Item 550-01 – <u>Dudswell LC registered (Wolfe)</u> – 1858, registered stampless cover from Dudswell LC, manuscript date, paid 3 paying 3d letter rate to Quebec (b/s) with registry fee paid in cash. Sherbrooke transit (b/s). Rare. \$125.00 <u>SOLD</u>




Item 550-02 – <u>Postmaster free franked letter</u> – 1843, Postmaster free franked letter (the last page) from Kingston to Ramsay, Lanark County. The letter is signed R.C. Campbell to James Wylie, Postmaster. \$75.00





Item 550-03 – Quebec to Medonte CW (Simcoe 1851-1884) – 1865, mourning cover from Quebec with Quebec Paid and paid 5 paying 5¢ letter rate to Medonte UC (b/s) via Barrie (b/s). Medonte is a very scarce Simcoe office. Small portion of back flap off. \$75.00 SOLD

Medonte, the name in Delaware language meant evil spirit. In Ojibwa, the word meant I carry on my back referring to the portage between Lake Simcoe and Georgian Bay. The town name was changed to Moonstone.



Item 550-04 – <u>Kingston 1d - Grand Masonic Festival</u> – 1854, Kingston printed circular, Grand Masonic Festival, rated 1d paying the circular rate to Brockville (b/s). The contents relate to the celebration of St. John's Day at Auburn New York and is addressed to the Sussex Lodge of Freemasons in Brockville. Very pretty and good topic. \$175.00





Item 550-11 – 1¢ SQ deep orange- GWR Mail Line – 1875, 1¢ SQ deep orange tied by G.W.R. East AU 5 75 Mail Line broken circle (1873-1888) on cover paying 1¢ printed matter rate to Armadale. Spectacular! \$150.00



Item 550-12 – 11¢ registered parcel post – 1887, 3¢ SQ pair, 5¢ RLS (pre-affixing trim perfs) tied by fancy cancel on cover, endorsed Parcel Post – Legal Papers Only, No Correspondence / Osgood Hall Toronto, paying 11¢ registered parcel post from Toronto to Plattsville Ont (b/s). Carried by Goderich & Ft Erie MC and B&LHR (b/s). A great cover for a rate exhibit! \$150.00 SOLD





This Lime Ridge Que marking is the first I have ever seen and maybe the earliest recorded date of the few existing examples. \$175.00 SOLD










Item 550-23 – **2¢ Quebec – Fearman Pork Packers and Lard** – 1908, 2¢ Quebec tied by Hamilton International machine cancel on F.W. Fearman & Co. Pork and Lard advertising cover paying 2¢ letter rate to Windsor N.S. (b/s). Small tear on back flap. \$50.00 **SOLD** 



Item 550-24 – 1¢ Quebec – Western Fair – 1908, 1¢ Quebec tied by London International machine cancel on National Drug & Chemical Co. c/c and Western Fair London advertising cover paying 1¢ drop letter rate. To GTR. \$175.00 SOLD



Item 550-28 – <u>San Francisco mailed on train</u> – 1908, 1¢ Quebec (2, some interesting printing flaws especially around the P of Postage on the left stamp) tied by C&V RPO BC (Gray WT-91.120) on San Francisco Hotel cover paying 2¢ letter rate to Massachusetts (b/s). A seldom seen Quebec Tercentenary cover mailed on train from an American hotel. \$150.00

Langelier Mirror Furniture advertising cover underpaying 5¢ double weight letter rate to Durham (b/s). Addressed to Durham Furniture Co. Charged 4¢ the double deficiency and paid with two First Issue 2¢ postage due stamps. Aging. \$150.00



Item 550-31 – <u>MR4 bisect</u> – 1919, 2¢+1¢ Wartax MR4 bisect tied by Orillia Ont Buy War Savings machine cancel on unsealed cover paying 1¢ drop letter rate. Curiosity or a huge lack of stamps forcing the used of such Wartax stamps (?). \$75.00 **SOLD** 



Item 550-32 – **Brandon Manitoba Creamery** – 1927, 2¢ Admiral tied by Brandon Man machine cancel on Brandon Creamery & Supply Co. advertising cover paying 2¢ letter rate to Winnipeg. Cold Storage facility at left with wagon and main building with automobile and carriage illustrated. \$40.00 **SOLD** 



Item 550-33 – Halifax drop letter redirected to St. John NB – 1924, 1¢ Admiral tied by Halifax machine cancel on Tuplin Silver Black Fox c/c cover paying 1¢ drop letter rate. Redirected within Halifax (to Union Street), ms "removed", 1¢ postage due stamp applied at the General Delivery office, tied by Halifax clerk double circle and then redirected to St. John NB. \$45.00





Item 550-34 – <u>Vernon Camp registered</u> – 1916, 2¢ Admiral, 2¢+1¢ Wartax MR3 tied by grid cancel on cover from Vernon Camp B.C. paying 8¢ Empire registered letter rate to England (b/s). Montreal transit (b/s) with Keyhole. \$300.00







Item 550-35 – <u>Camp Borden Pie Crust postmark</u> – 1917, 1¢, 7¢ Admiral (pre-affixing fault) tied by FPO Camp Borden Pie Crust cds (*also called the violet Borden scalloped cds*) on MFB cover paying 8¢ registered letter rate to St. Catharines. Routed via Hamilton with Hamilton & Meaford RPO and Toronto & Niagara Falls RPO (b/s). A few tape repairs to back but still a Great War rarity. \$500.00



Item 550-36 – <u>London Camp registered</u> – 1917, 2¢ Admiral, 2¢+1¢ Wartax MR4 tied by London Camp cds hammer 1 on MFD cover paying 8¢ <u>double weight drop registered</u> letter rate. Partially printed contents from the military Paymaster enclosure. A scarce double weight registered local cover from a camp. \$250.00





Item 550-37 – <u>Levis Camp Que</u> – 1913-1914, 1¢ Admiral tied by Levis Camp Que cds, no year date in postmark, on Montmorency Falls postcard paying 1¢ postcard rate to Mrs V.W. Learned in Learned Plain Quebec (Compton County). The message reads: *Having a good time, best place to camp that I have struck yet, have not been over to Quebec yet but will some afternoon, can see this falls from the ground here, have been having a cold but better now.* \$200.00





Item 550-38 – <u>Vernon Camp YMCA staff real photo card</u> – 1916, 1¢ Admiral (2) tied by Vernon Camp BC cds on YMCA staff real photo postcard paying 2¢ PC rate to New Westminster BC. The photo, by H. Smith, is depicting a group of men in YMCA shirts. Instructional marking "please have your mail addressed to – street and number". Pretty! \$150.00





Item 550-39 – <u>Camp Sewell Manitoba</u> – 1915, 1¢, 2¢ Admiral tied by Sewell Camp cds SP 16 15 on 45<sup>th</sup> Battalion Lines real photo postcard overpaying the postcard rate to Winnipeg. Advance photo postcard No.87 Portage Avenue, Winnipeg. \$150.00





The card is depicting soldiers at Camp, line up at outdoor kitchen. Top rarity. \$750.00






Item 550-41 – **26¢ airmail special delivery to U.S. taxed 20¢** - 1939, 3¢ Mufti (2), US 10¢ Special Delivery tied by Vidora Sask cds on cover underpaying 26¢ airmail special delivery letter rate to Wisconsin (Milwaukee b/s). The 20¢ special delivery fee had to be prepaid as required by the U.S. regulations. No insufficient postage marking and handled as special delivery letter which is confirmed by the charge of 20¢ to be collected. \$125.00



Item 550-42 – SD facing slip SD4 300,000 22-4-36 — 1937, bilingual special delivery facing slip form SD4 300,000 22-4-36 mailed from Edmonton Alberta with oval and Air Mail marking to Urbana Illinois (b/s). This form was used to group special delivery letters to one location, wrapped all together and mailed as a separate package. Interestingly, sent airmail. \$200.00




Item 550-43 – Y Force – Jamaica – 1942, Jamaica 6d tied by Kingston Jamaica cds on Canadian legion cover paying 6d airmail letter rate to Hamilton Ontario. Censored by military censor No.2. The cover is from Lt Mc Lean of the Argyll & Sutherland Highlanders. \$75.00




Item 550-44 – <u>Y Force – Jamaica</u> – 1942, Jamaica 1/ tied by Kingston Jamaica machine cancel on cover paying 1/ double weight airmail letter rate to Hamilton Ontario. Censored by military censor No.10. The cover is from Lt Mc Lean of the Argyll & Sutherland Highlanders. \$100.00



Item 550-45 – 1¢ postage due paid at Niagara Camp – 1939, 2¢ Mufti tied by Oakville Ont machine cancel on cover paying 2¢ drop letter rate. The cover is addressed to Lcol L. Keene. Redirected to Niagara Camp in Niagara-on-the-Lake and charged 1¢ redirectional fee. An interesting military cover a few weeks before Canada declared War against Germany and seldom encountered 1¢ Royal Visit stamp paying dues. \$100.00





Item 550-46 – <u>Rejected by Postal Censor</u> – 1941, Brazil cover incoming to Canada addressed to Internment Camp F, Fort Henry, Kingston Ontario. Entered in Canada in Ottawa (Base APO b/s), rejected by postal censor, not a chance to be directed to the intended addressee, stopped and returned to sender. \$200.00 <u>SOLD</u>



Item 550-47 – 1¢ War plate 15 strip of 4 position 90-94 – 1946, 1¢ War plate 15 strip of 4 position 90-94 tied by matching Quyon PQ cds on United Church cover paying 4¢ letter rate to Montreal. Redirected within Montreal and then returned to sender (b/s). \$40.00



Item 550-48 – <u>FECB and registered to Hong Kong</u> – 1948, 5¢ War, 10¢, 20¢, 50¢ Peace tied by Welland Ont cds on FECB passed for export cover paying 85¢ triple weight airmail registered letter rate to Hong Kong. Hamilton Ont (b/s) and tiny R6 marking probably applied in Hong Kong. \$150.00



Item 550-49 – 7¢ Peace booklet stamp use – C9as – 1950, 7¢ Peace (booklet stamp, C9as) 10¢ E11 tied by Winnipeg Man duplex cancel on cover paying 17¢ airmail special delivery letter rate to Scarboro. A rare C9as single usage on cover. \$75.00



Item 550-50 – 1¢ GEOVI unrevised issue single use – 1950, 1¢ GEOVI unrevised issue tied by Winnipeg machine cancel on postcard underpaying 3¢ postcard rate to Saskatchewan. 4¢ postage due, the double deficiency, postage paid with a 4¢ Postes Postage carmine regular stamp. Highly unusual. \$45.00




