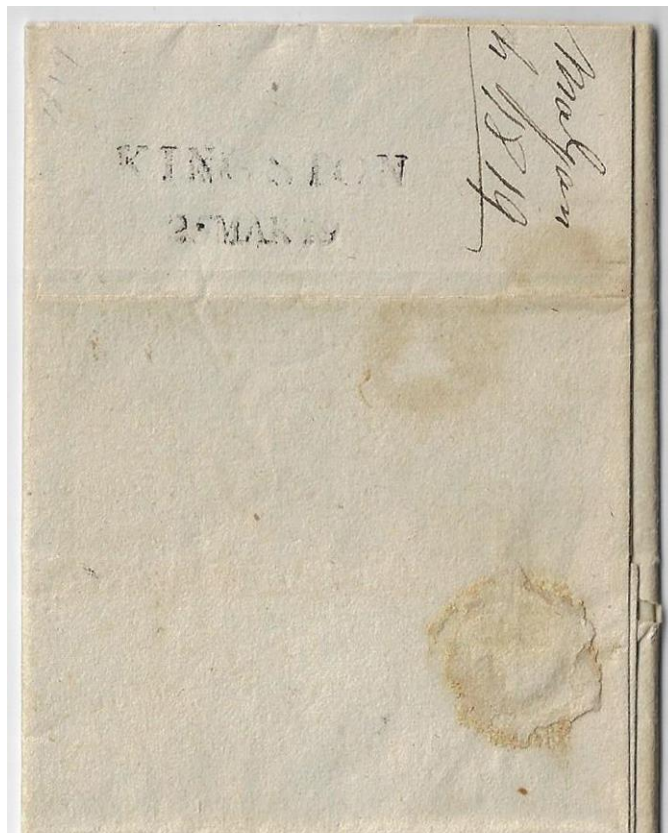




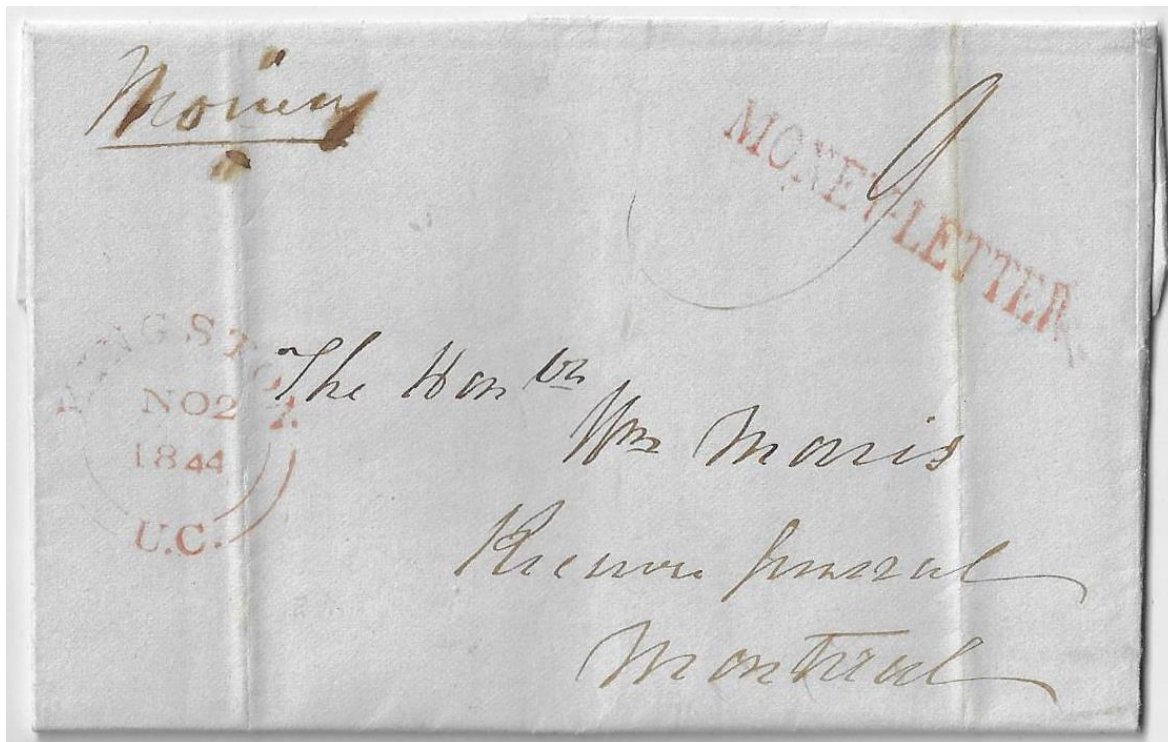
Item 552-01 – **Steamboat Letter Kingston "5"** – 1848, folded cover dated MY 11 48 from Kingston rated 7d collect to Cobourg (b/s). The cover was posted on board the Kingston-Toronto steamer "Princess Royal" with postal conductor's red Steam Boat Letter Kingston "5". As Cobourg was a port of call enroute to Toronto, the letter was put off the steamer for local delivery. The six steamboat handstamps ordered for Kingston were assigned to conductors 1,2,3 for Kingston-Montreal and 4,5,6 for the Kingston-Toronto route. Ex Parson, Sparks. \$600.00 **SOLD**



Item 552-02 – **Bytown Money Letter** – 1842, folded letter from Bytown, signed by Fraser, Fisher and Thompson, money letter rated 2/3 collect to Kingston. The message relates to a fine imposed for hawking marble slab in the town of Bytown. Exhibit quality. \$125.00 **SOLD**



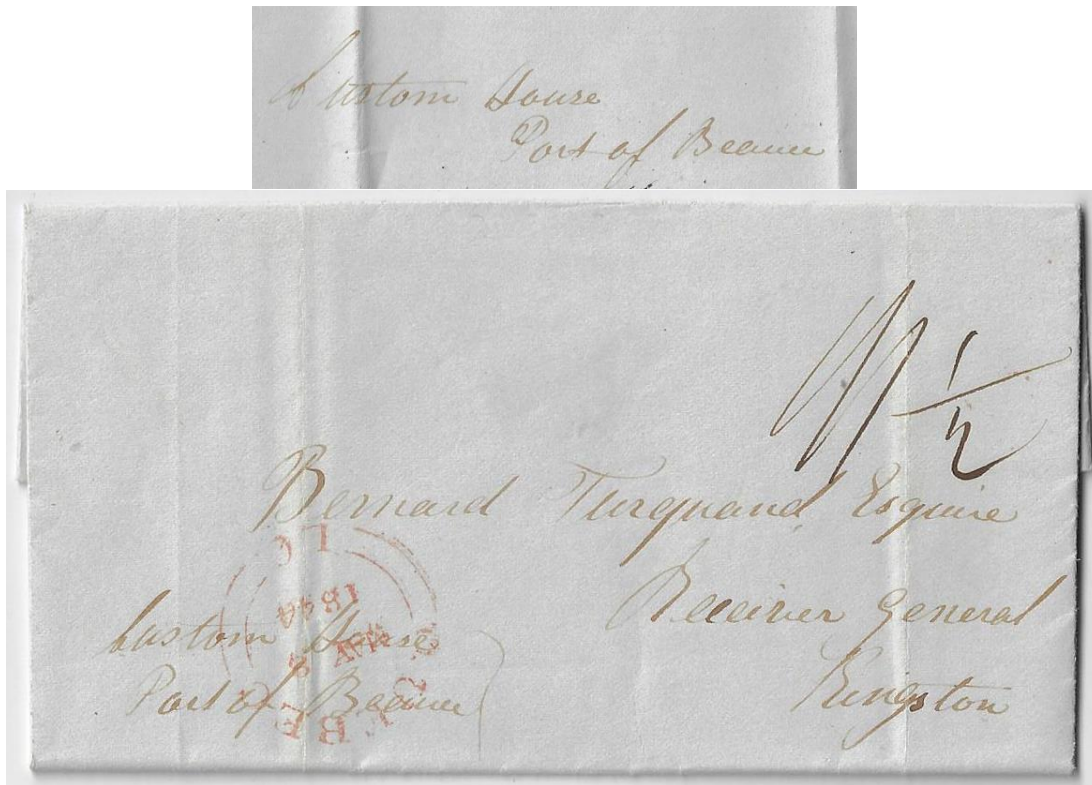
Item 552-03 – **Kingston Straight-line - theft** – 1819, business folded letter from Kingston with Straight-line KINGSTON 25 MAR 19 rated 1N collect to Montreal. The letter is from Patrick McGan and reads in part: *with much regret I have to acq you that on the night of the 14th feloniously broke into the tavern where I put up, some person or persons, broke open my trunk and took away all my money, my reason not making any remittance previous was. In order to sell all my goods and turn them in cash which I did Having them in my possession two hundred and thirty five pounds in gold and Montreal notes.....* Ex Lussey, Sparks. \$150.00 **SOLD**



Item 552-04 – **Kingston Money Letter** – 1844, money letter signed by David John Smith Treasurer, datelined Treasurer Office Kingston 2 NO 44, rated 9d collect to Montreal (b/s). \$100.00



Item 552-05 – **Brewer's Mills UC – More-To-Pay 7c** - 1864, stampless cover from Brewer's Mills UC (Frontenac County, the small Berri hammer, in red) paid 5c paying the letter rate to Manningville (b/s) via Kingston, Montreal and St. Remi (b/s). At Kingston, found shortpaid the double weight and charged 7c collect with More-to-Pay and 7c from the 7d Cy mutilated handstamp. Light reduction at left. Ex Sparks. \$150.00



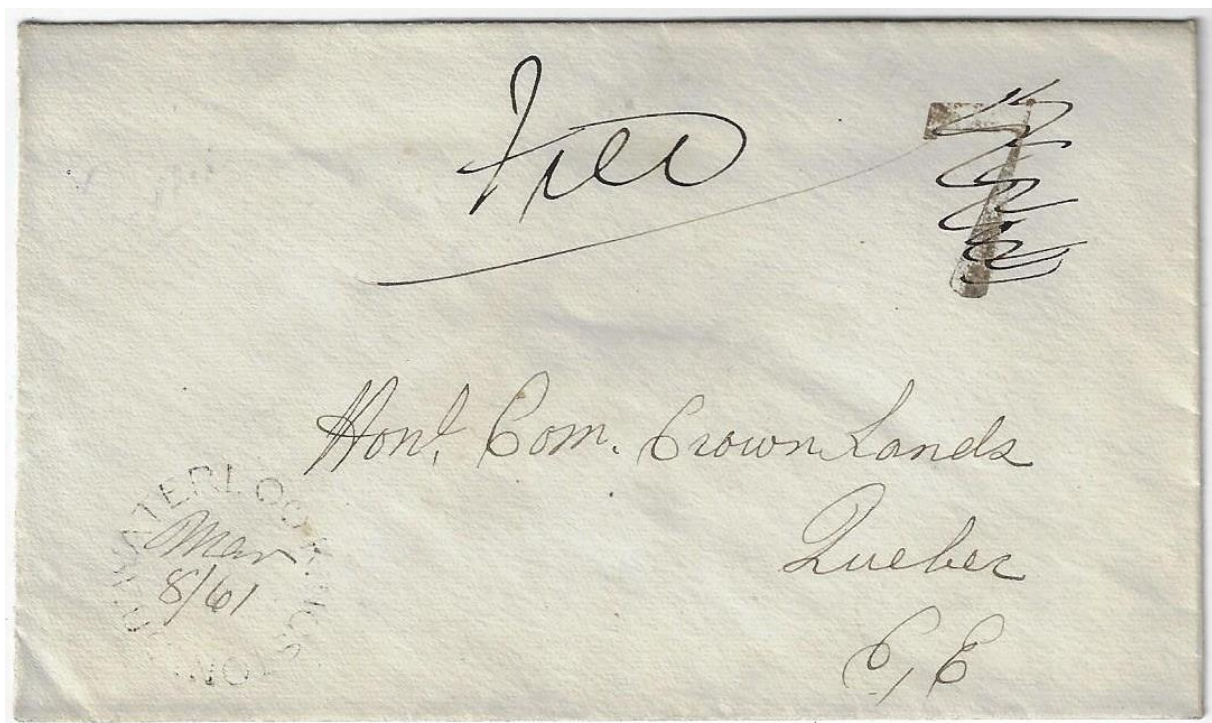
Item 552-06 – **Customs House - Port of Beauce LC** – 1844, Customs folded letter signed by Thomas Taschereau (*Collector of Customs*), datelined Customs House Port of Beauce, mailed at Quebec rated 11½d collect to Kingston. \$75.00



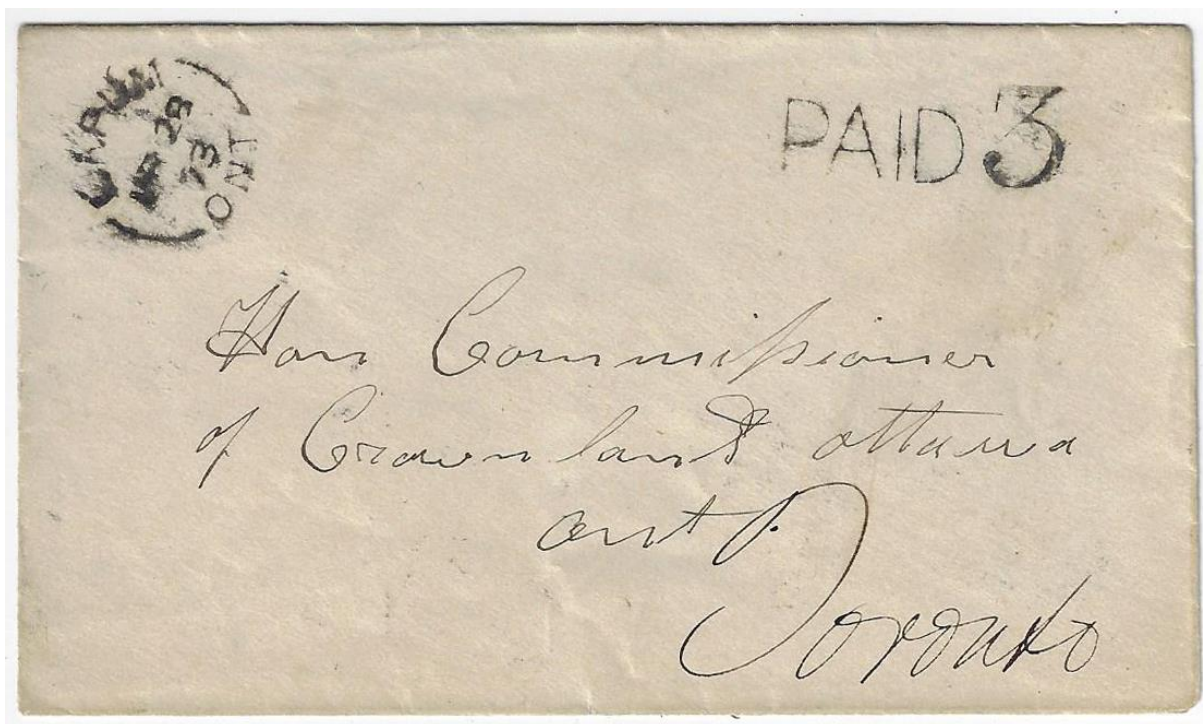
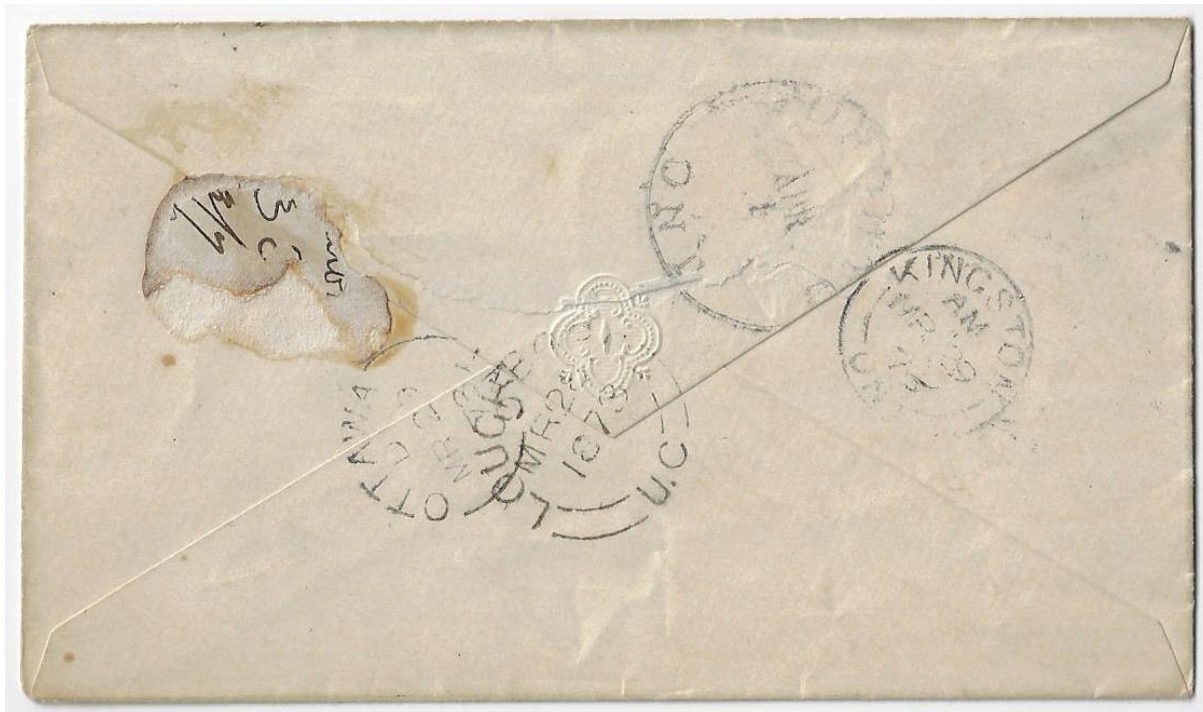
Item 552-07 – **Customs House - Kingston** – 1845, OHMS Customs folded letter signed by Thomas Kirkpatrick (*Collector of Customs*), datelined Customs House Office Kingston, rated 9d collect to Montreal. \$75.00



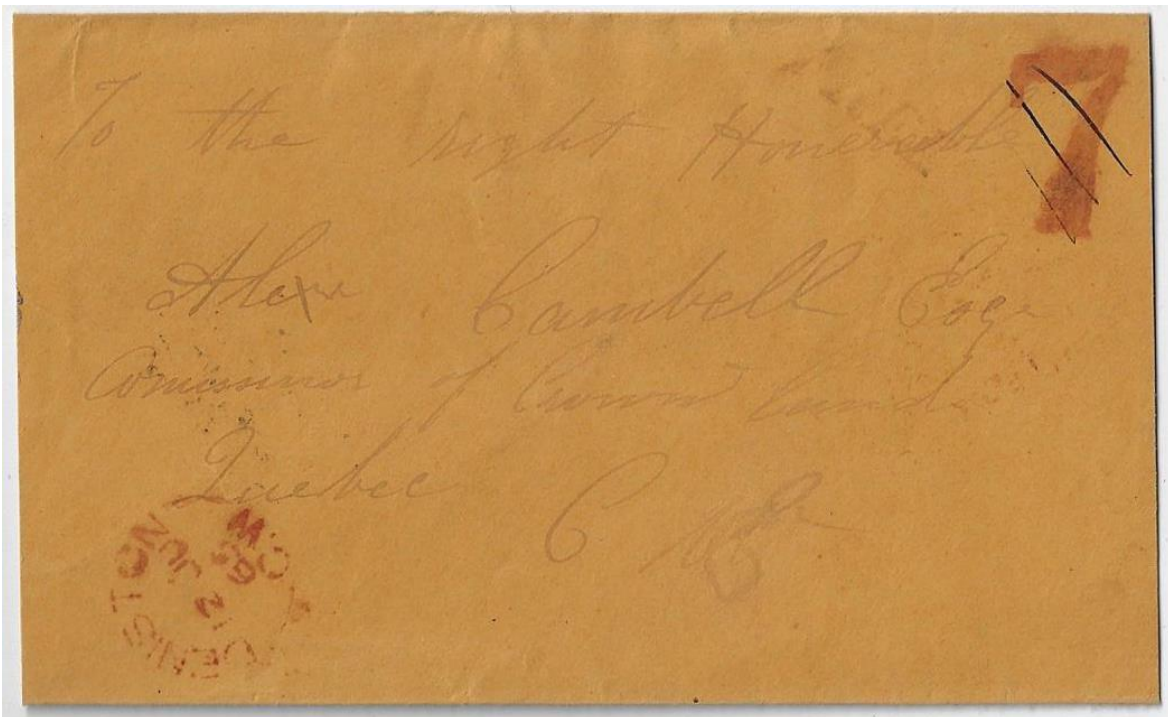
Item 552-08 – **Waterloo-Kingston UC (1851-1868)** – 1855, stampless cover from Waterloo-Kingston UC, struck in red with ms date, paid 6d / Canada Paid 10 Cts paying 10¢ cross border letter rate to Illinois. Routed via Kingston (b/s). A rare Frontenac County office which was closed in 1868. Small portion of back flap off. Ex Sparks. \$300.00



Item 552-09 – **Waterloo-Kingston UC (1851-1868)** – 1861, stampless cover from Waterloo-Kingston UC, struck in black with ms date, the latest recorded date MR 8 61. Initially rated 7¢ collect and rerated free to Quebec (b/s) via Kingston (b/s). A rare Frontenac County office which was closed in 1868. Ex Sparks. \$300.00



Item 552-10 – **Lapum Ont (Frontenac 1872-1874)** – 1873, stampless cover from Lapum Ont paid 3 paying 3¢ letter rate to Toronto (b/s) via Loughboro, Ottawa, Kingston (b/s). A top Ontario rarity and exhibit quality. Ex Sparks. \$500.00



Item 552-11 – **Deniston CW (Frontenac)** – 1865, stampless cover from Deniston CW rated 7¢ collect and rerated free to Quebec. Harrowsmith, Kingston and House of Assembly (b/s). A scarce office 1854-1878. Slightly reduced both sides. \$150.00



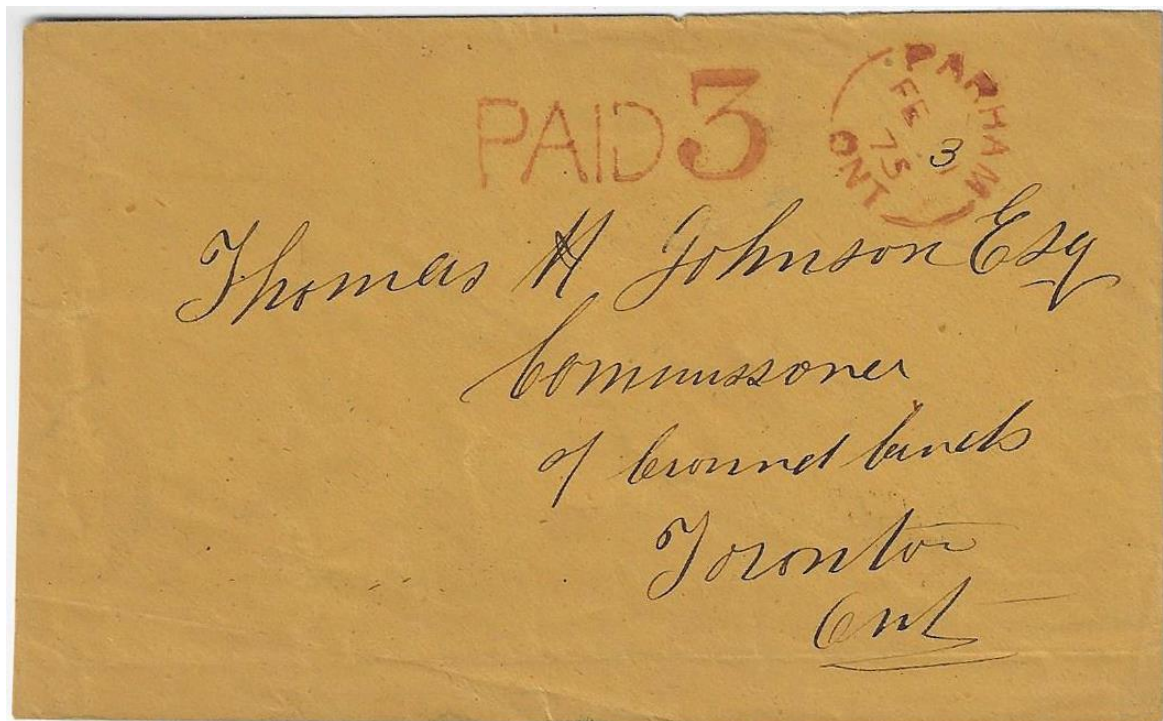
Item 552-12 – Sheriff's Office Kingston – 1856, stampless cover from the Sheriff's Office in Kingston, double ring oval in red, rated 3d to Toronto (b/s). Crease and small fault UL. \$100.00



Item 552-13 – Missent To and Forwarded – 1871, stampless cover from Kingston rated 5c collect to Toronto (b/s), missent to Belleville and then forwarded to Toronto. An interesting cover with two diff cds with inner arc hammers. \$75.00 **SOLD**



Item 552-14 – **Loughboro UC (Frontenac)** – 1864, stampless cover from Loughboro UC paid 5 to Quebec (b/s) via Kingston (b/s). This is the earliest recorded date of the 3rd Loughboro hammer. Office was closed in 1883. \$200.00



Item 552-15 – **Parham Ont in red (Frontenac)** – 1873, stampless cover from Parham Ont (2nd hammer) paid 3 paying 3c letter rate to Toronto (b/s) via Kingston (b/s). \$75.00

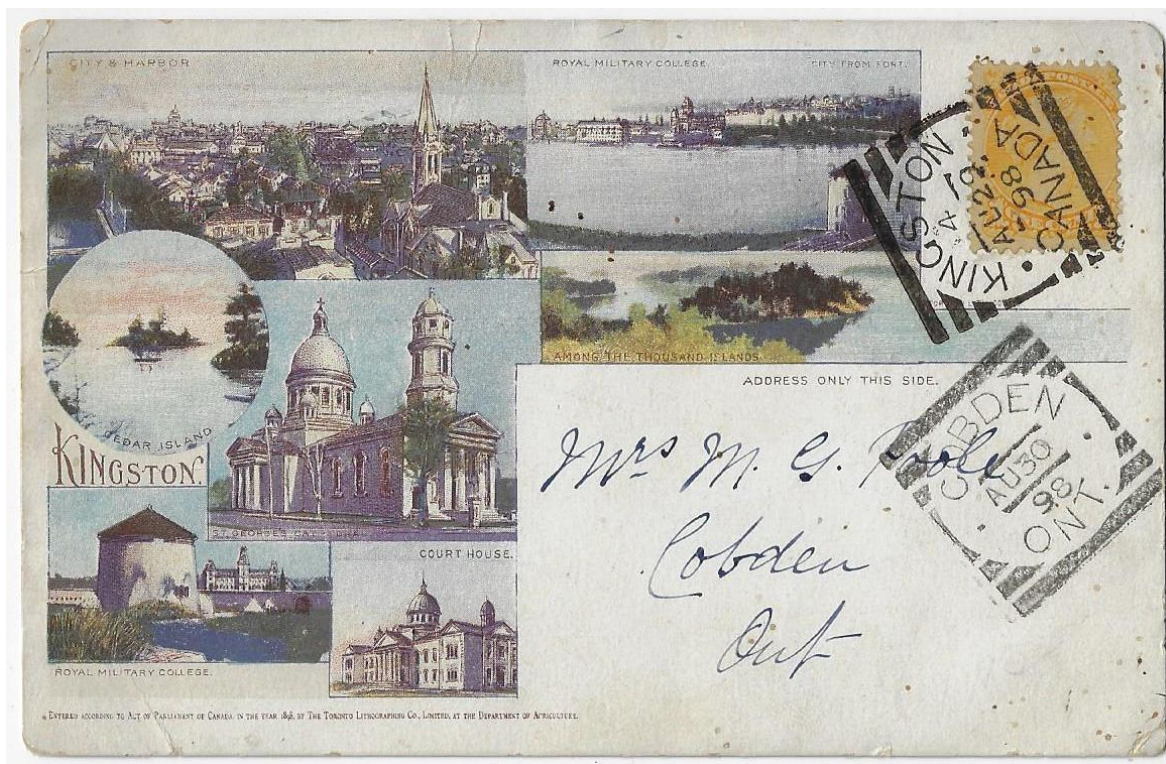

Item 552-21 – Donaldson's Mills 1891-1901 – 1893, 3¢ SQ (5) tied by unlisted fancy "sunrise" cancel on large cover cut-down to letter size paying 15¢ quintuple weight letter to Toronto (b/s) via Renfrew (b/s). Filing folds. A rare Frontenac County office in operation from 1891 to 1901. Ex Sparks. \$250.00

Sender attempted the printed matter rate as the card is not written, not accepted and charged 5. The 5 centimes converted to NZ 1d was paid by a 1d due stamp and tied by Mosgiel cds. A bit rough but still a very scarce NZ postage due item. \$300.00

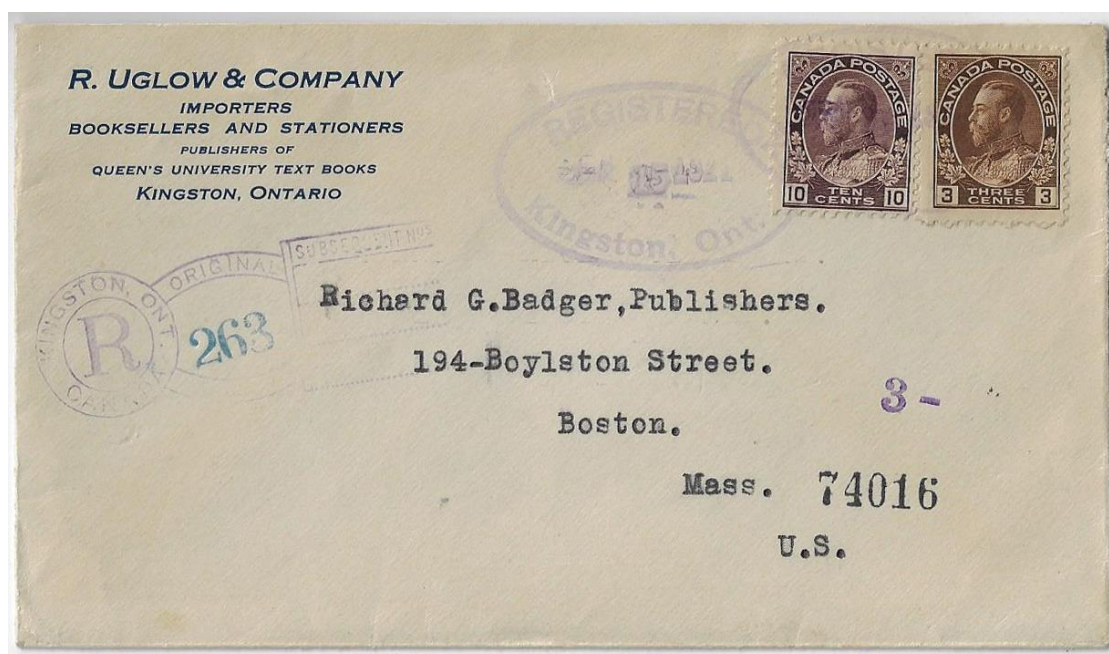

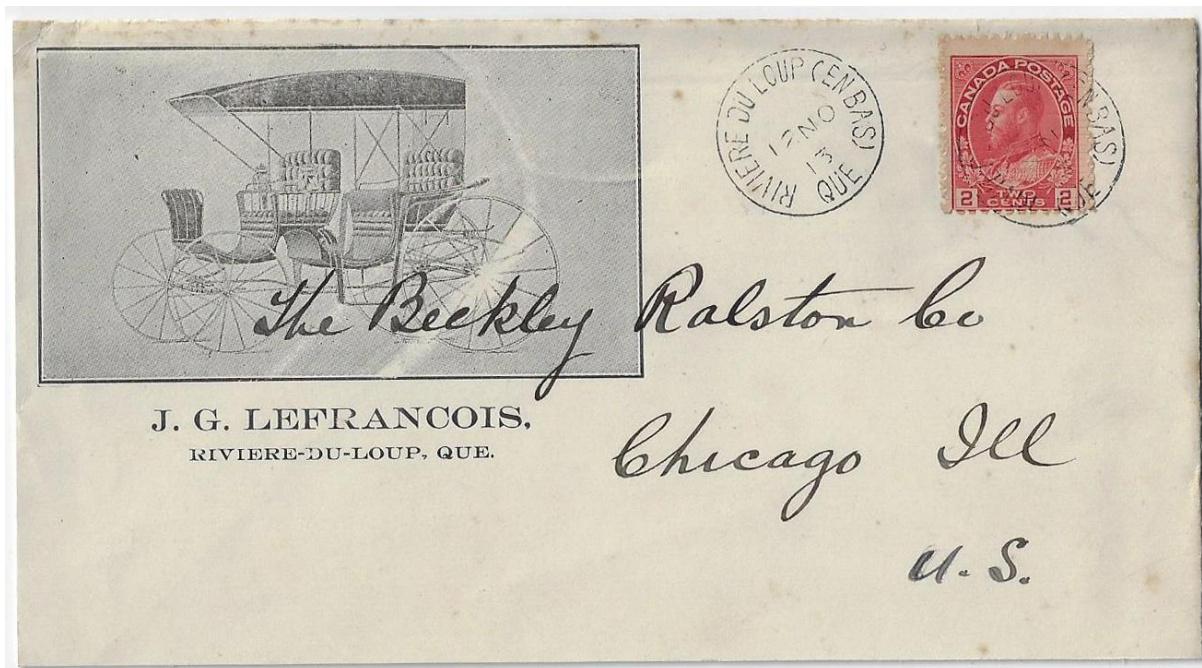

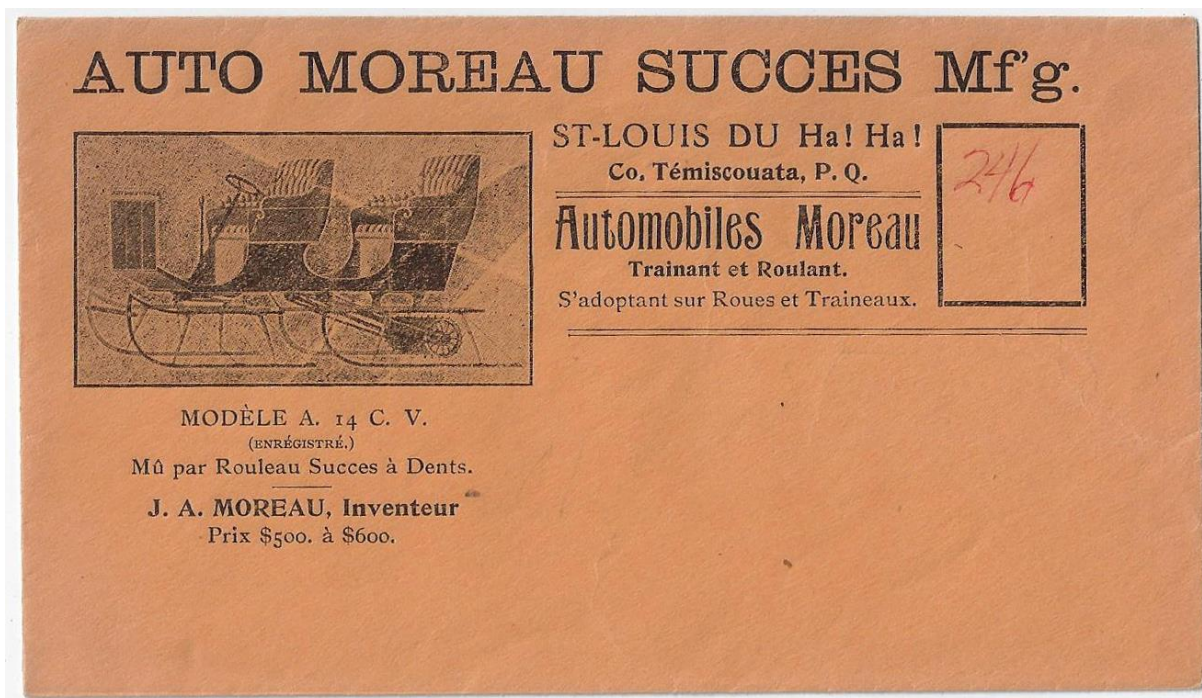
Item 552-49 – **Fort Henry POW Camp** – 1916, 1¢, 2¢ Admiral tied by Kingston Ont cds on cover from Fort Henry prisoner of war camp dated AUG 13 1916 paying 3¢ letter rate to Toronto. Passed by Internment Censor Kingston datestamp in blue, portion of back flap off, a tiny bite out of LR but still a very scarce Great War Canadian POW marking. This camp is historically known for a number of escapes and a famous tunnel discovered. The camp was closed in the spring of 1917 and prisoners moved to Kapuskasing. \$275.00



Item 552-50 – **Kingston Keyhole and Oval** – 1921, 3¢, 10¢ Admiral tied by oval Registered Kingston cancel on bookseller c/c cover paying 13¢ registered letter rate to U.S. (b/s). An interesting match of registration markings with oval and Keyhole handstamps on the same cover. Both rare. \$75.00

Item 552-57 – **Camp F trio – Fort Henry censored covers** – 1941, trio of Camp F covers from Germany to Fort Henry Ontario, all highly censored, addressed to Uffz junior non-commissioned officer ranks. Camp F was located at Fort Henry Kingston. Lot \$150.00 **SOLD**



Item 552-58 – **Military Post Office No.302** – 1940, 3¢ Mufti tied by Military Post Office No.302 (Barriefield Ont), device without city or location designation, on RCCS Corps of Signals cover paying 3¢ letter rate to Hamilton. \$20.00 **SOLD**
