My Dearest Henrietta

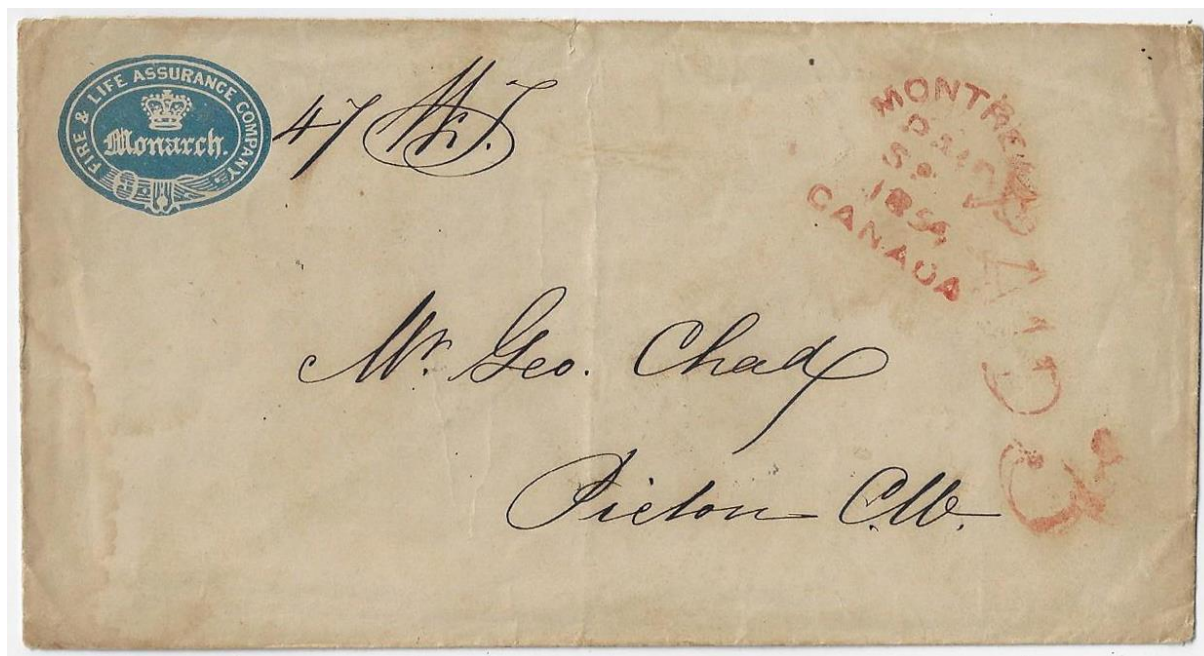

It is ever a desired pleasure to me to receive a letter from you & to hear that you are in good health & enjoy yourself, & for me we will not but doing very well people are not putting up any iron buildings this fall & the jobs that I had on hand when last I wrote you I have nearly finished up & I shall not get any more to do soon I shall get home as soon as I can & come home & spend a few weeks & don't know but longer I think it will be a harder task to leave home this time to return to Canada than it ever has been before for I see that has become dearer to me than home ever was
