

Item 555-01 – <u>Amherstburg UC cross border</u> – 1858, stampless lady cover from Amherstburg UC paid 6d with Canada 10 Cents exchange marking paying the cross border letter rate to Michigan via Windsor (b/s). Exhibit strikes. \$75.00 <u>SOLD</u>




Item 555-02 – <u>Kingston Post Office Inspector</u> – 1894, OHMS Post Office business cover (form 35,000 8-11-93) with P.O. Inspector's Office Kingston Canada, mailed from Kingston free registered to New Jersey, US. Toronto and New York transit (b/s). \$100.00



Item 555-03 – <u>Canadian poet and Post Office Dept clerk</u> – 1871, free franked cover from Ottawa signed by Charles Sangster (1822-1893), in Sangster's hand and initialed C.S., the Canadian poet and Post Office Dept clerk, to Henry Morgan. The cover is also signed in red by the Deputy Postmaster General, William Henry Griffin. \$125.00



Item 555-04 – <u>Toronto Post Office Dept (signed M.S.)</u> – 1877, OHMS free franked cover (form 30,000 21-3-77) from Toronto initialed M.S. / P.O.D. Post Office Dept to the Supt Postal Railway Service in New York (b/s). \$100.00



Item 555-05 – <u>Orangeville UC 22mm D.G. Berri hammer</u> – 1858, stampless cover from Orangeville UC with 22mm double broken circle from the D.G. Berri order of 1857, the current earliest recorded date, rated 3d collect to Toronto (b/s). Ex Graham. \$275.00



Item 555-06 – <u>Hamilton Berri duplex – Allan Line</u> – 1868, 12½¢ Large Queen tied by Hamilton CW Berri duplex cancel (1860-1869) on cover, Hamilton ONT accompanies (1867-1873), paying 12½¢ Allan Line letter rate to Scotland (b/s). Charged to box account 35. Carried by the Peruvian from Quebec to Liverpool. Entered in Glasgow. Light fold but not affecting stamp. A beauty! \$300.00



Item 555-07 – <u>Cameo advertising – Quebec</u> – 1895, 3¢ SQ tied by Quebec Canada duplex cancel on Bresse & Co. Boots & Shoes cameo advertising cover paying to Arichat N.S. (b/s). Opened and small tear at right. \$50.00



Item 555-08 – <u>Cameo advertising – Waubaushene Ont</u> – 1884, 3¢ SQ cancelled by light smudge cancel on Georgian Bay Lumber Co. embossed cameo advertising from Waubaushene Ont paying 3¢ letter rate to Toronto. \$100.00





Item 555-10 – <u>Cameo advertising – Peterborough</u> – 1897, 3¢ SQ tied by Peterborough squared circle on Walter Pater & Son Tanners and Leather Merchants embossed cameo advertising paying 3¢ letter rate to Havelock (b/s). Fold at right affecting stamp. \$35.00



Item 555-11 – <u>Cameo advertising – Montreal</u> – c1890, 3¢ SQ tied by Montreal duplex cancel on John Jones & Co. embossed cameo advertising paying 3¢ letter rate to U.S. (b/s). Small tear at top. \$35.00



Item 555-12 – <u>Cameo advertising – Shediac NB</u> – 1899, 2¢ Numeral tied by RPO cds on Weldon House embossed cameo advertising cover paying 2¢ letter rate to Sussex (b/s). \$50.00

Signed by Bourinot the House Clerk. From the Annie Howells and Achille Fréchette Correspondence. Small tears on flap. \$75.00 SOLD

Item 555-21 – <u>Jubilee – Buckingham Que registered</u> – 1897, 2¢, 5¢ Jubilee tied by Buckingham Que duplex cancel on cover paying 7¢ registered letter rate to U.S. (b/s) via Montreal (b/s). \$125.00









Item 555-25 – Quebec Board of Health free franked cover – 1896, Montreal Imperial machine cancel, die E flag 1-6, on OHMS Board of Health free franked cover to Ste. Sabine (Missisquoi). Unused free franked reply folded letter accompanies. A very unusual piece with a lovely and perfect Imperial 1-6. \$75.00 SOLD




Item 555-32 – Merry Christmas – 1898, 2¢ Map tied by Halifax squared circle dated DE 25 98 on cover paying 2¢ Empire letter rate to Scotland. Endorsed "Thanks so much for stamps and letter, will write you soon, Fred Pearson". Interesting as this kind of endorsed with strongly prohibited. A significant tear at top through the endorsement. Still a lovely first day Map cover. \$650.00 SOLD





Item 555-33 – <u>Brockville – Ontario Glove Works</u> – 1907, 1¢ Edward tied by Brockville Ont duplex cancel on James Hall Ontario Glove Works private postcard paying 1¢ postcard rate to Pakenham (b/s). Gloves, mitts and suspenders. \$75.00






Item 555-34 - **123**rd **Battalion CEF** - 1916, GB ½d tied by Liverpool machine cancel on Postal Card Telegrapm 123rd Battalion CEF to Devonshire (b/s). The card is from a British born soldier of the 123rd Canadian Expeditionary Force to his mother in the English countryside. The original 129th Wentworth Battn CEF was based in Dundas Ontario. In August 1916, it was incorporated into the 123rd and 124th Battns. A very scarce WW1 card. \$100.00 **SOLD**



Item 555-35 – <u>Letter card "Canada" postally used</u> – 1915, Letter card "Canada", illustrated with miniature reproductions of the engraving from the original plate artistically produced (*camps, Zeppelins etc*), datelined St. Martyns Plain, mailed from Shorcliffe Camp to Norwich Ontario. Interesting message to dad with explanations on camps etc. Aging but still a spectacular WW1 item, complete and postally used. \$75.00 **SOLD**



Item 555-39 – 1¢, 2¢ Admiral blocks on cover – 1922, 1¢ block, 2¢ block plus a single tied by Hamilton cds on cover paying 13¢ registered letter rate to U.S. (b/s). Seldom seen franking. \$40.00








Item 555-43 – <u>Barrington Que buttermaker</u> – 1921, 3¢ Admiral tied by a late use of the SQ era concentric ring cancel on G.F. Haney Buttermaker advertising cover paying 3¢ letter rate to St. Hyacinthe. The cover is addressed to the Dairy School. \$60.00




Item 555-44 – <u>Canada Greece patriotic</u> – 1914, 2¢ Admiral tied by Toronto machine cancel on Canada Greece patriotic c/c cover paying 2¢ letter rate to U.S. It might be from the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of Canada in Toronto. Rare. \$85.00




Item 555-45 – Rare - Saskatoon Buy Victory Bonds – 1919, 3¢ Admiral tied by Saskatoon "Let Us Not Demobilize Patriotism – Buy Victory Bonds" (L-230) on Johnson Duesbury & Co. Brooms c/c cover paying 3¢ letter rate to U.S. A rare slogan and grossly undercatalogued. \$100.00 SOLD



Item 555-46 – **22¢ special delivery – Ste Agathe des Monts** – 1922, 1¢ Admiral coil pair, 10¢ E1 (2) tied by Ste. Agathe des Monts Que cds on cover paying 22¢ special delivery letter rate to Montreal. Both E1s with shading in 10 tablet. The E2 stamp was issued in September 1922. Certainly a very late use and still in period. A very pretty Quebec cover and Post Office fresh. \$200.00



Item 555-48 – 4¢ UPU postcard rate to France – 1928, 1¢ Admiral, 3¢ Confederation tied by Toronto machine cancel on postcard paying 4¢ UPU postcard rate to France. A seldom encountered franking with 3¢ Confederation. \$50.00



Item 555-49 – Shortpaid special delivery with 5¢ block – 1929, 2¢ Scroll (5) tied by Cal & Van RPO cds on 2¢ stationery envelope from Banff Alberta underpaying 22¢ special delivery letter rate to Lethbridge. Shortpaid 10¢, charged 20¢ and paid with a 5¢ postage due stamp J4 block of 4. WOW! \$200.00 SOLD





Item 555-50 – 12¢ Empire registered to Federated Malay States – 1930, 12¢ Historical tied by Vancouver Station E cds on cover paying 12¢ Empire registered letter rate to Kuala Lumpur, Malay States (Singapore b/s). Small fault. A rare 12¢ Laurier Macdonals single franking to a scarce destination. \$250.00





Item 555-51 – <u>Cuvier Sask (unreported - only in proof book)</u> – 1929, 10¢ Scroll tied by grid cancel on 2¢ postal stationery envelope from Cuvier Sask paying 12¢ UPU printed matter registered rate to France (b/s). Routed via Archerwill, Yorkton & Sask RPO, Montreal and Montreal B&F. This Cuvier postmark is listed in the 1987 Robinson's book as only known in the proof book. (*). 1919-1932. \$275.00 **SOLD**





Item 555-52 – **15¢ double wgt registered to Newfoundland** – 1941, 5¢ Mufti tied by Timiskaming Station Que duplex cancel on RE1 registered stationery paying 15¢ double weight Empire registered letter rate to Newfoundland (b/s). FECB in Montreal (b/s). A pretty cover! \$100.00



Item 555-53 – **3¢ UPU postcard rate to Malaya – Refused** – 1938, 3¢ Mufti tied by Tavistock Ont duplex cancel on boring Toronto Exhibition postcard paying 3¢ UPU postcard rate to Perak, Malaya. Refused, tax 5, T10 centimes, 4 cents Malayan postage due stamp tied by Ipoh and then sent to the Dead Letter Office. A show piece. \$350.00




Item 555-54 – Shortpaid to Liechtenstein with dues – 1939, 1¢, 2¢ Mufti tied by Winnipeg machine cancel on cover underpaying 5¢ UPU letter rate to Liechtenstein. T20 centimes converted to 10n with due stamp tied by Triesenberg cds. An incredible cover! \$300.00



Item 555-55 – **Bon Voyage to Their Majesties** – 1939, 1¢, 2¢, 3¢ Royal Visit tied by Royal Train machine cancel on a trio of matching covers with "Their Majesties Leave Canada To-Day – Bon Voyage – God Save The King" c/c cachet. The first such Bon Voyage covers that I have seen. \$100.00 **SOLD**



Item 555-56 – <u>First Indochina War - 25¢ airmail</u> – 1948, 5¢ War, 20¢ Peace tied by Trois Rivieres Que machine cancel on cover paying 25¢ airmail letter rate to Viet Nam (b/s) via Hong Kong (transit on front). Sent to French Army servicemen fighting the Việt Minh (Democratic Republic of Vietnam). \$200.00



Item 555-57 – **8¢ Peace use** – 1947, 5¢ War, 8¢ Peace tied by Toronto Sub No.21 cds on cover paying 13¢ registered letter rate. A seldom seen franking. \$40.00



Item 555-58 – <u>Airmail business reply envelope</u> – 1943, 1¢ War tied by grid cancel on Fred Bray airmail reply permit cover overpaying 7¢ airmail letter from Upper Blackville NB to Hamilton. Postage will be paid by permit 497. 1¢ War not required. \$30.00 <u>SOLD</u>
