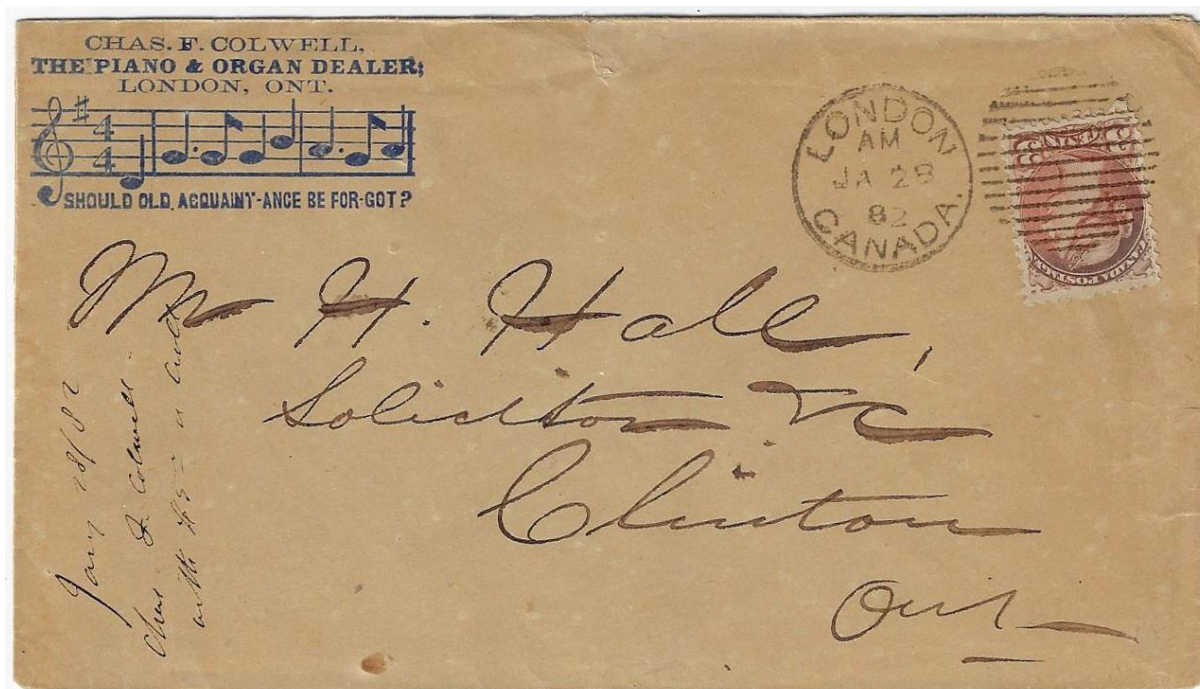
Item 553-07 – **Woodstock Ont - Ottawa & Prescott Railway** – 1869, stampless free franked cover from Woodstock Ont to Ottawa. Redirected to Toronto (b/s), still free franking and carried by Ottawa & Prescott Railway OC 18 69 PM (Gray ON-413). \$150.00



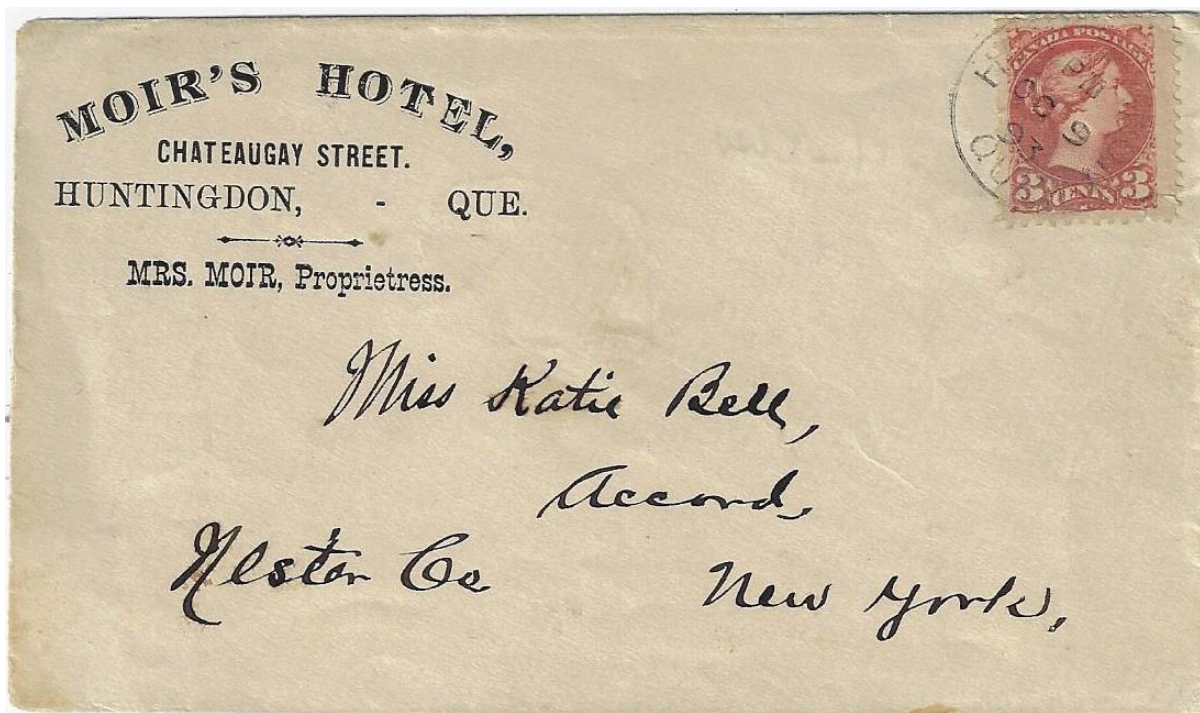
Item 553-08 – **2¢ double weight domestic printed matter** – 1880, 2¢ SQ tied by Quebec duplex cancel (*Quebec in the grid obliterator*) on unsealed cover paying 2¢ double weight unsealed printed matter rate to Dorchester N.B. 1¢ per 4 ounces. Looks ordinary but it is NOT. A very unusual rate on cover and more common for catalogs, reports and larger envelopes etc. \$150.00 **SOLD**



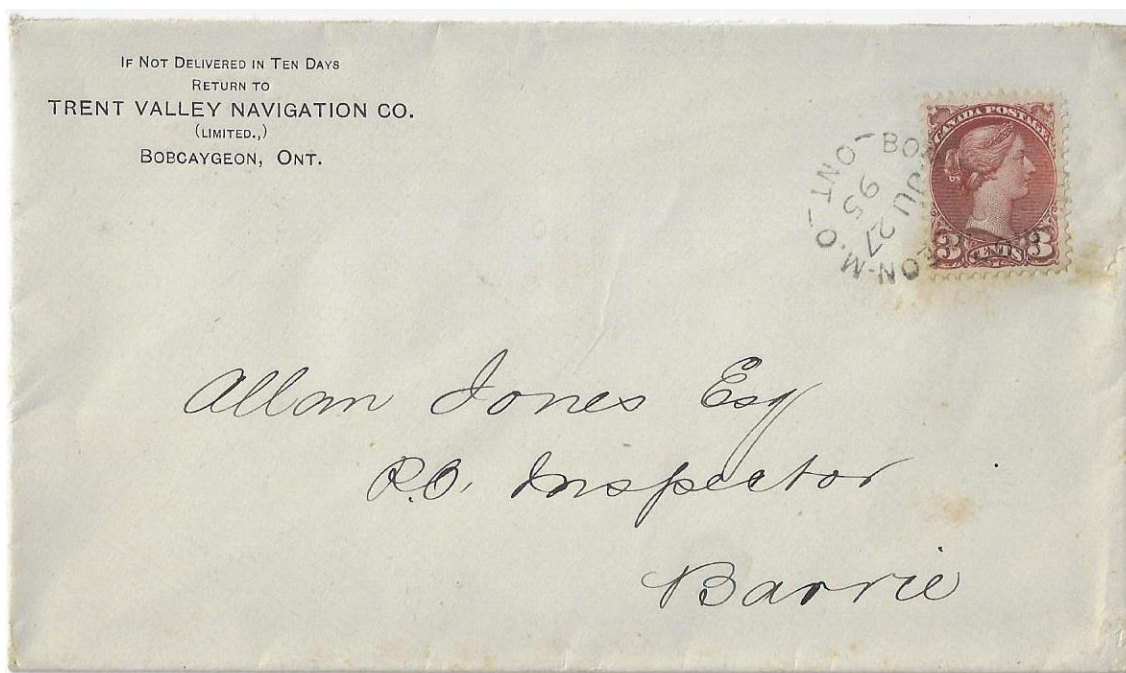
Item 553-09 – **1¢ UPU newspaper rate to Denmark** – c1890, 1¢ SQ tied by grid cancel on Henry Hechler wrapper from Halifax paying 1¢ UPU printed matter rate to Denmark (b/s). Filing fold at left but still a very pretty wrapper to a destination with nice clean receiver. \$200.00 **SOLD**

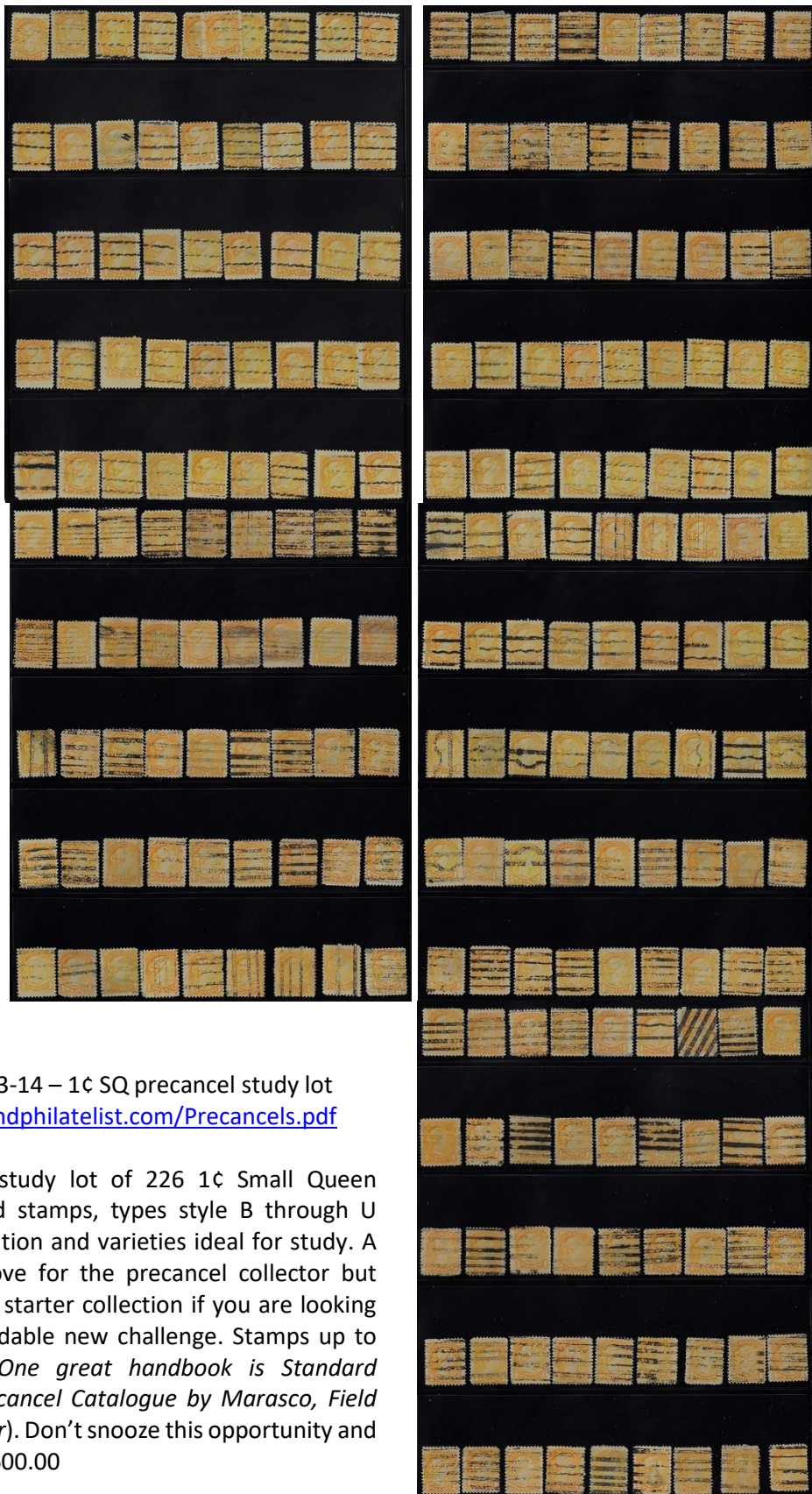

Item 553-13 – **Muskoka Falls Ont Crown seal as obliterator** – 1890, 3¢ SQ tied by large grid cancel and by Crown brass seal on cover from Muskoka Falls Ont paying 3¢ letter rate to Toronto (b/s) via Bracebridge (b/s). Occasionally, Crown brass seal usually used for packets or on wax sealed Post Office business correspondence, was used as cancels. Very desirable. \$100.00



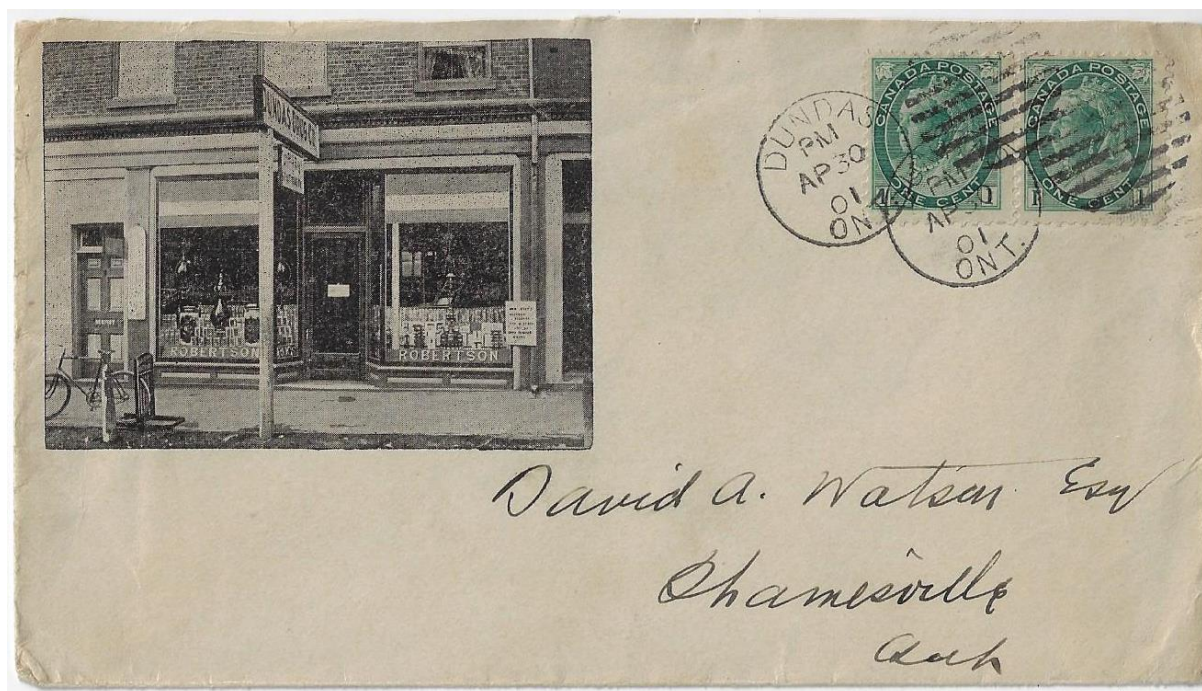

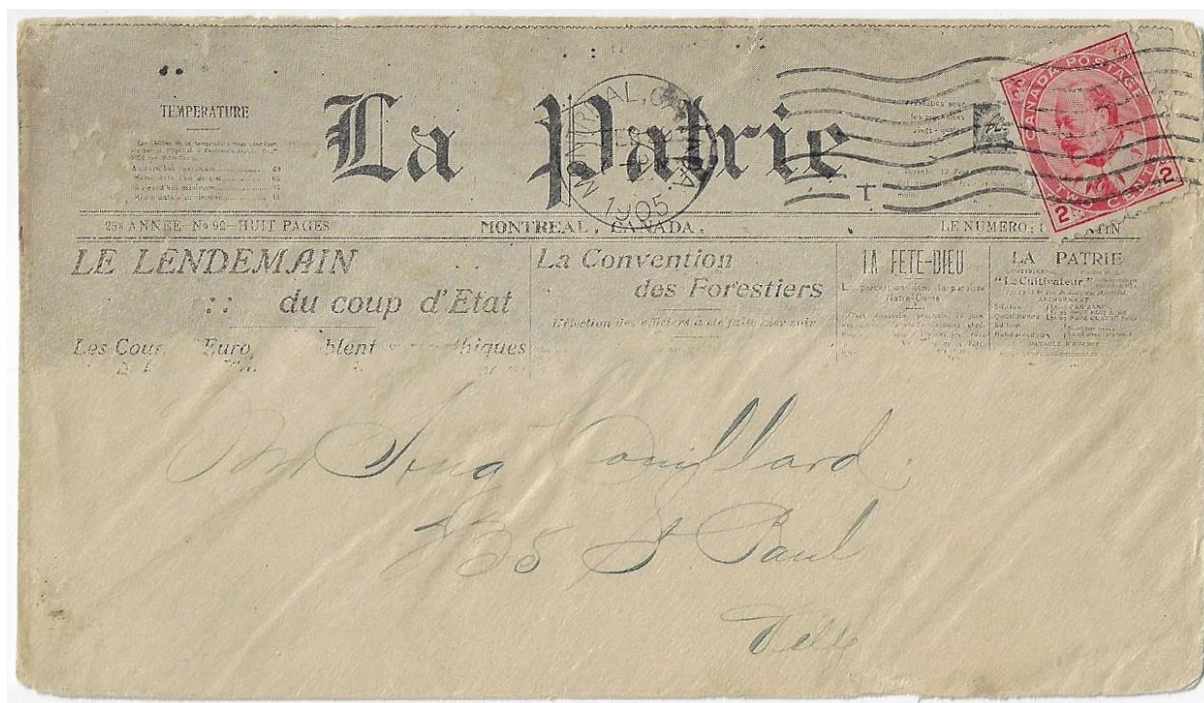
Item 553-25 – **Patriotic “Opening of Dundurn Park”** – 1900, 2¢ Numeral tied by Hamilton Bickerdike machine cancel on patriotic F.W. Fearman Co. Pork and Lard Packers advertising cover, *Come to Hamilton / Opening of Dundurn Park / Queen’s Birthday*, paying 2¢ letter rate to Moncton. \$150.00 **SOLD**



Item 553-26 – **Letter card from the Ottawa Exhibition** – 1900, 2¢ stationery letter card mailed from the Ottawa Central Canada Exhibition Post Office, SEP 18 1900, cancelled also with Ottawa Bickerdike, paying 2¢ letter rate to Dunham Que (b/s). The message reads in part: “Dear Sister - Our Exhibition is on and your humble servant is the officer in charge of the Post Office on the ground...we expect to see some of you this week - I wish Father could be here”. The exhibition was very agricultural with livestock and barns etc. The exhibition opening days were September 14 to 22. An interesting Ottawa Exhibition letter, from the Postmaster on the ground and real non philatelic. \$200.00 **SOLD**



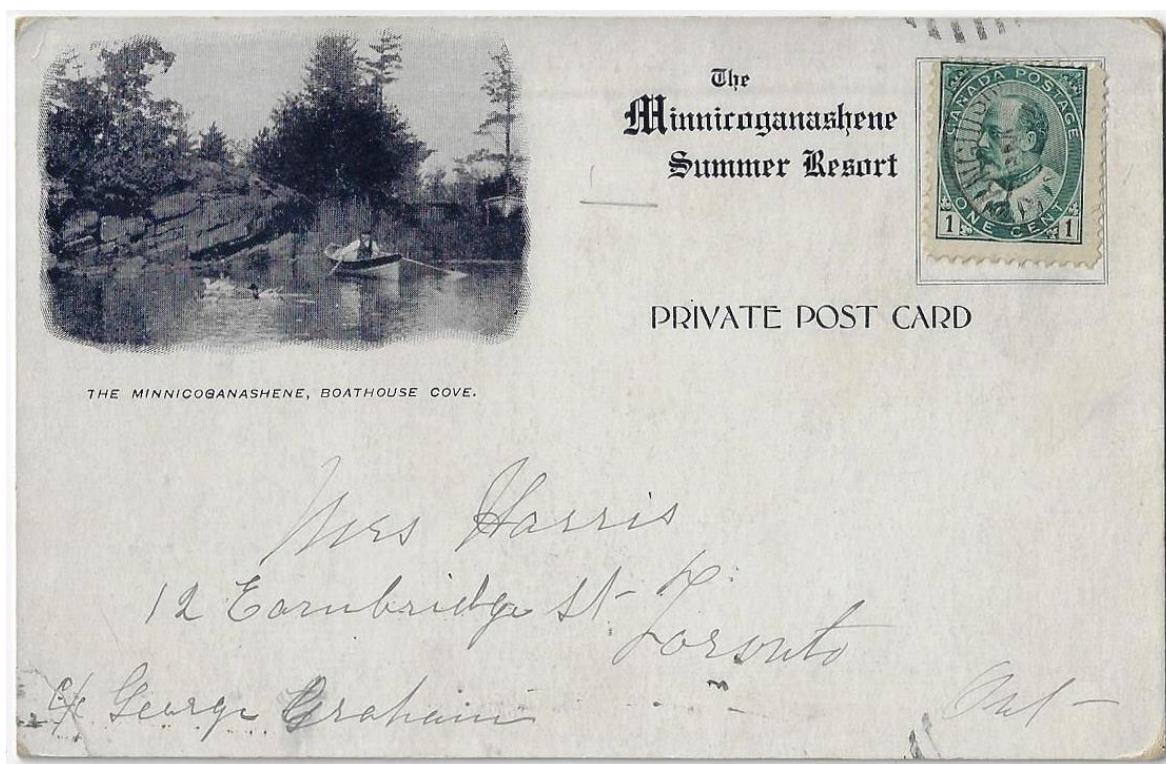
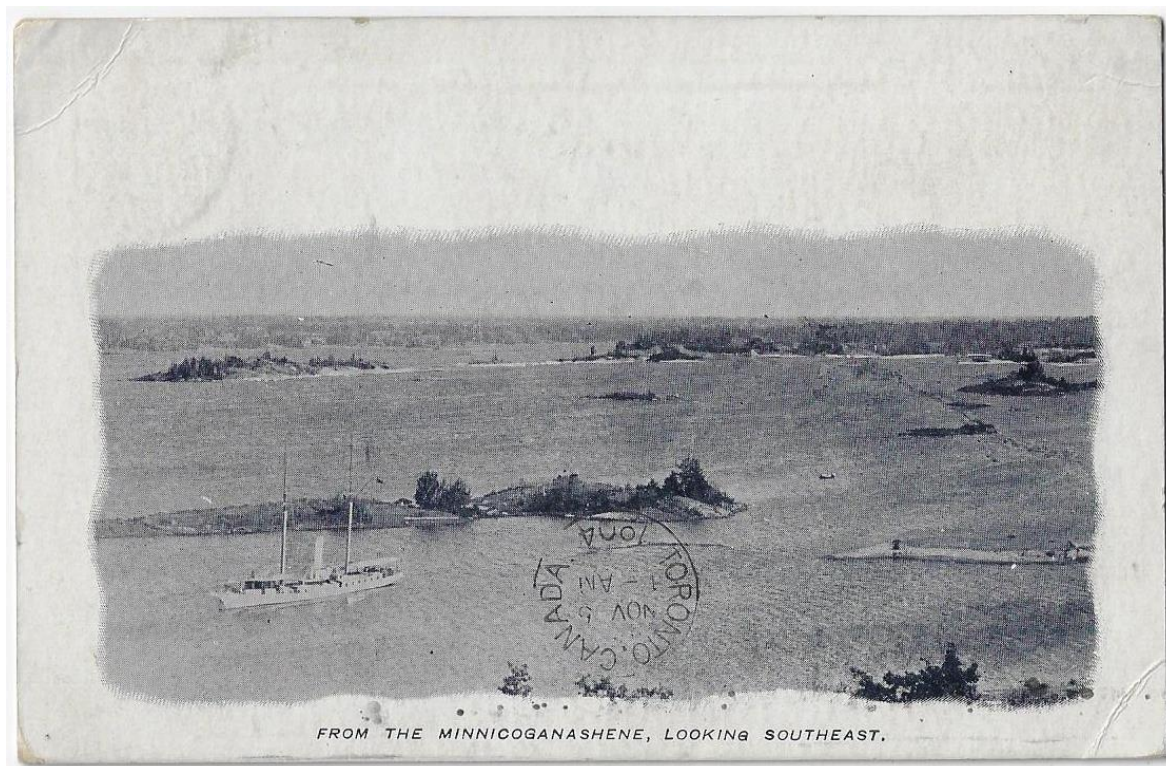

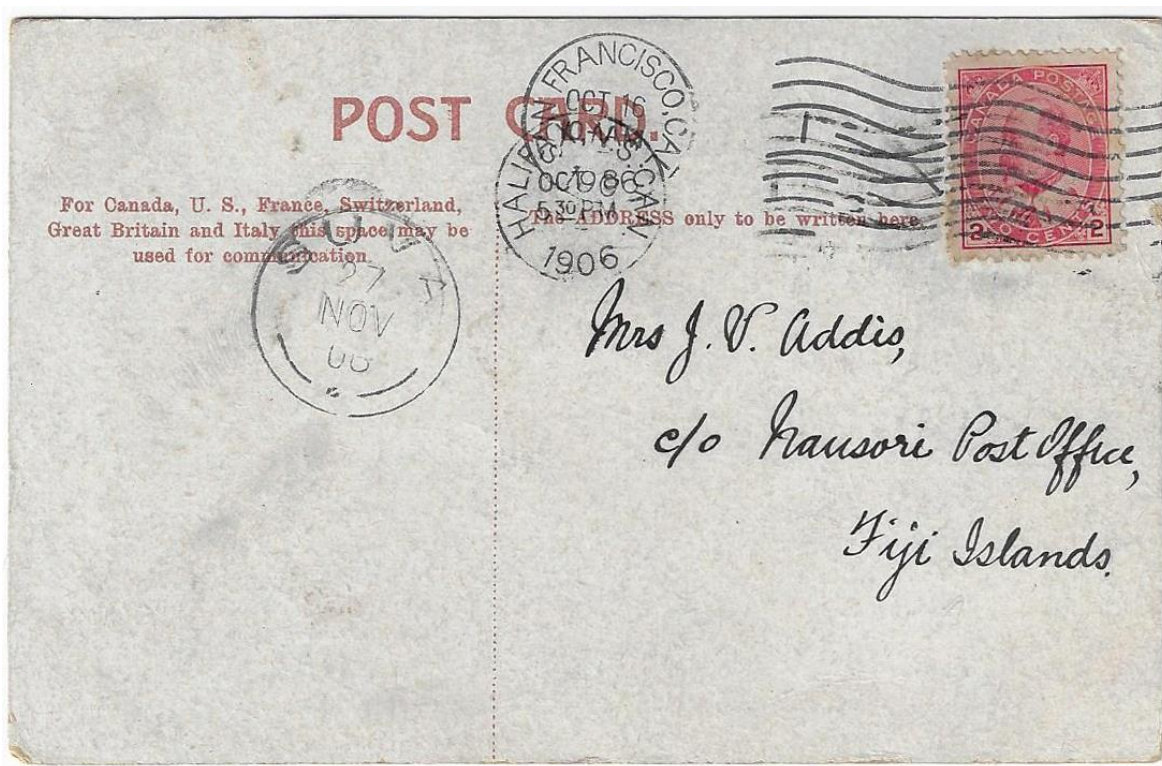
Item 553-28 – **Journal La Patrie (Montreal)** – 1905, 2¢ Edward tied by Montreal machine cancel on La Patrie Newspaper advertising cover paying 2¢ double weight drop letter rate. The Coup d'État on the Newspaper relates to the Russian Revolution of 1905 or the First Russian Revolution which began on 22 January 1905. An interesting double weight advertising cover. \$60.00



Item 553-29 – **Carmacks Yukon** – 1910, 2¢ Edward tied by grid cancel on Whitehorse Warwick & Rutter postcard from Carmacks Yukon paying 2¢ Empire postcard rate to Scotland. Not scarce but one of the finest I have had the pleasure to offer. \$125.00 **SOLD**



Item 553-30 – **Muskoka – Minnicoganashene Summer Resort** – 1904, 2¢ Edward tied by Penetanguishene Ont duplex cancel on summer resort private postcard from Minnicoganashene, boathouse and lake view illustrated, paying 1¢ postcard rate to Toronto (b/s). This card was probably mailed onboard somewhere in the Georgian Bay and entered the mail in Penetanguishene. \$75.00 **SOLD**

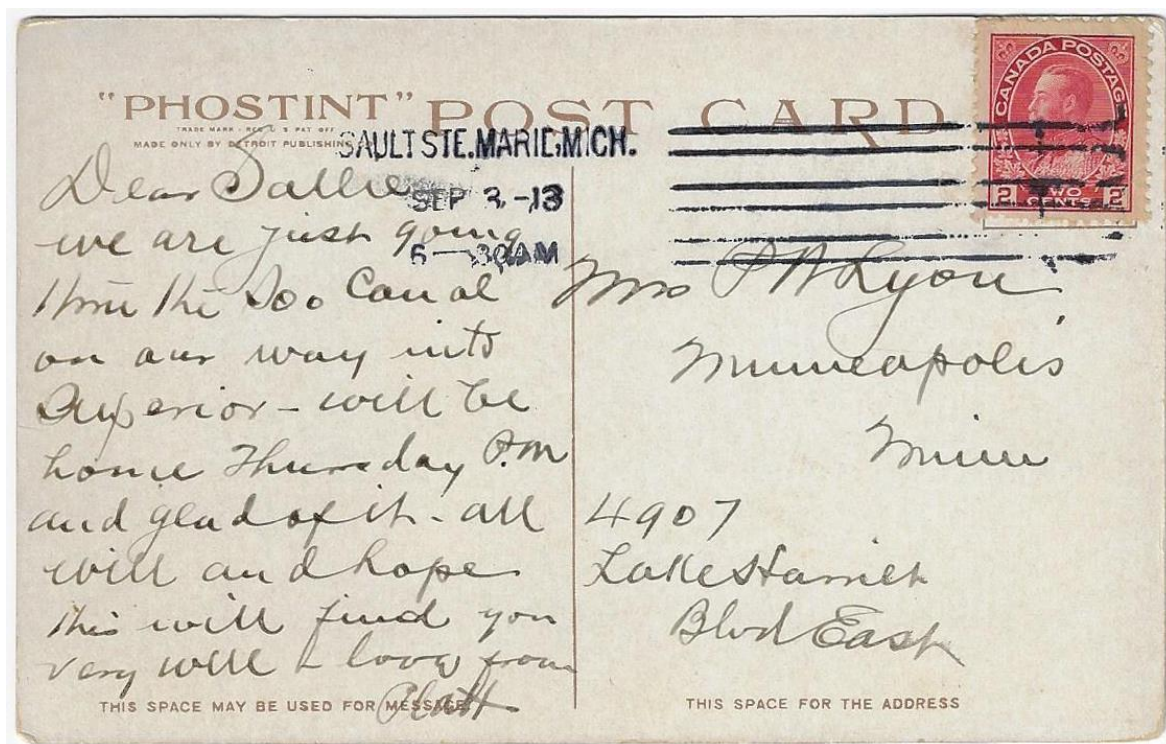
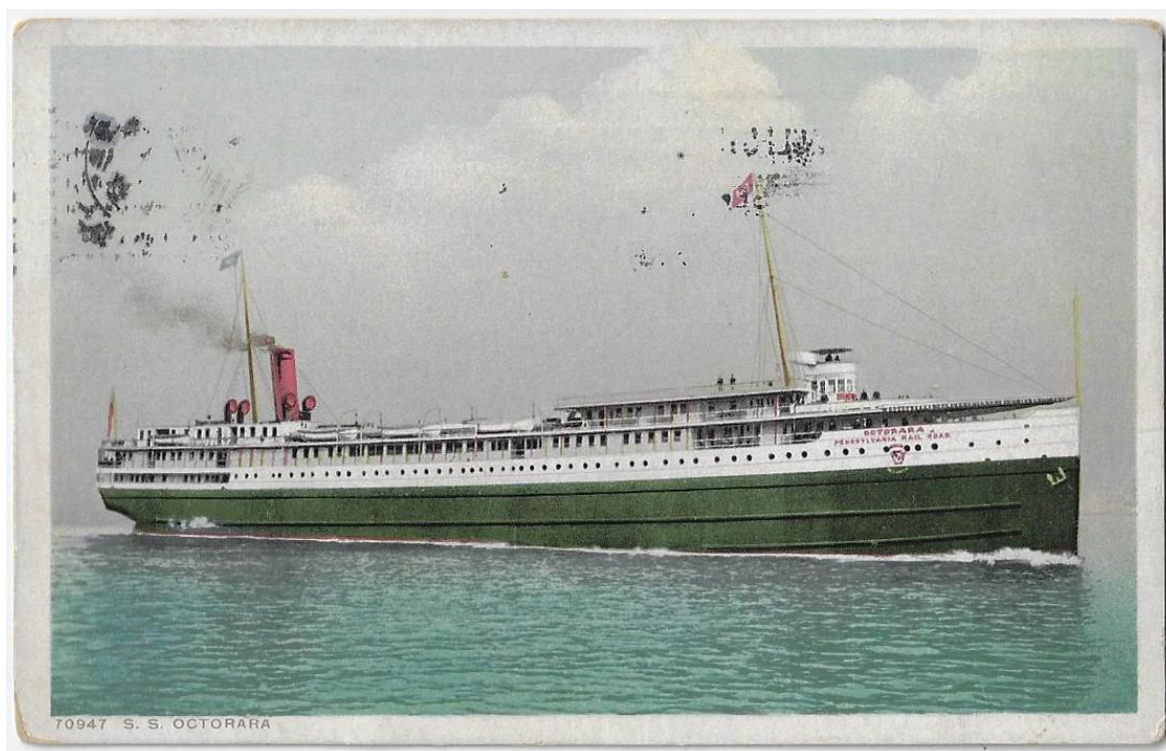
Item 553-32 – 1¢ Edward plate 44 single use – 1911, 1¢ Edward single from plate 44 tied by Tilsonburg Ont duplex cancel on postcard paying 1¢ PC rate to Simcoe. \$50.00 **SOLD**



Item 553-33 – 1c Edward PC cut squared, 1c Quebec by DLO – 1908, 1c Edward postal stationery card cut square tied by Toronto machine cancel attempting to pay 1c postcard rate. Not valid, caught, circle indicates invalid and sent to the Dead Letter Office for payment. 1c Quebec tied by Toronto DLO and forwarded to destination. An interesting 1c Tercentenary use. \$75.00



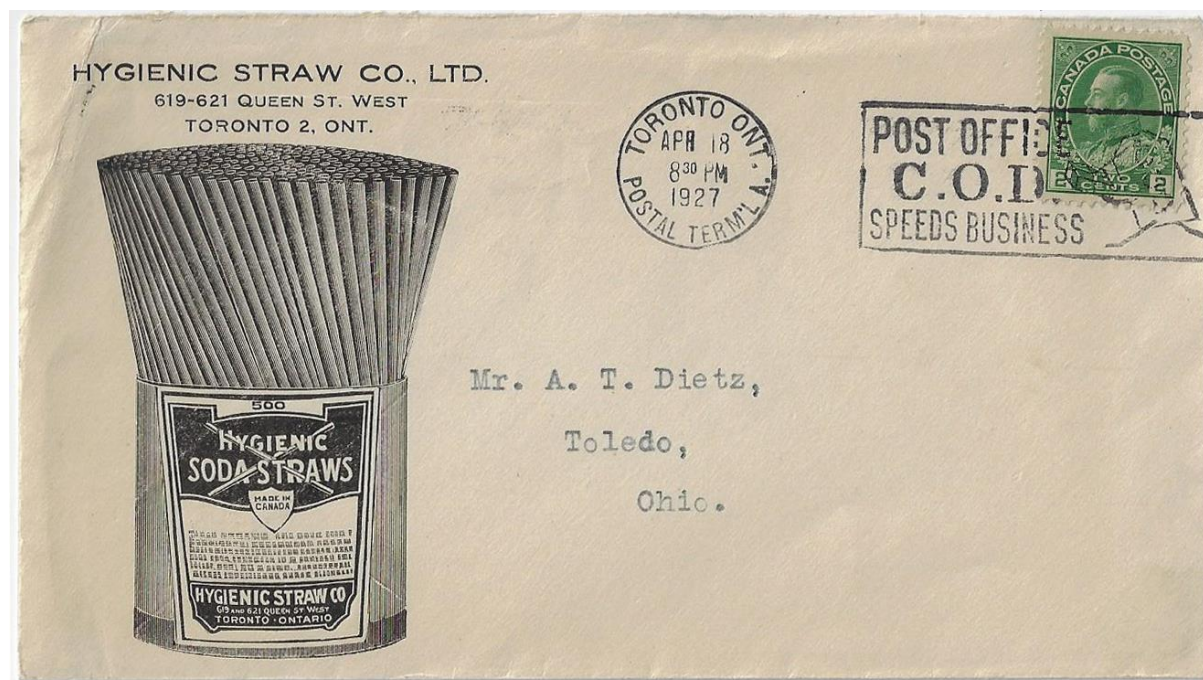
Item 553-34 – GB card shortpaid to Vancouver – 1924, GB 1d tied by Bridgwater cds on Royal Clarence Hotel RPPC underpaying the Empire postcard rate to Vancouver. T10, oval Vancouver Station C letter carrier, 2c Admiral added and delivered. \$30.00 **SOLD**



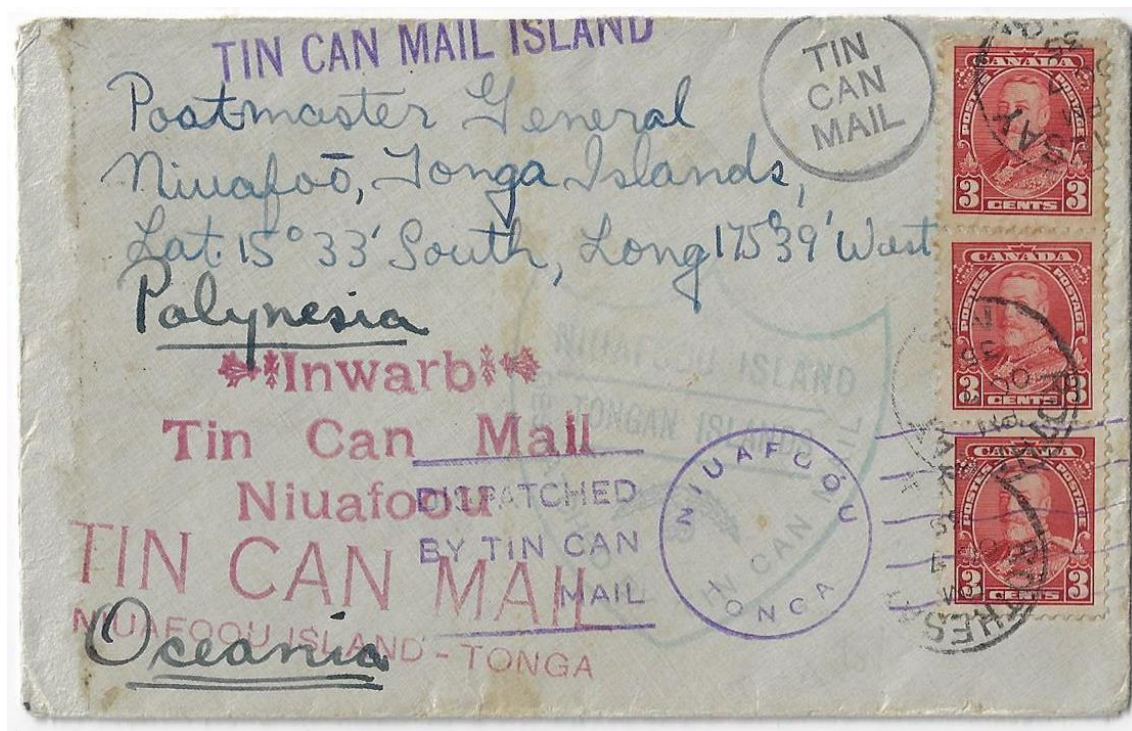
Item 553-35 – **Great Lake ship** – 1913, 2¢ Admiral on Steamship Octorara postcard, mailed onboard, entered the mail on the American side of Sault Ste. Marie in Michigan paying 2¢ postcard rate to Minnesota. \$30.00



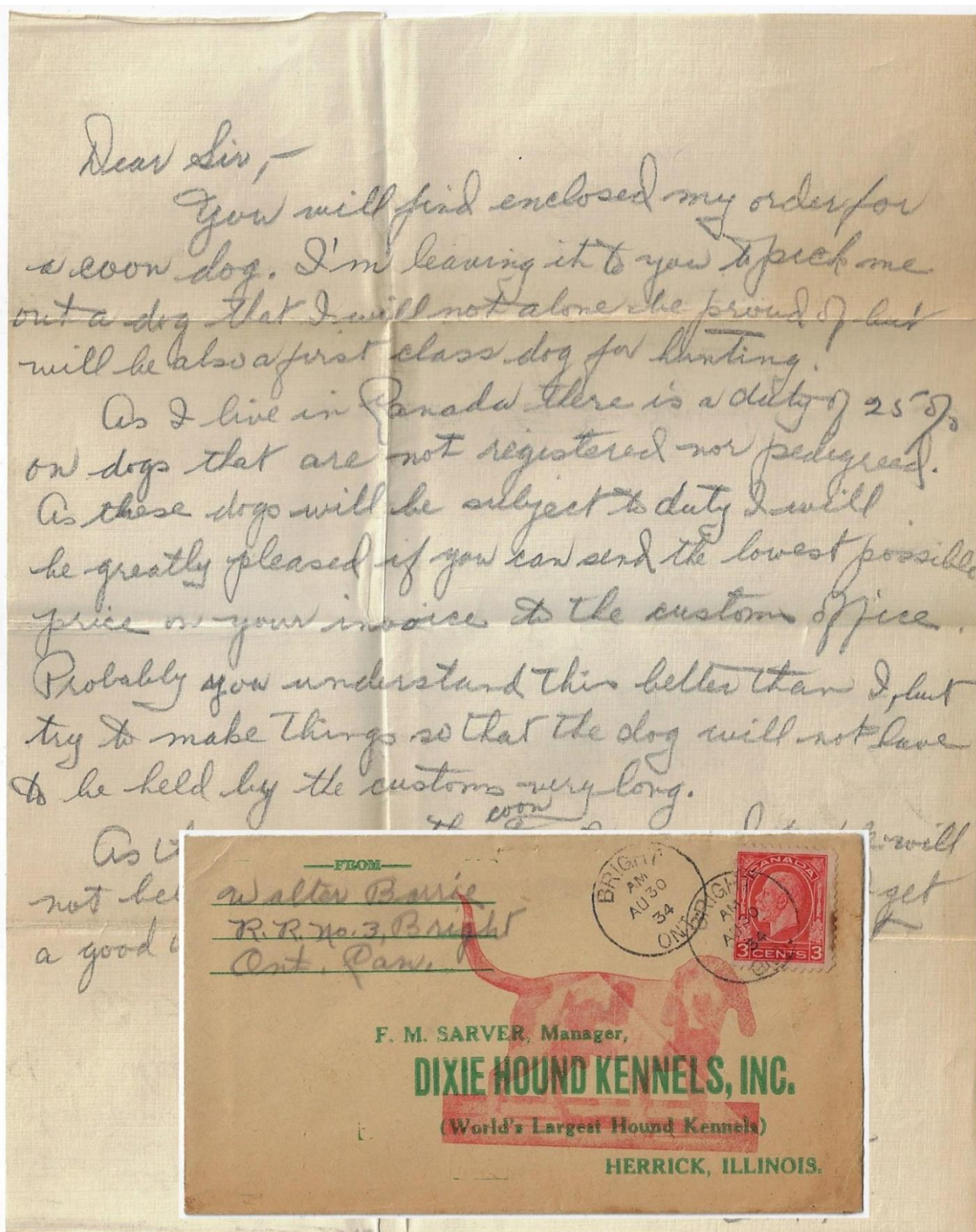
Item 553-36 – **Photo mailed from Niagara Camp** – c1915-6, 2¢ Admiral tied by Niagara-on-the-Lake Ont roller No.1 on YMCA illustrated wrapper (presumably a cover folded and opened as a wrapper), endorsed “Photo”, paying 2¢ double weight printed matter rate to U.S. A very pretty photographer’s rate, technically a printed matter rate. Seldom encountered. \$125.00



Item 553-37 – **Toronto Straw Company** – 1927, 2¢ Admiral tied by Toronto machine cancel on Hygienic Straw Co. advertising cover, the bane of the society, paying 2¢ letter rate to U.S. \$50.00

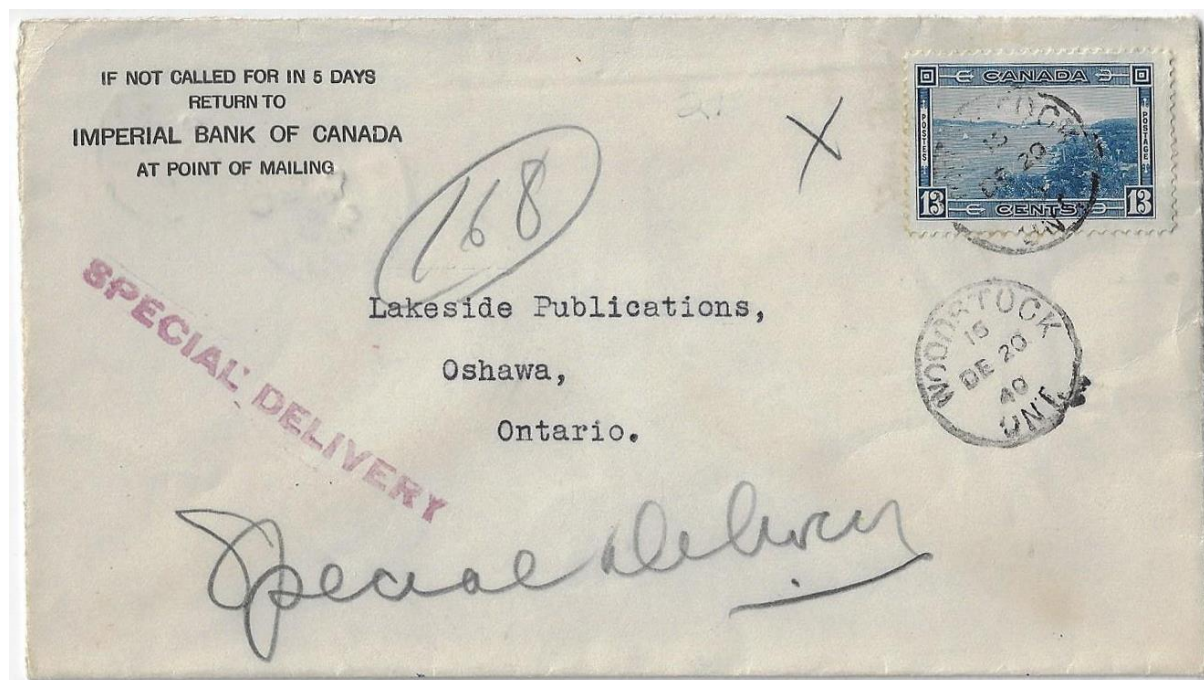


Item 553-38 – **Tonga Tin Can Mail** – 1936, 3¢ Pictorial (2) tied by Rothesay N.B. cds on cover paying 9¢ double weight preferential letter rate to Tonga Islands via Tin Can Mail Island and Polynesia Island. Since the tiny volcanic island of Niuafo’ou lacked a beach and harbour, mail was originally transferred from passing ships via tin cans to swimmers who brought the mail to shore. In the 1930’s a swimmer was killed by a shark and the mail was then collected by outrigger canoes. William Bishop Collegiate School philatelic origin. \$150.00 **SOLD**

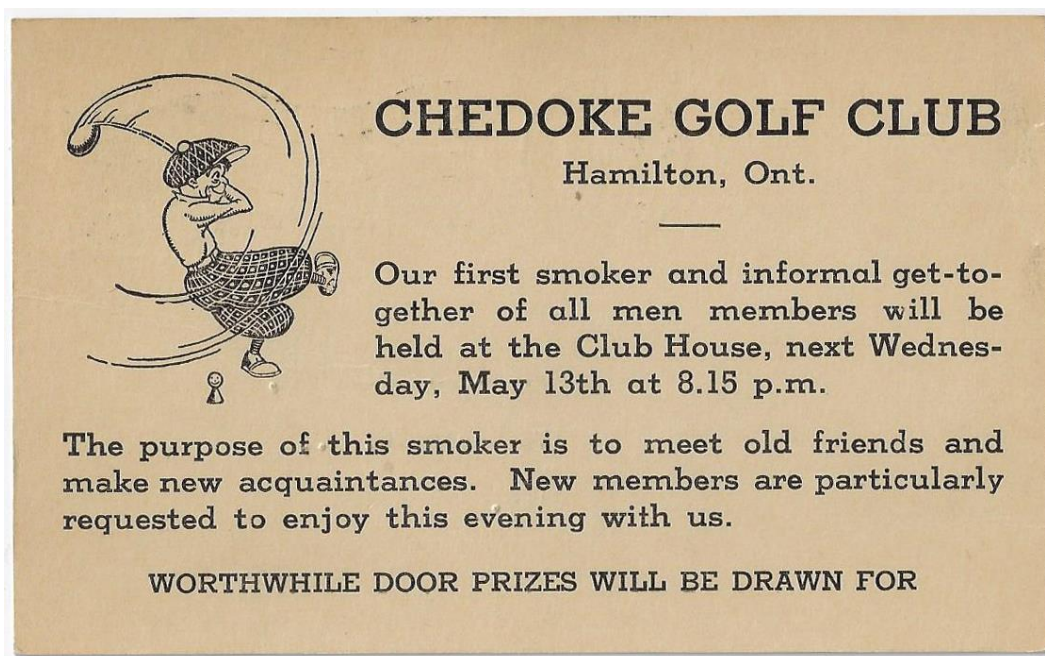
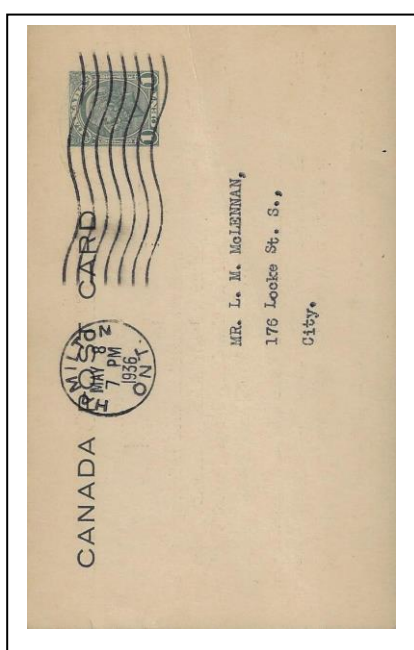


Item 553-39 – An order for a new coon dog and worries about Customs – 1934, 3¢ Medallion tied by Bright Ont cds on Dixie Hound Kennels Inc reply cover with letter paying 3¢ letter rate to Illinois. Dear Sir, you will find enclosed my order for a coon dog. As I live in Canada, there is a duty of 25% on dogs that are not registered nor pedigreed. You understand that this better than I but try to make things so that the dog will not have to be held by the Customs very long. \$50.00

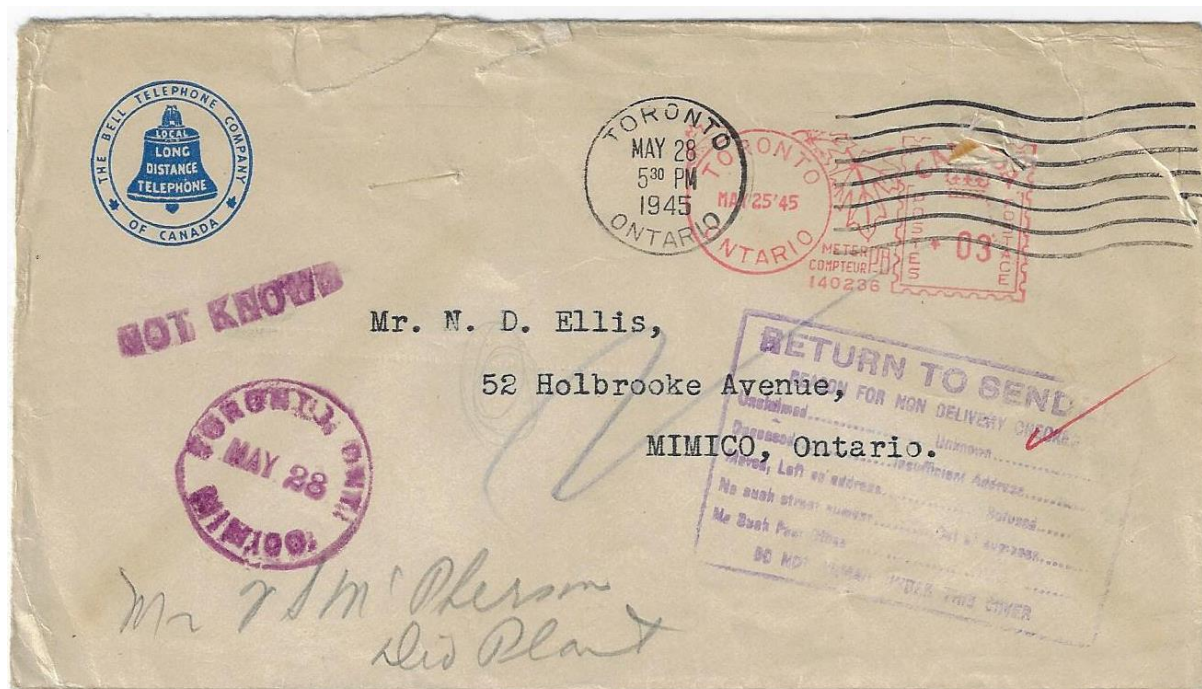

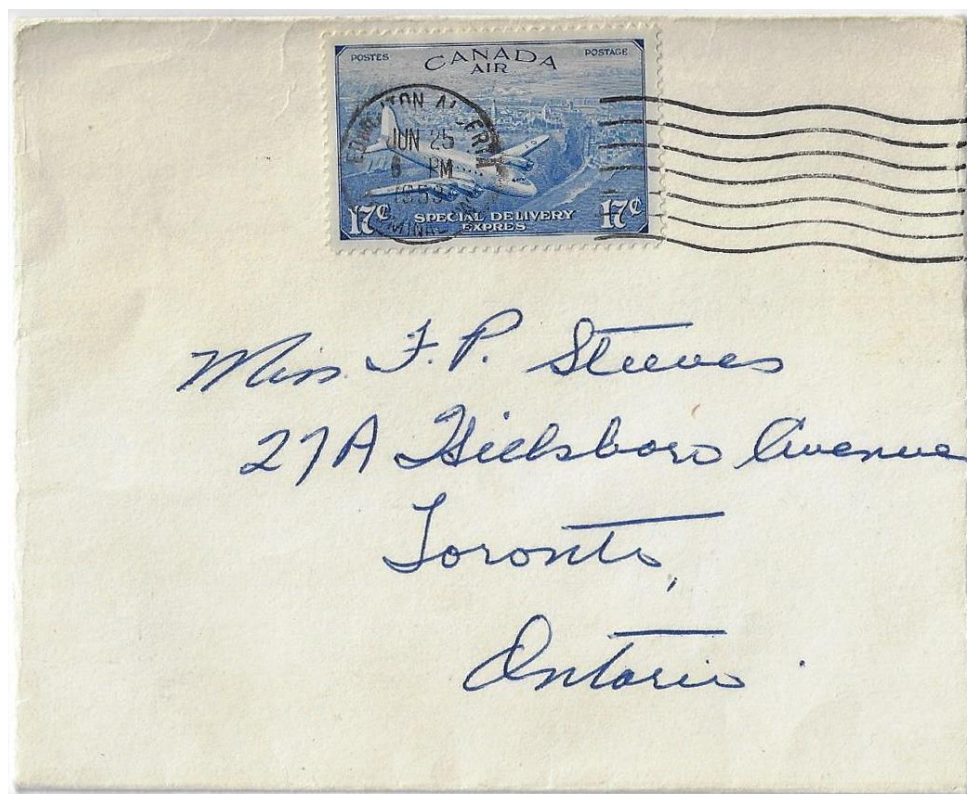

Unknown and returned to sender with Toronto Ont Mimico MOOD cancel. Toronto machine cancel on front as receiver. Roughly opened. A very scarce MOOD. \$40.00 **SOLD**



Item 553-45 – **5¢ GEOVI unrevised issued** – 1950, 5¢ GEOVI unrevised design issue tied by Sarnia Ont machine and cds on banking cover paying 15¢ special delivery letter rate to Ottawa. Odd payment with three 293's, 1¢ overpaid by convenience or perhaps by lack of lower denominations. \$30.00
