Carried by the Cunard Europa 5th voyage via Halifax (Boston, Halifax to Liverpool). Liverpool 21 MR 49 (b/s). This is a very late 1/2 Stg usage as the rate was lowered to 1/ in April 1849. 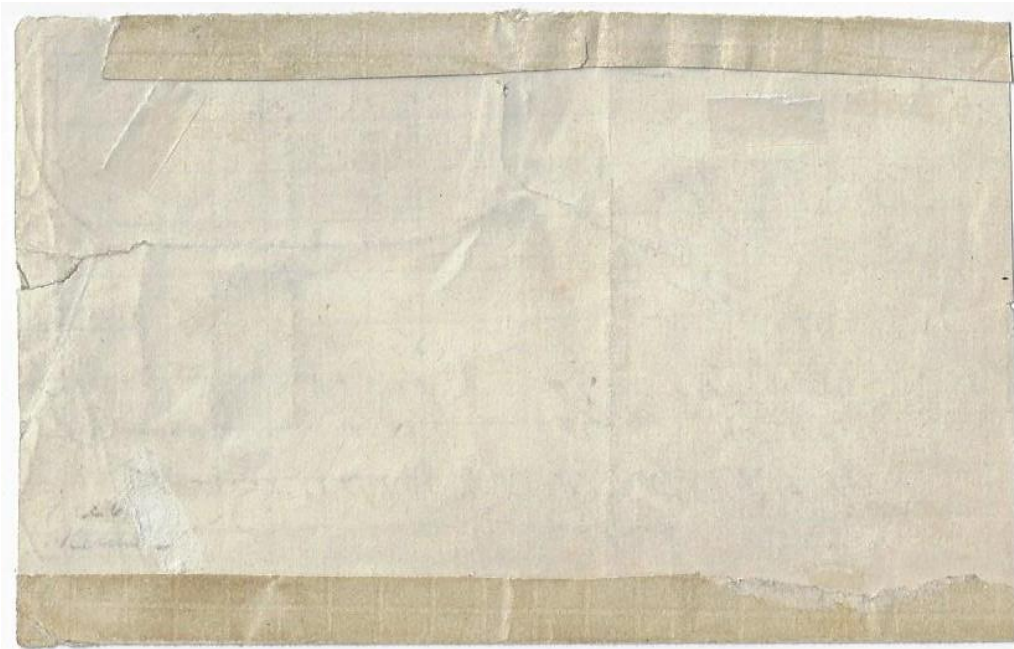
Item 551-11 – **J.S. Macdonald 1st Premier of Ontario** – 1870, stampless cover from Toronto paid 3 paying 3¢ letter rate to Berlin (b/s). The cover is signed by J. Sandfield Macdonald, the Premier "In Office" of the new Province of Ontario. Macdonald was Premier of Ontario and held the portfolio of Attorney-General (A.G.). He had a long political career beginning in Glengarry in 1841. He opposed Confederation but reconciled with it upon its completion and in 1867 was persuaded by John A. Macdonald to accept the office of Premier in the new Province of Ontario. \$300.00



Item 551-12 – **Montreal Telegraph Co. postally used** – 1863, stampless cover with Montreal Telegraph Company cameo embossed advertising cover presumably from Montreal, rated 7¢ collect to Smiths Falls (b/s). The cover is addressed to the Postmaster! \$150.00 **SOLD**
