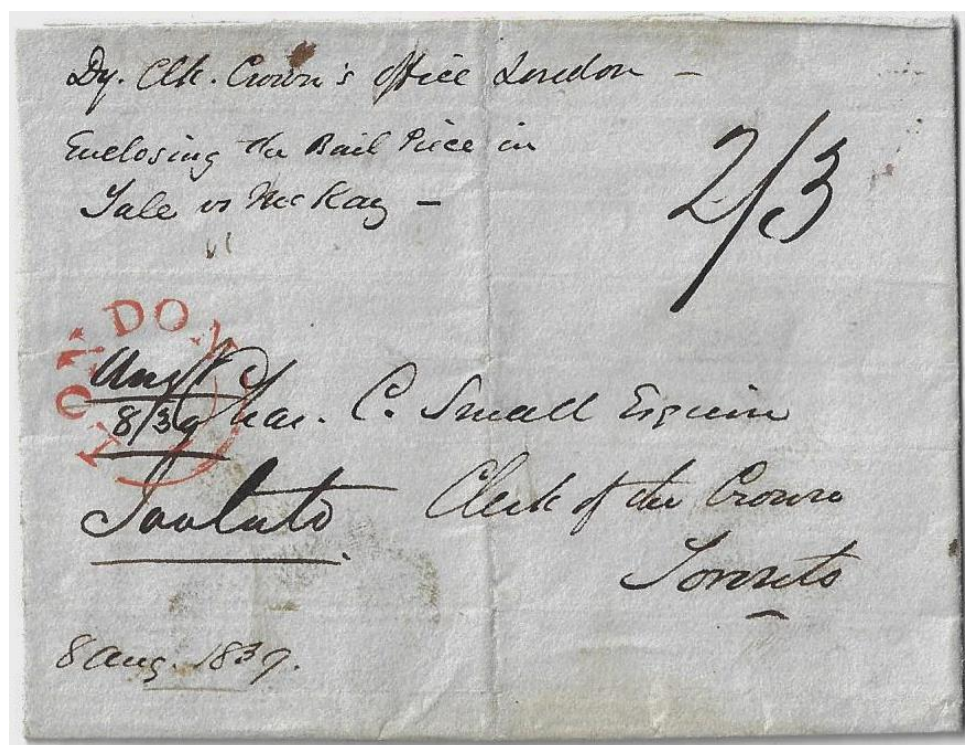

Item 526-01 – **London UC 1829 in red** – 1839, folded cover from London UC rated 2/3 collect to Toronto (triple 9d). Mailed too late, 1829 type in red dated AU 8 39 and an unusual note by the Deputy Clerk of the Crown. \$100.00



Item 526-02 – **Murray Bay LC double circle** – 1845, folded cover from Murray Bay LC rated 3/8 collect paying the quadruple 11d rate. Signed by G. Duberger. Quebec and Montreal (b/s). Internal archival tape. \$100.00



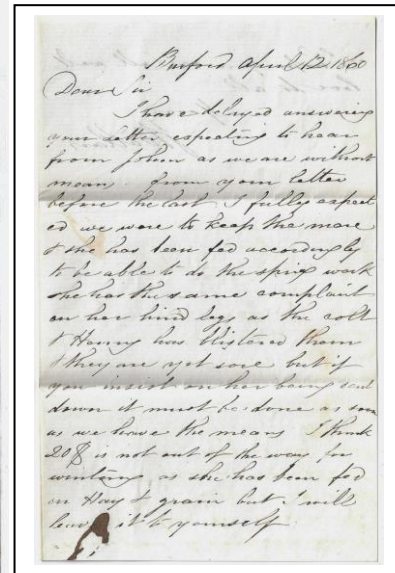

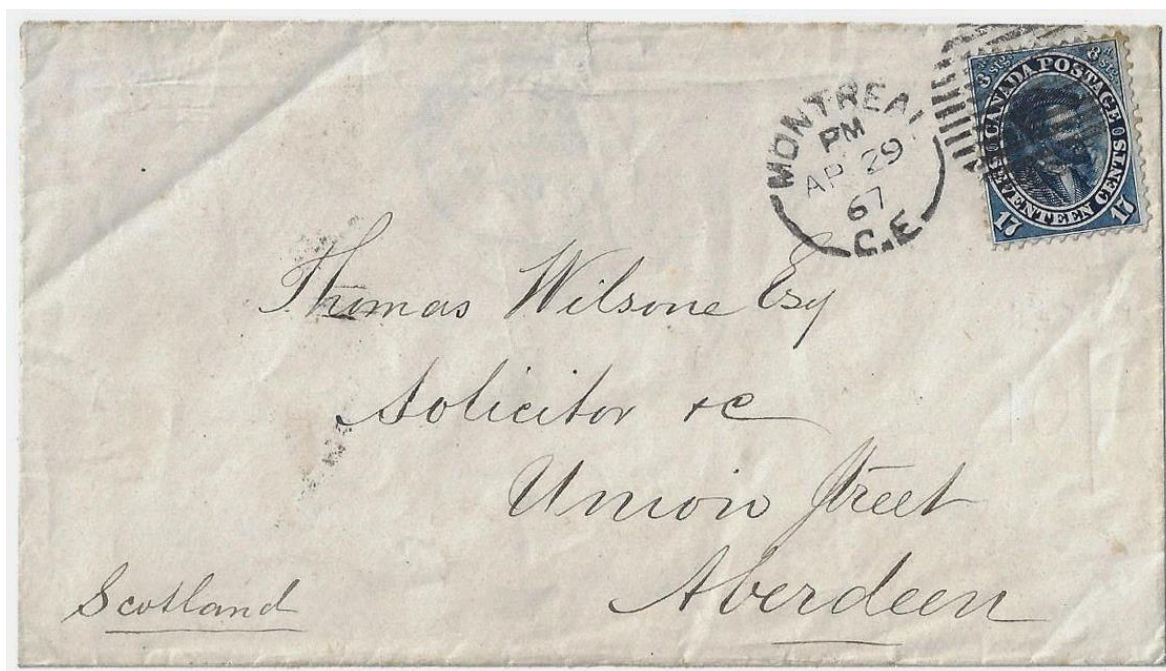

Item 526-06 – **Kingston CW Berri duplex** – 1862, 5¢ Beaver pair (Whitworth plate flaw No.4, state 4, position 81-82) tied by Kingston CW Berri duplex cancel on cover paying 10¢ cross border letter rate to New York. \$150.00



Item 526-07 – **5¢ Beaver position 91, re-entry** – 1860, 5¢ Beaver tied by "Paid" handstamp on cover from Burford UC paying 5¢ letter rate to Toronto. The beaver is: position 91, state 1, re-entry #1, an early state of the plate flaw #44a(11), plate flaw beneath T of CENTS and semicircular bubble. Letter accompanies. \$150.00 **SOLD**



Item 526-08 – **17¢ Cartier printing order 10 (new blue intense)** – 1867, 17¢ Cartier printing order 10 (new blue intense) tied by Montreal CE duplex cancel on cover paying 17¢ Cunard letter rate to Scotland. Carried by the Scotia 31st voyage. Aberdeen (b/s). \$500.00



Item 526-09 – **5¢ Large Queen – Allan Line Sarmatian** – 1875, 5¢ Large Queen (*decent centering*) tied by Quebec CE duplex cancel on cover paying 5¢ UPU letter rate to Scotland. 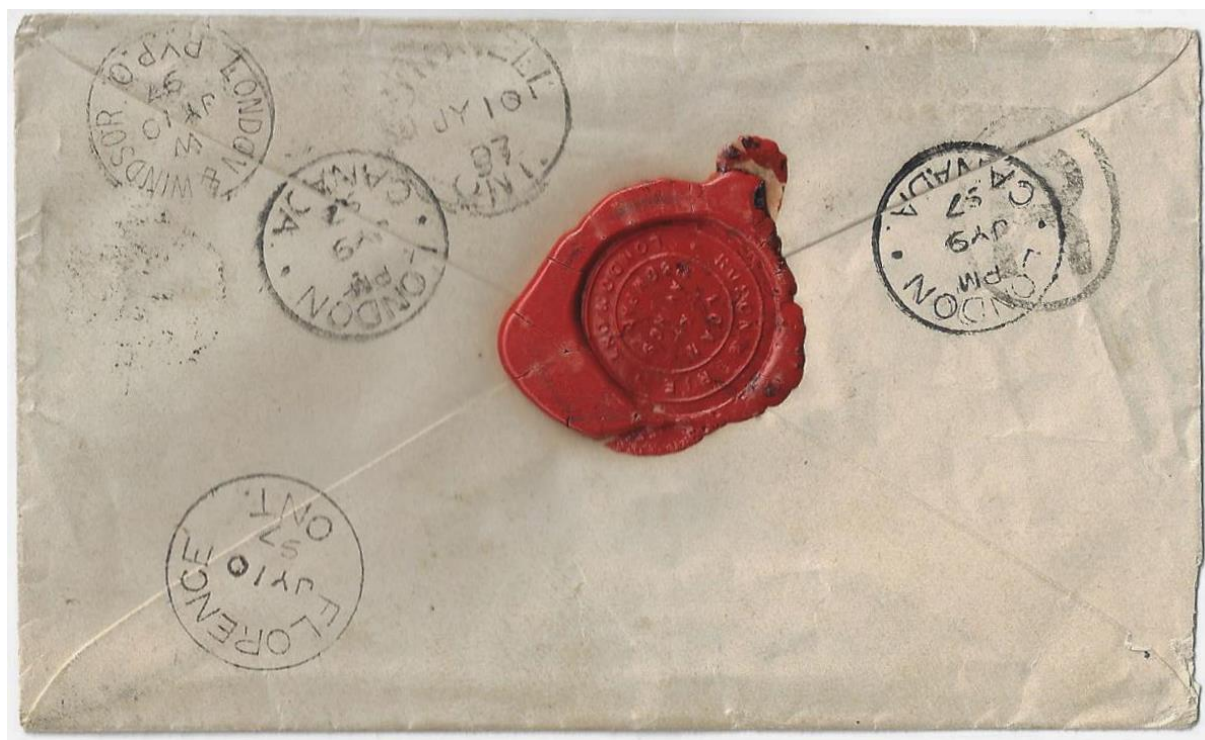
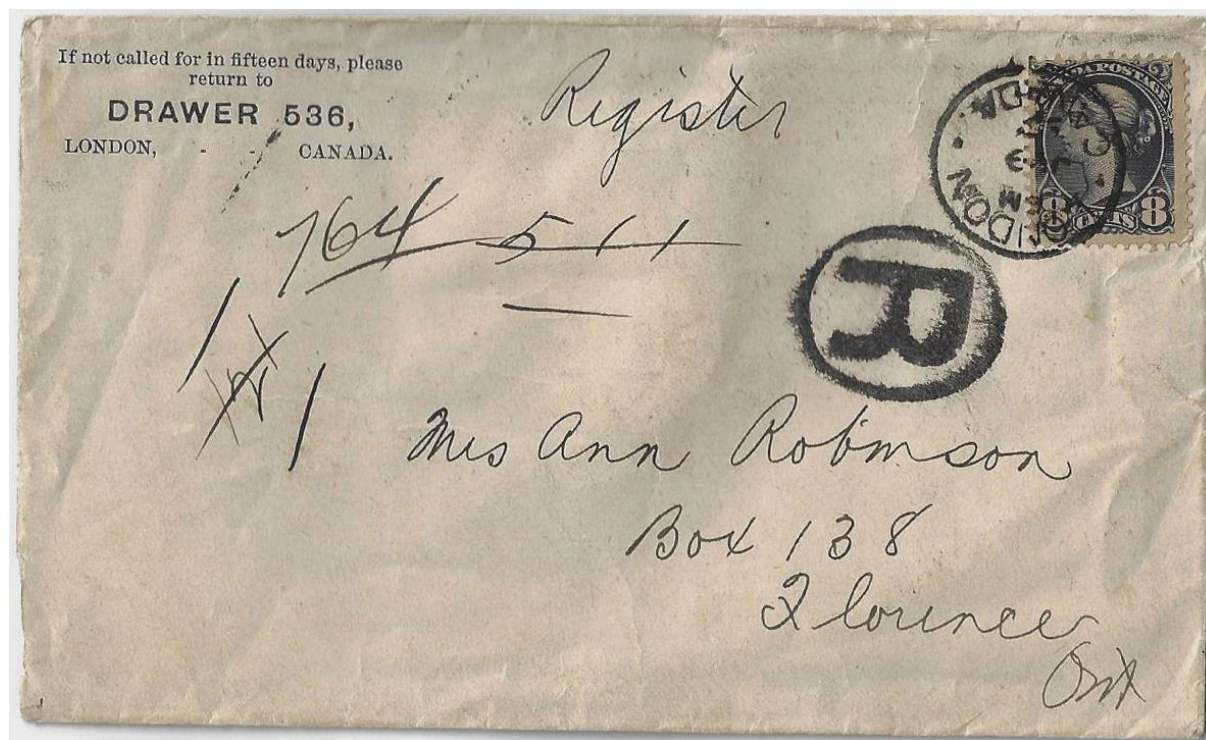
Item 526-10 – Ashburnham UC (Peterborough, closed in 1874) – 1869, 12½¢ Large Queen tied by smudge cancel on mourning cover from Ashburnham UC (the current latest recorded date for this hammer) paying 12½¢ Allan Line letter rate to Brighton, England (b/s). Reverse with paper lost due to waxseal removal. A rare Peterborough office, closed in 1874 and a lovely mourning cover. \$375.00 **SOLD**



Item 526-11 – **St. Catharines leaf cancel** – 1882, 3¢ SQ tied by leaf fancy cancel on cover from St. Catharines Ont paying 3¢ letter rate to Cumrock (b/s) via Fergus and Guelph (b/s). Light reduction at left. \$60.00



Item 526-12– **6¢ double weight registered letter rate** – 1875, 6¢ SQ (yellow brown) tied by masonic triangle fancy cancel on cover from Kingston (Lacelle 1335, September to November 1875) paying 6¢ double weight letter rate to Toronto with 2¢ registry fee paid in cash. File fold. A late registry fee paid in cash example. \$125.00 **SOLD**

Item 526-15 – **Blyth fancy cancel** – 1882, 3¢ SQ tied by Blyth in grid fancy cancel, Lacelle 305 (p.40), on cover from Blyth Ont paying 3¢ letter rate to Clinton (b/s). Huron County. A seldom encountered fancy! \$275.00



Item 526-16 – **A.R. Williams Machinery Co.** – 1899, 2¢ Numeral tied by York Street Toronto squared circle, MY 11 99, on A.R. Williams Machinery Co. all-over advertising cover paying 2¢ letter rate to Brantford (b/s). \$150.00



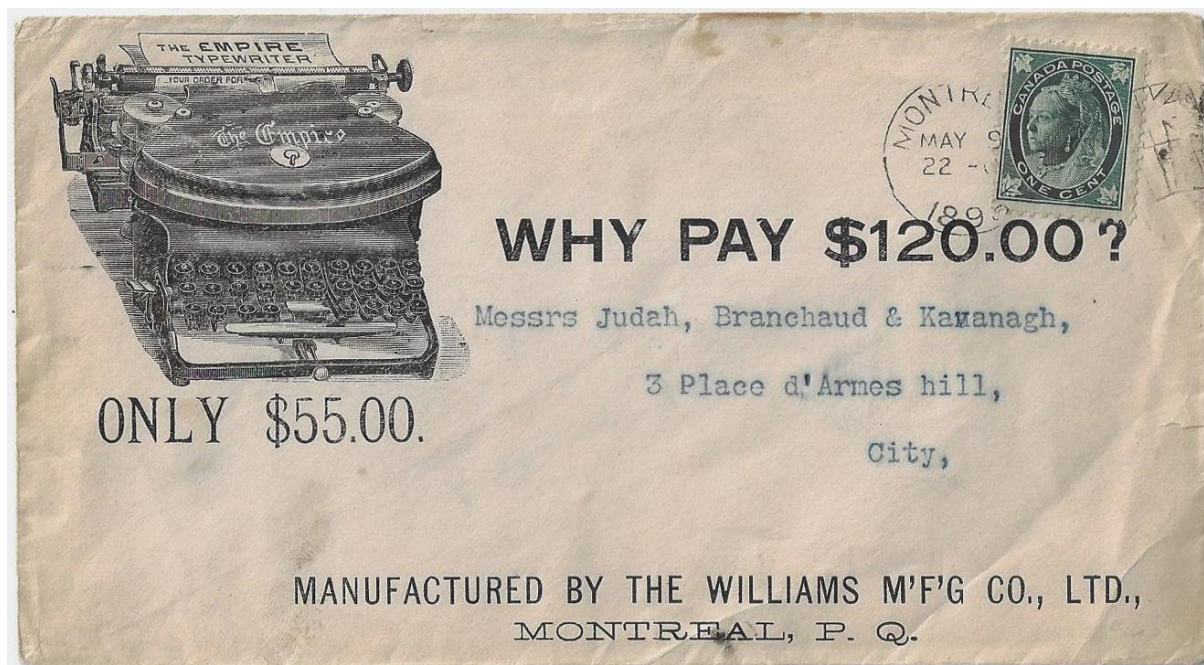

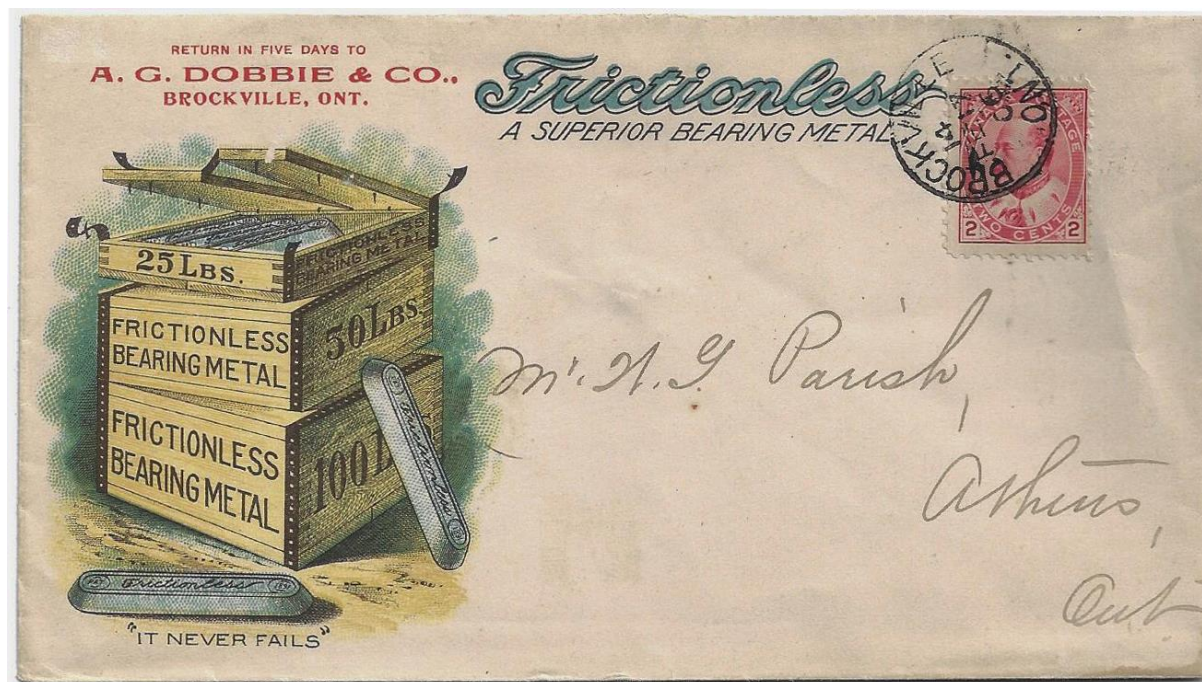
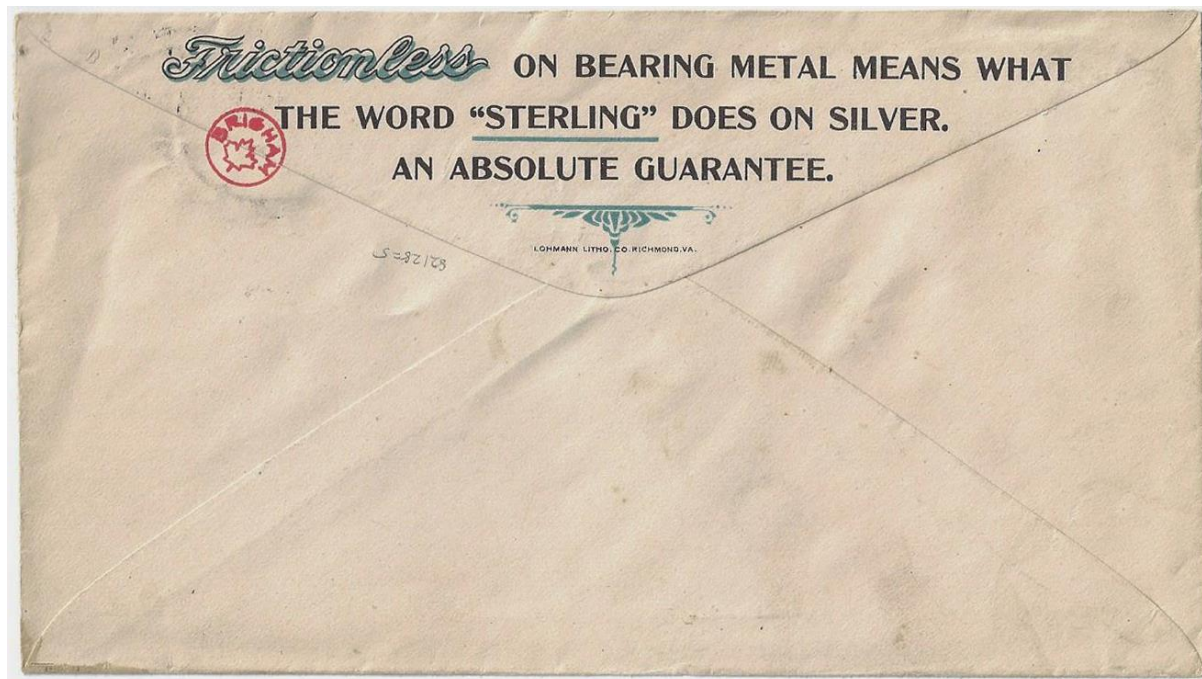

(Karlovac, West of Zagreb, Croatia). In the late 19th and early 20th century, Karlovac was a district capital in the Zagreb County of the Kingdom of Croatia-Slavonia within the Austro-Hungarian Empire. A rare destination. 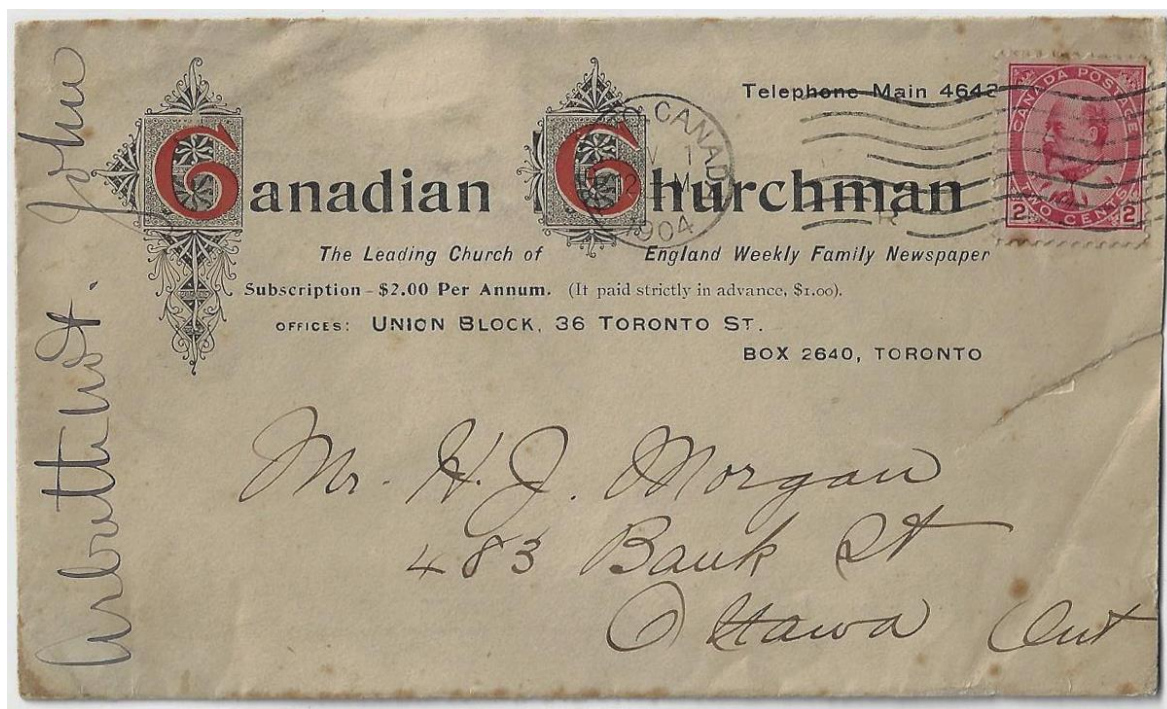

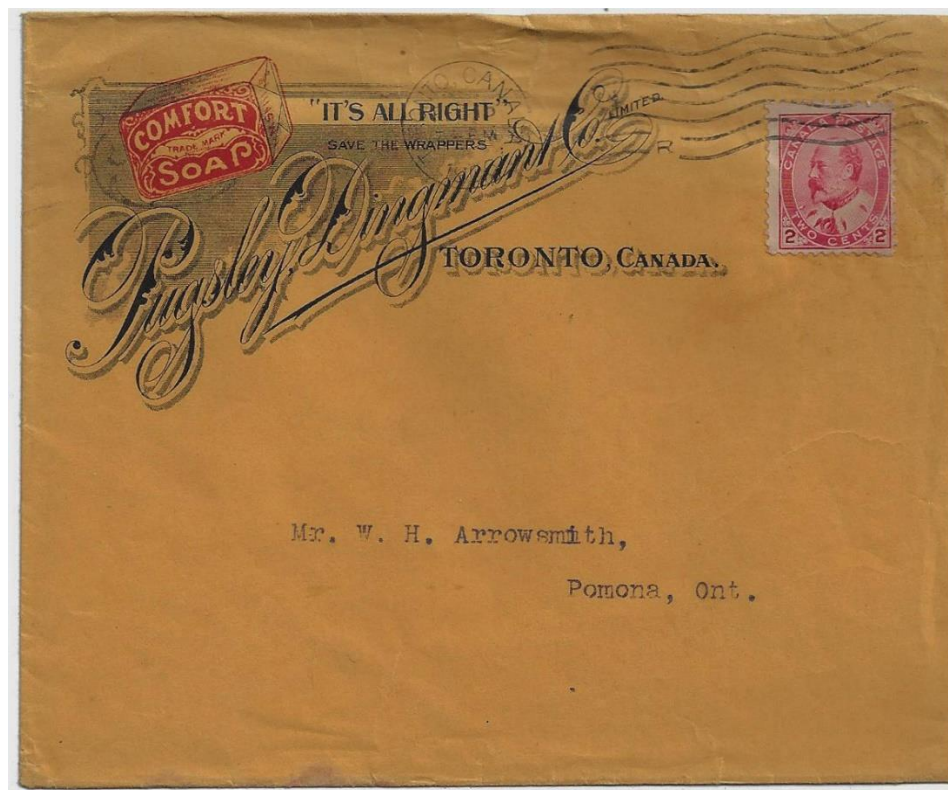

No.2, Montreal hammer IV, Halifax & Moncton MC East (b/s). A peculiar 1/2 marking upside down on front very similar to the transatlantic rate marking. \$50.00

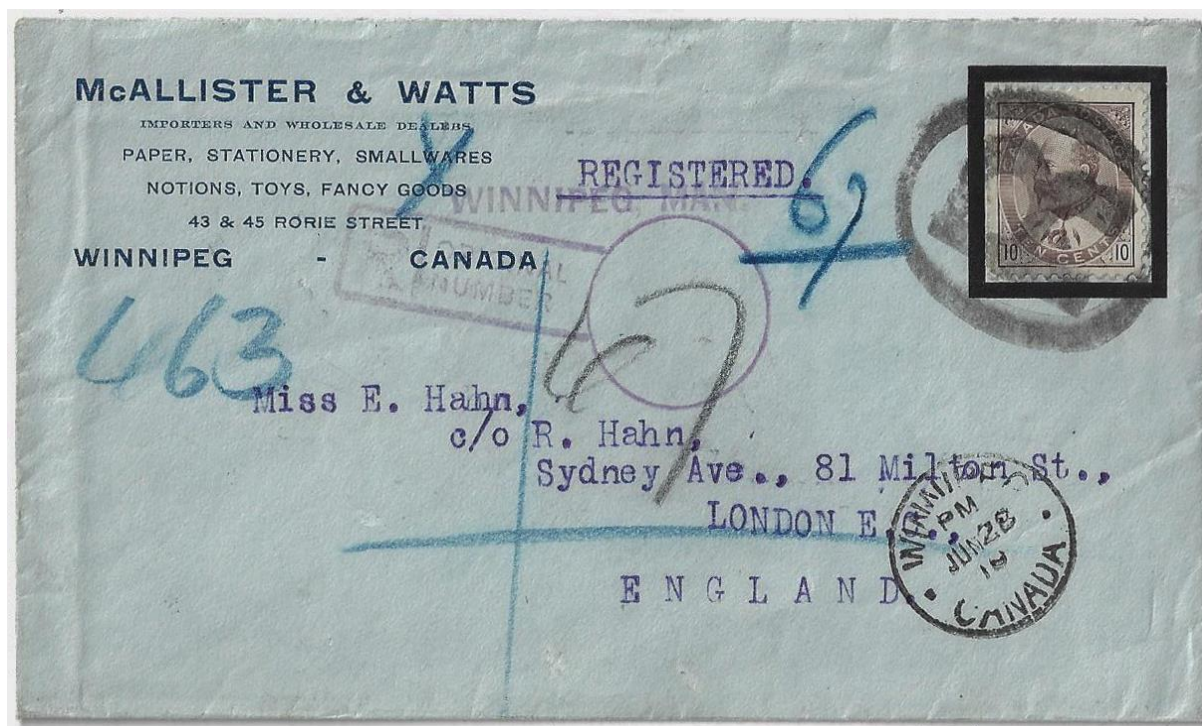

Item 526-25 – **Multi-coloured food company cover** – 1910, 2¢ Edward (affixed over edge) tied by Toronto machine cancel on International Stock Food Co. advertising cover, all-over illustrated on front and back multi-coloured 3 FEEDS FOR ONE CENT, paying 2¢ letter rate to Pickering redirected to Greenwood (b/s). Whitby transit (b/s). Great condition. Ex Hennok. \$250.00 **SOLD**



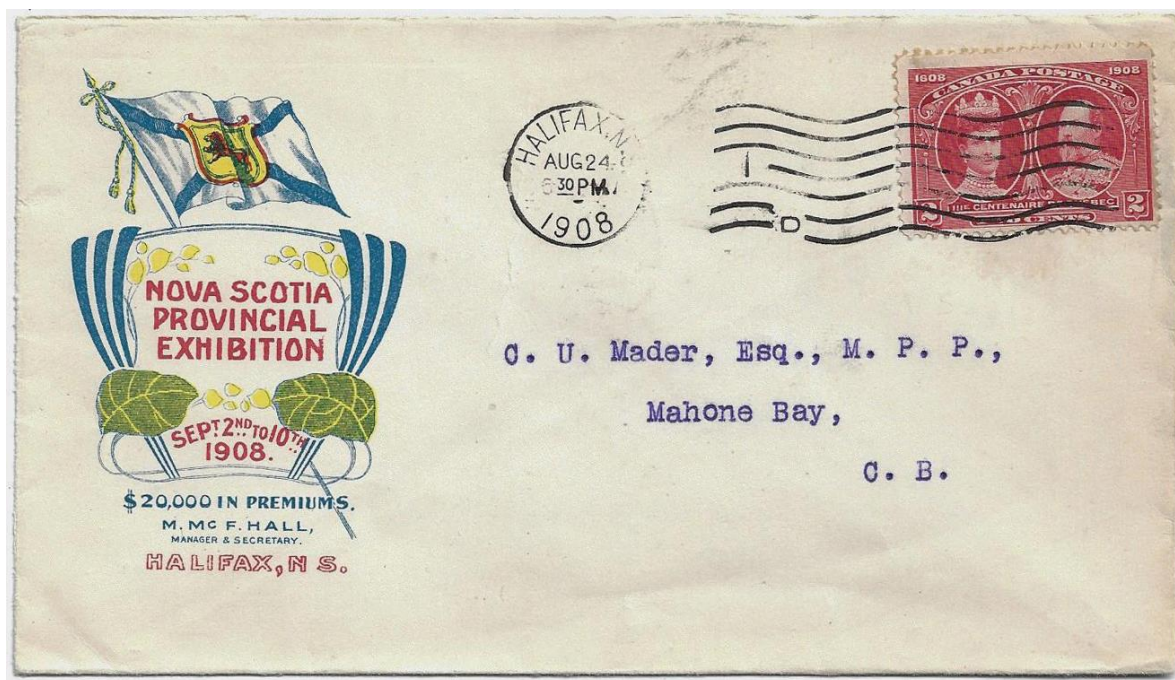
Item 526-26 – **Duck Lake Saskatchewan - 10¢ UPU registered to France** – 1912, 10¢ Edward tied by Duke Lake Sask cds on cover, 23 OC 12, paying 10¢ UPU registered letter rate to France (b/s) via Winnipeg and London England (b/s). Some back flap and paper lost but still a fine and attractive Saskatchewan UPU registered cover to Europe. \$450.00



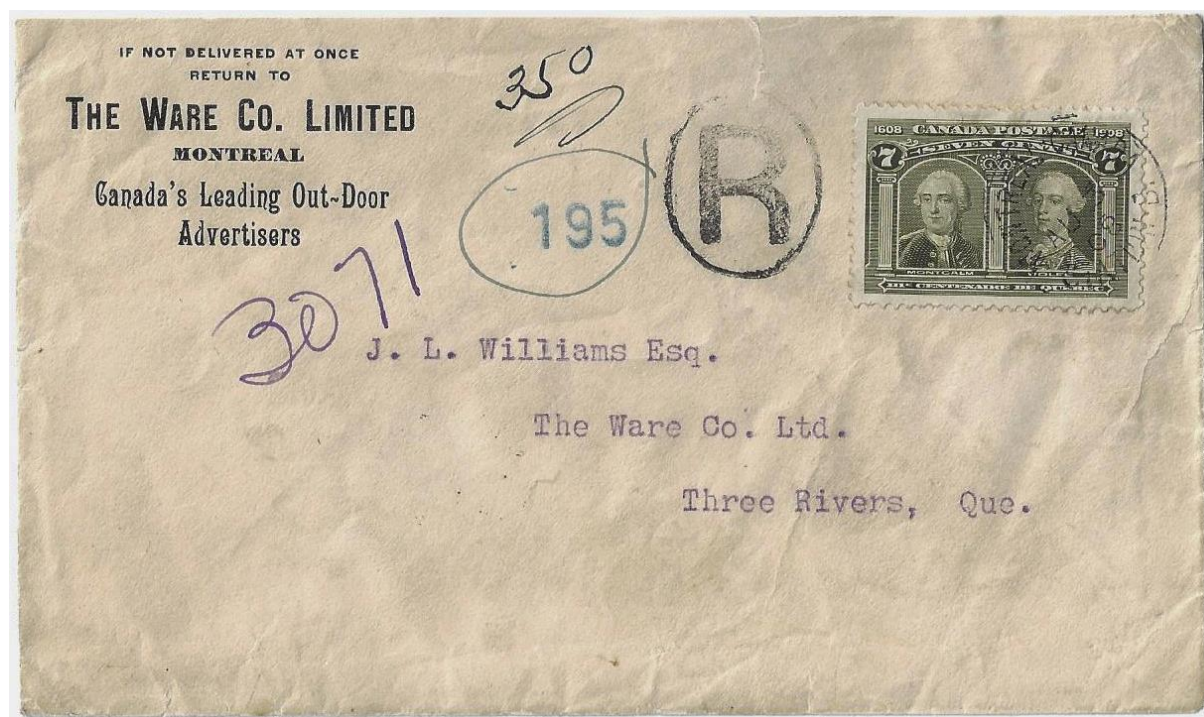
Item 526-27 – **Mourning stamp-collar** – 1910, 10c Edward tied by large oval registered cancel on McAllister & Watts c/c cover with mourning stamp collar paying 9c double weight Empire registered letter rate to England, 1c convenience. Keyhole precursor registration marking along with a Winnipeg Man straight line. McAllister & Watts were importers and wholesale dealers in paper, stationery, smallware, toys and fancy goods. \$500.00



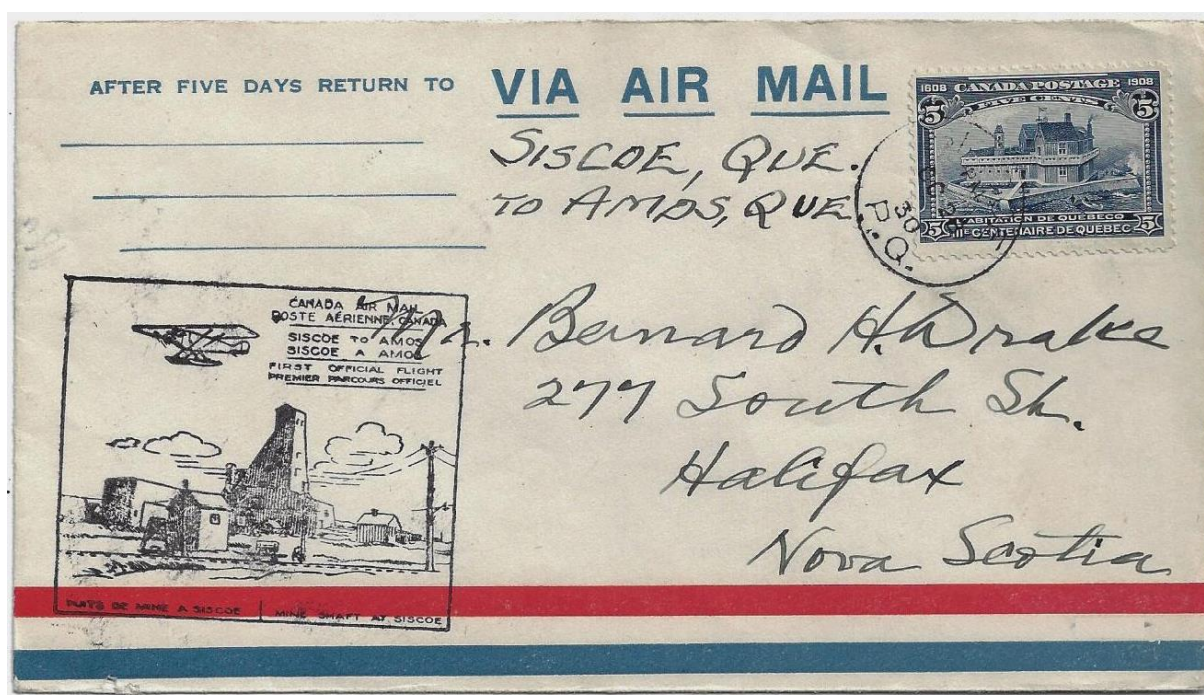
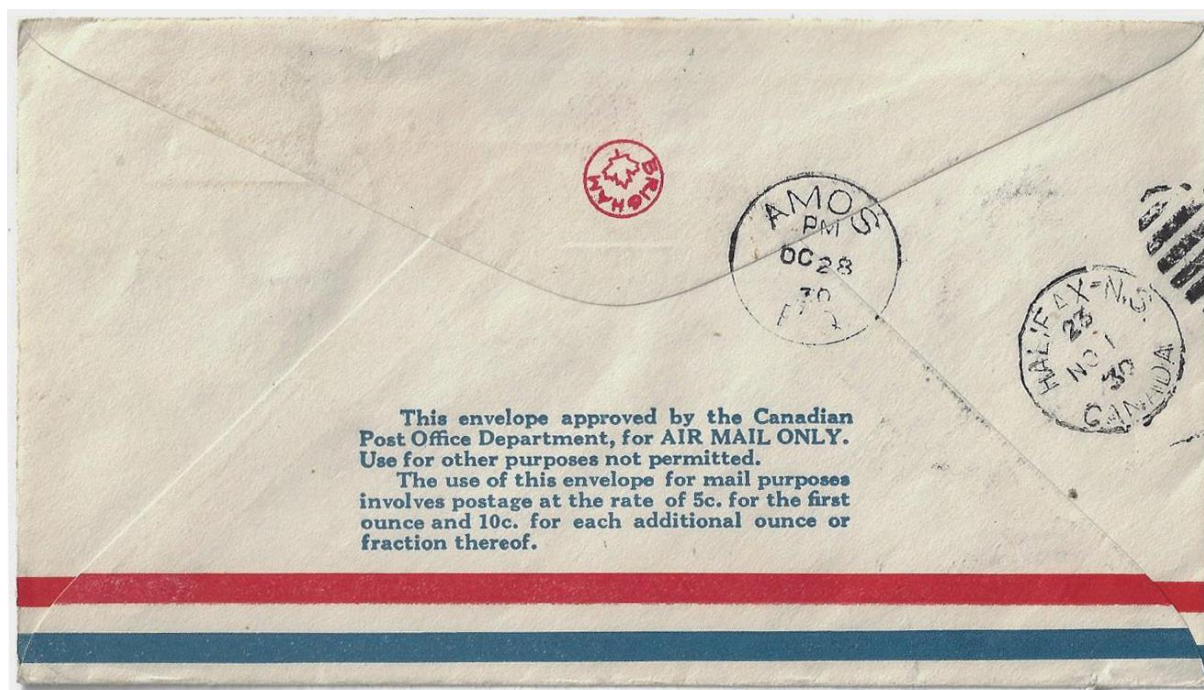
Item 526-28 – **2c double weight drop** – 1908, 1/2c Tercentenary block of 4 tied by Vancouver BC cds on cover, AU 19 08, paying 2c double weight drop letter rate. The drop rate was decreased to 1c on August 98 1908 1908 making this cover a double weight drop. Ex Nickle. \$50.00 **SOLD**



Item 526-29 – 2¢ Quebec on Nova Scotia Prov. Exhibition – 1908, 2¢ Quebec tied by Halifax machine cancel on Nova Scotia Provincial Exhibition advertising cover paying 2¢ letter rate to Mahone Bay (b/s). The cover is addressed to Charles Uniacke Mader, MPP. Mader was a merchant and political figure in Nova Scotia. He represented Lunenburg County in the Nova Scotia House of Assembly as a Liberal member from 1904 to 1911. He first worked as a clerk in a general store and then went into business on his own in Mahone Bay in 1880. Mader built a general store in Mahone Bay in 1887 and also operated a fishing fleet. He served as a member of the local school board. \$150.00 **SOLD**

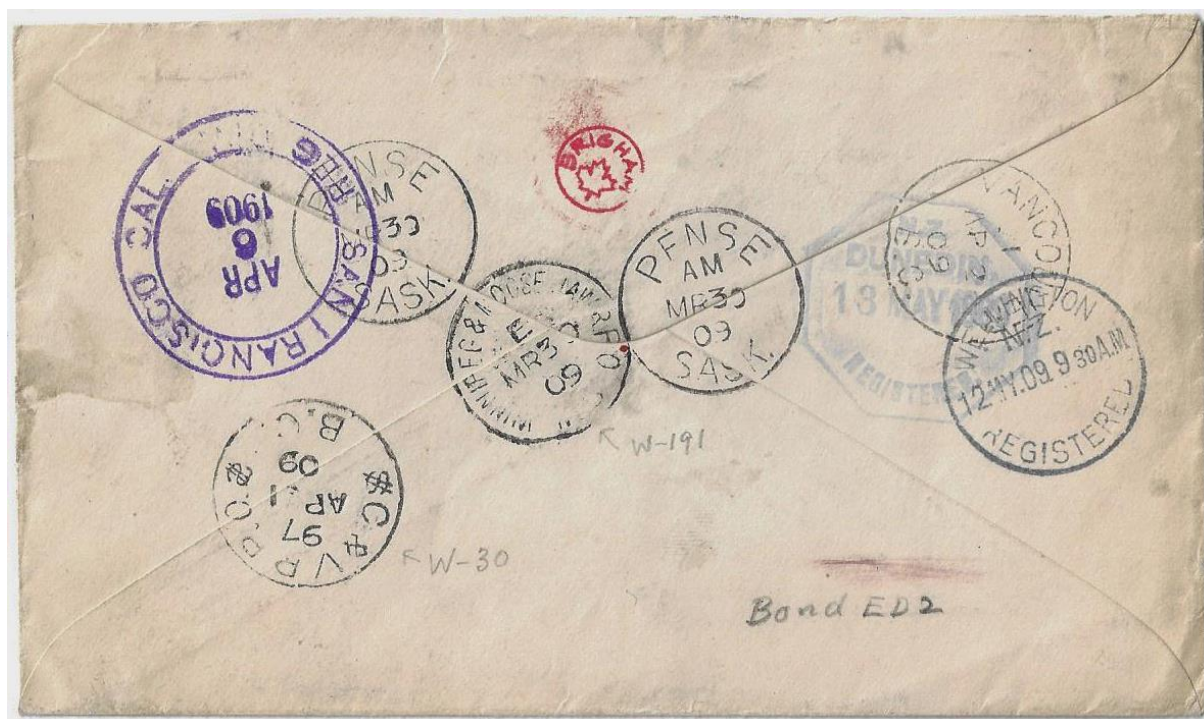

Red wax seals on back. Ex Nickle, Libra, Brigham. \$750.00



Item 526-33 – **10¢ Quebec Tercentenary use** – 1909, 1¢ Edward, 10¢ Quebec Tercentenary tied by oval registered cancel on cover paying 11¢ triple weight registered letter rate to U.S. Boxed violet “Supposed Liable to United States Customs Duties” on front, New York (b/s). Very pretty registered cover. Ex Libra, Brigham. \$750.00

No receiver as customary. \$1,000.00



Item 526-35 – **7¢ Empire registered to New Zealand** – 1909, 1¢ Jubilee (3), 1/2¢ (2), 1¢ Quebecs tied by Pense Sask cds on 2¢ postal stationery envelope, 30 MR 1909, paying 7¢ Empire registered letter rate to New Zealand (b/s). San Francisco registration label applied and backstamped then routed to Dunedin via Wellington (b/s). Nickle, Libra, Brigham. \$500.00

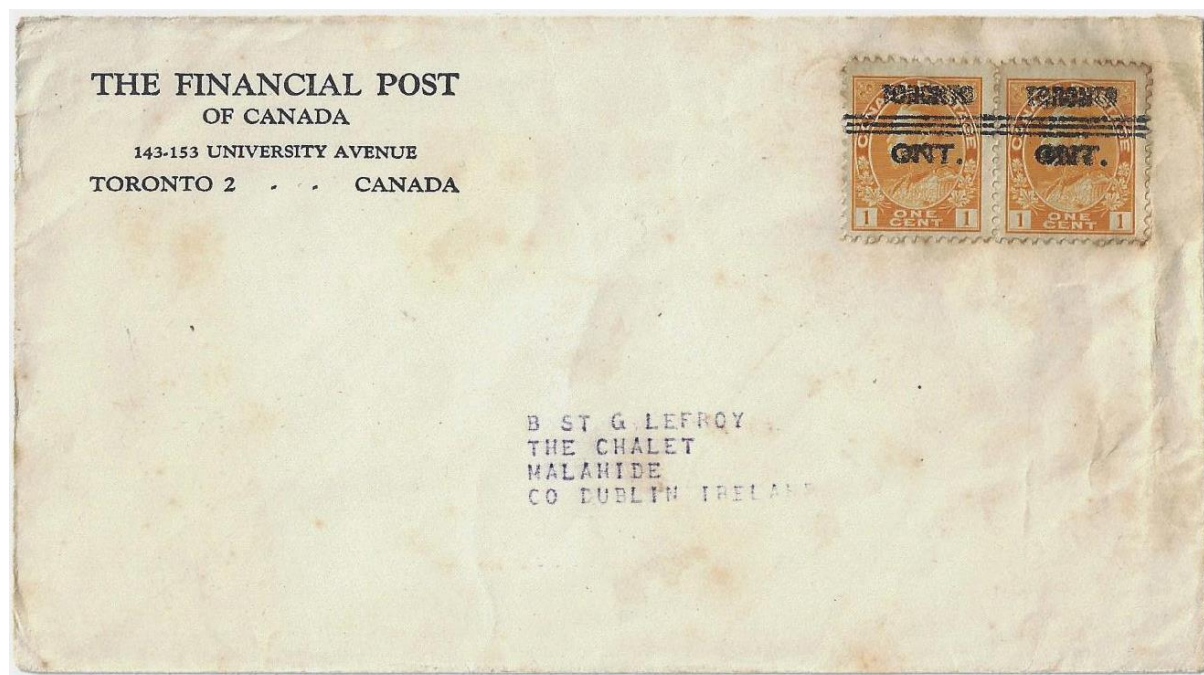


Item 526-36 –**Great War medals 15¢ registered** – 1922, Ottawa 5¢, 10¢ Admiral precancel (10¢ over flap and corner off from opening) on Militia Director of Records mailer paying 15¢ quintuple weight 3rd class registered rate to Montreal. Prepayment was not required on these medal envelopes at the time of mailing and had to be forwarded unrated to the Post Office. Then, registered by the Ottawa P.O. (*Ottawa Canada Registered double circles in blue*) and forwarded to destination. Ex Michel. \$200.00 **SOLD**

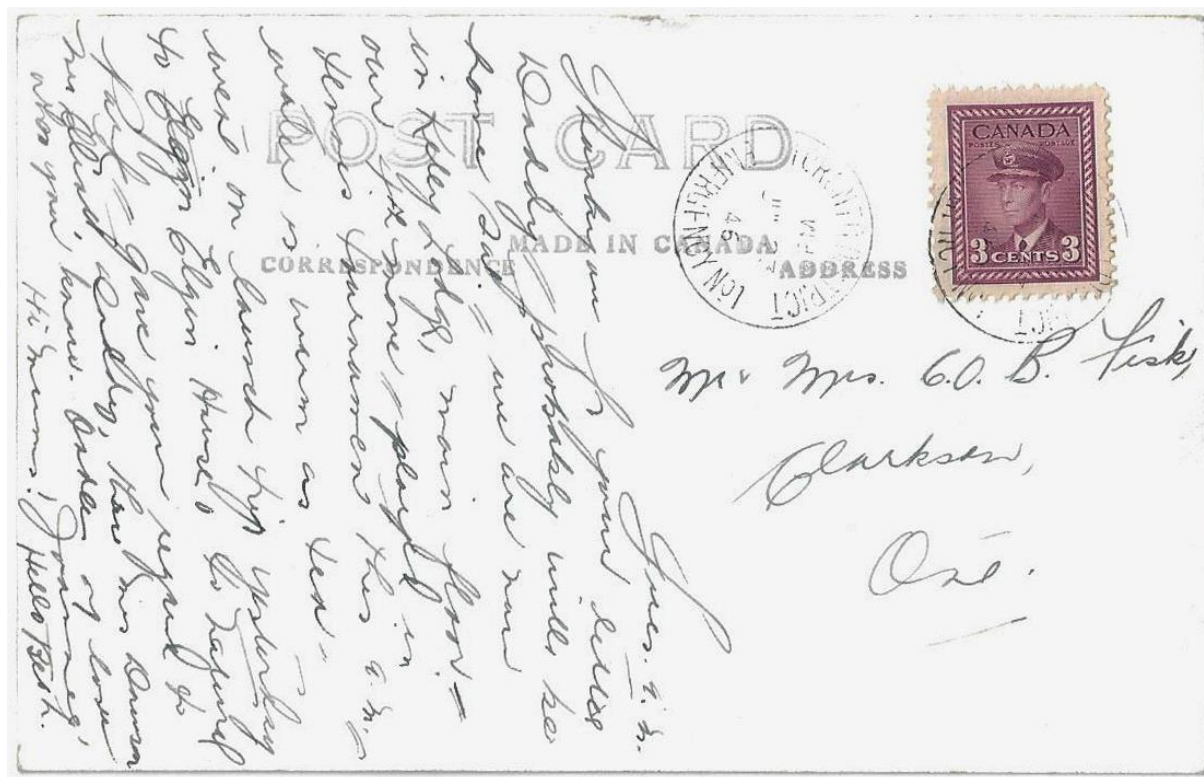
Item 526-44 – **30¢ airmail to Army Post Office, England** – 1941, 4¢ Mufti, 13¢ Pictorial (2) tied by Calgary Alta machine cancel on cover paying 30¢ airmail letter rate to England. To an officer stationed at 1st Canadian Div HQ in England. Trans-Atlantic Air Mail Army P.O. England handstamp and routed via Ottawa (Base APO b/s). Odd franking. \$50.00



Item 526-45 – **Freddy Masson Grosse Isle** – c1946-7, 10¢ Peace tied by Montmagny Que machine cancel on typewritten folded letter, signed by Freddy Masson to California, U.S. -- Masson was the secretary of Grosse Isle and has connections with the War Disease Control Station. The content relates to philatelic covers production. \$40.00



Item 526-46 – **E7 single franking** – 1942, 10¢ Special Delivery E7 cancelled by grid cancel on cover from Ste Anastasie Que paying 10¢ free special delivery to Quebec City (*to Postal Superintendent*). Parcel special delivery Exprès label form S.D. 1 50M 5-6-39. \$100.00
