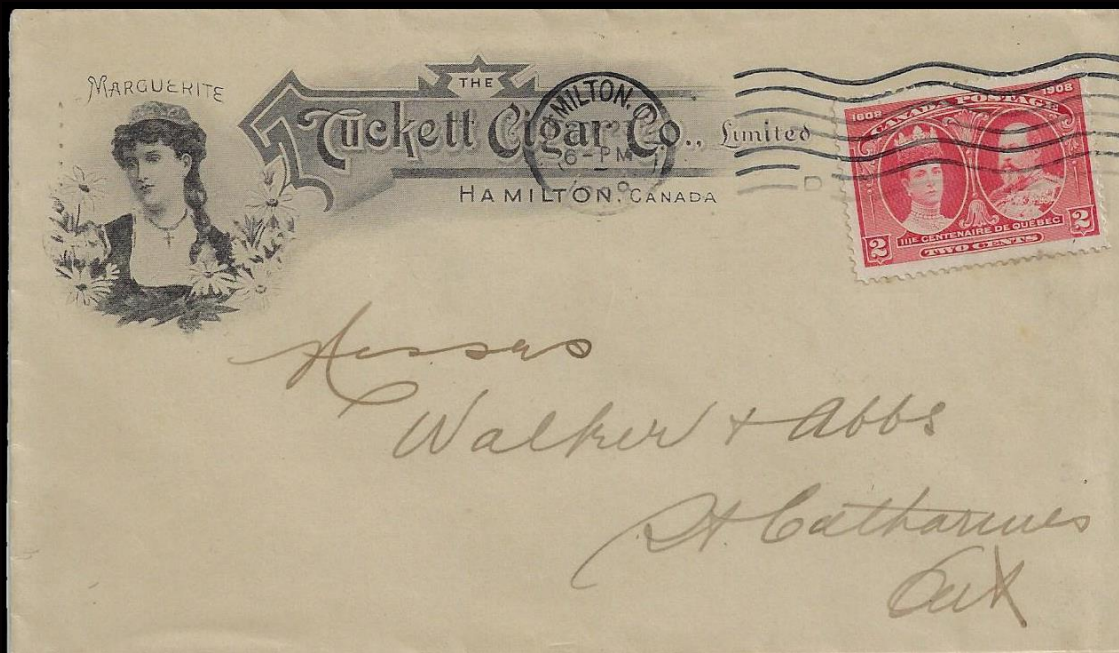

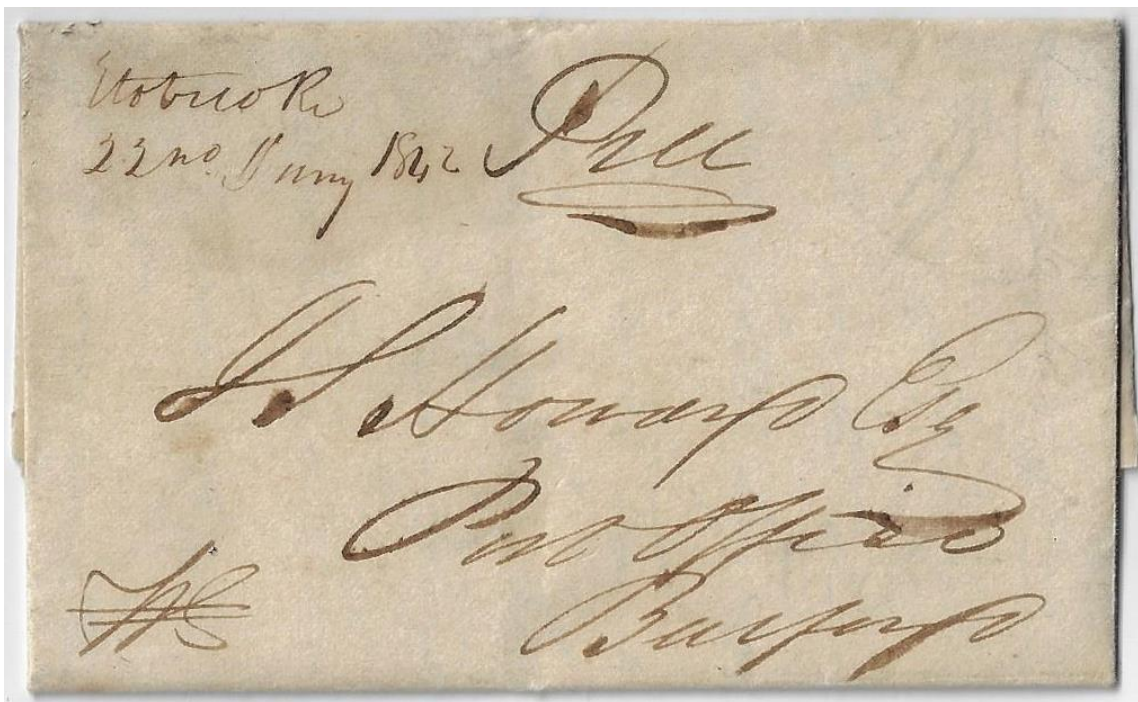




Item 557-01 – **Memramcook to Hillsborough NB** – 1858, stampless folded cover from Memramcook NB rated 3d collect to Hillsborough. Redirected to Fredericton “Try Fredericton NB”. Memramcook, Salisbury, Hillsborough and Fredericton (b/s). \$75.00 **SOLD**



Item 557-02 – **Quebec oval “Q” steamboat** – 1844, stampless folded cover from the Montreal Bank of Quebec rated 9d collect to Montreal. The letter was placed directly on the westbound steamboat for Montreal with Quebec oval “Q” 184__ type 1. This type of markings were introduced to the Quebec Montreal boats for the opening of the navigation in 1842. Exhibit quality. \$400.00 **SOLD**




Item 557-03 – **Etobicoke UC manuscript and ERD** – 1832, free franked folded letter datelined Milton Mills mailed from Etobicoke UC to Burford with manuscript postmark. 

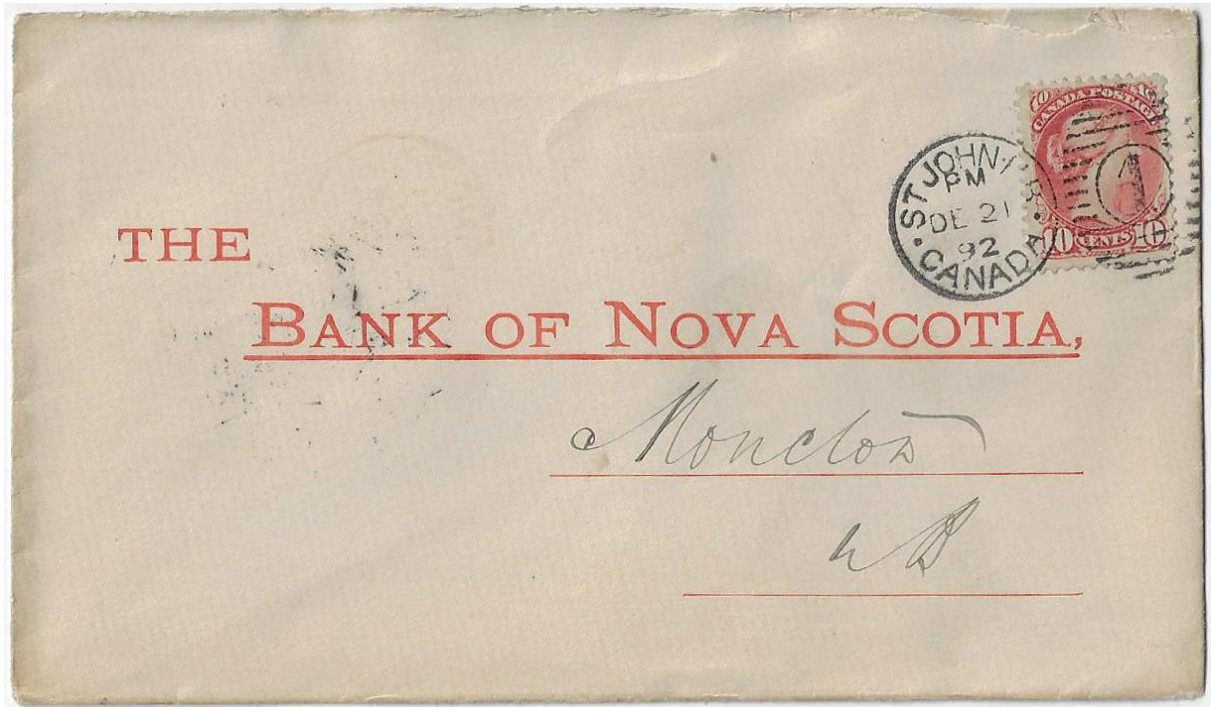

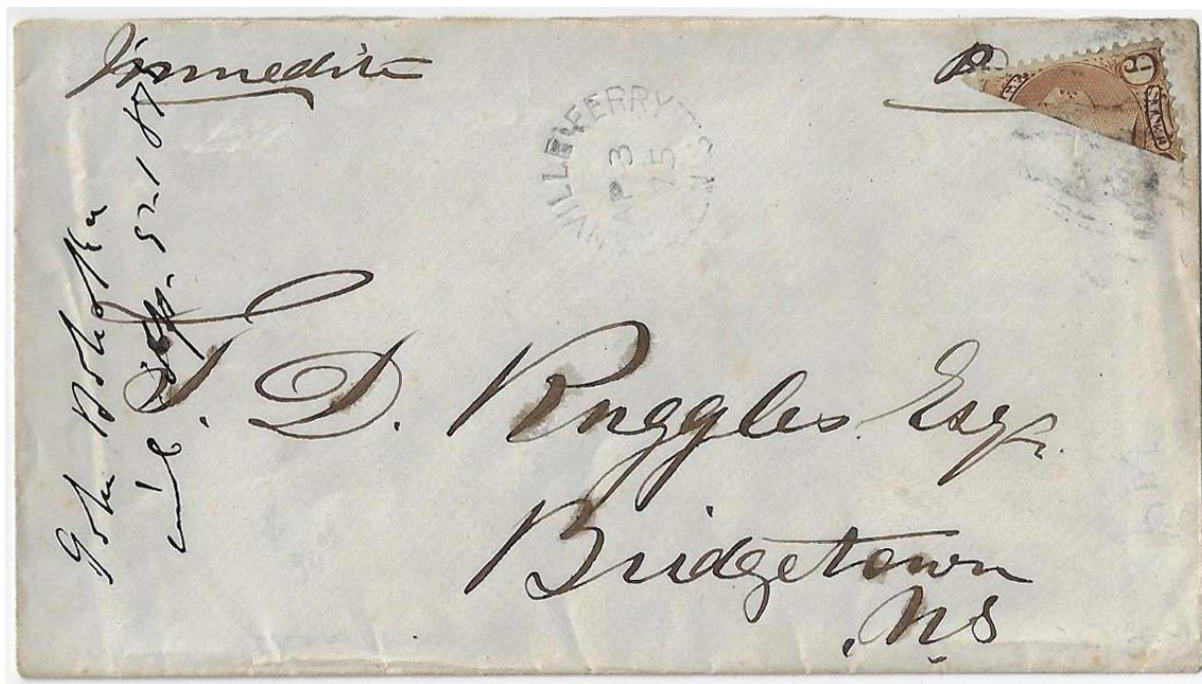

Cancelled by central concentric ring cancel, in matching blue, paying 3d letter rate to Vittoria (b/s). Routed via Brantford and Simcoe (b/s). VGG 17343: Genuine. \$2,000.00



Item 557-05 – **10¢ SQ carmine rose** – 1892, 10¢ carmine rose tied by St. John NB duplex cancel on Bank of Nova Scotia reply cover paying 9¢ triple weight letter rate to Moncton (b/s), 1¢ convenience, either by lack of lower denominations or reluctance to exert a necessary effort. Very pretty and clean. \$250.00



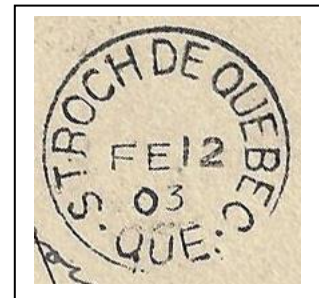
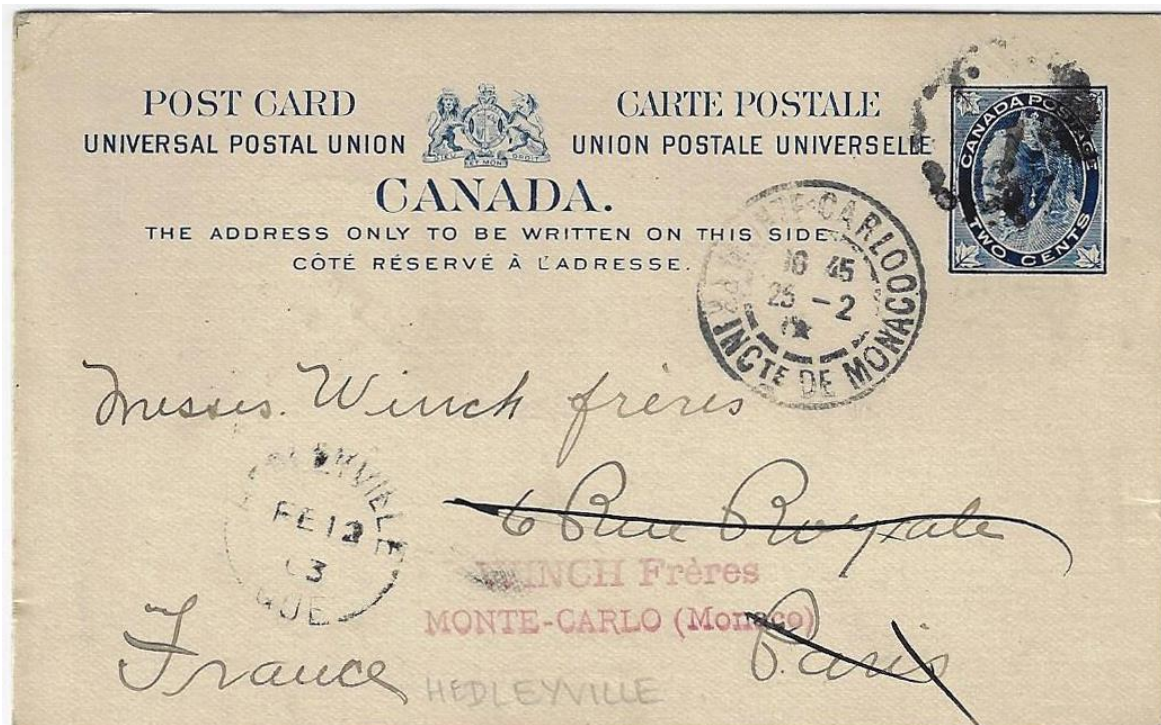
Item 557-06 – **Windsor Ont 5¢ UPU to Australia returned** – 1897, 1¢ (2), 3¢ SQ tied by Windsor Ont squared circle on cover paying 5¢ UPU letter rate to Australia (b/s). Redirected several times and forwarded to the Melbourne Dead Letter Office. Then returned to Canada via the Ottawa DLO. The cover was forwarded seven times and bears 22 cancels and instructional markings, eight manuscript endorsements and was resealed. \$850.00



Item 557-07 – **6¢ SQ diagonal bisect use** – 1875, 6¢ SQ right diagonal bisect tied smudge cancel on Ruggles cover from Granville Ferry NS paying 3¢ letter rate to Bridgetown (partial bs). This is a typical Ruggles correspondence cover, well documented, with only a very few recorded examples. Ex Roberts (1997). \$2,000.00



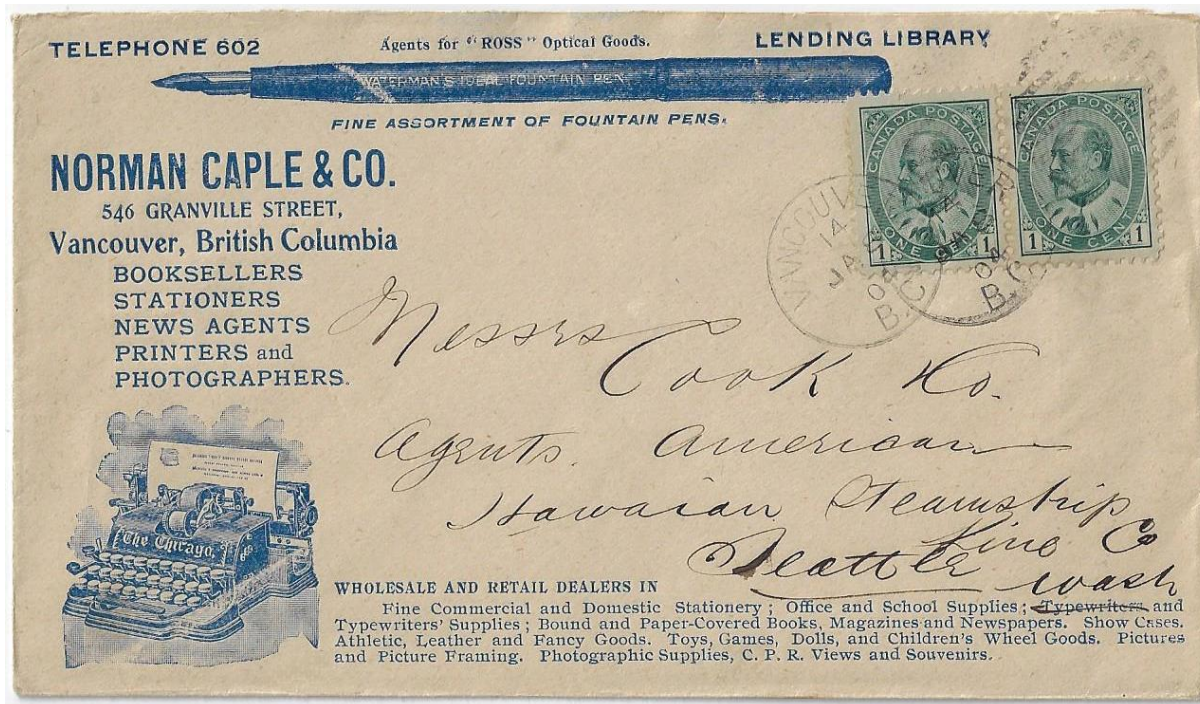

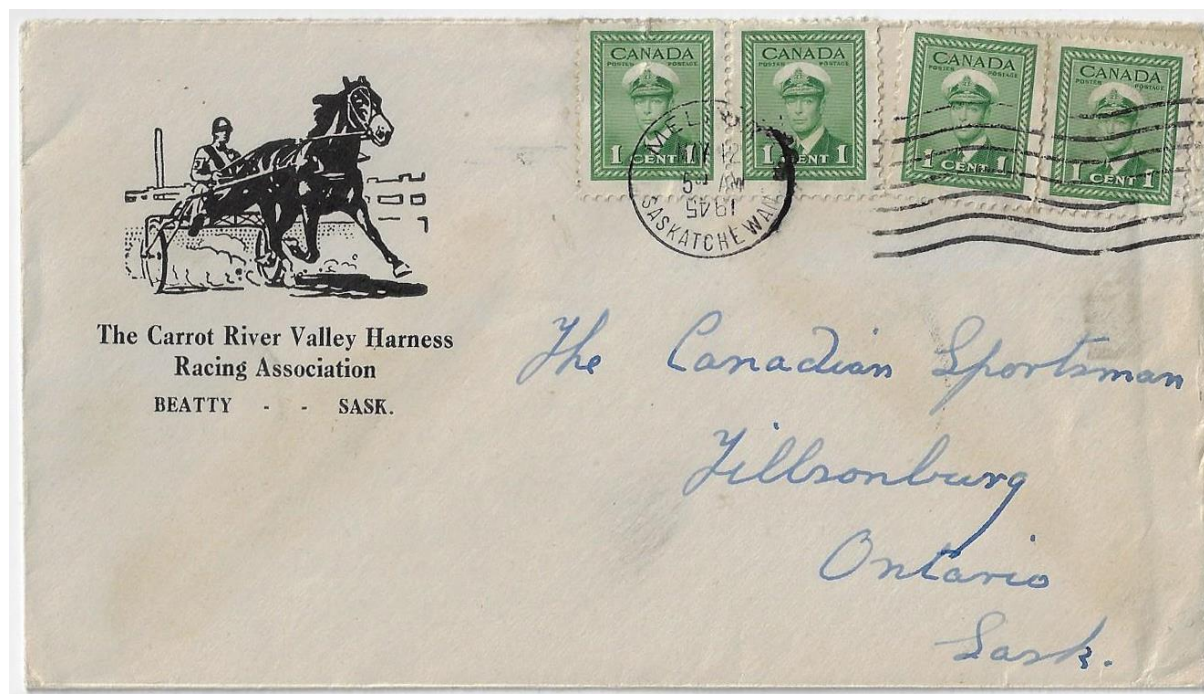
Item 557-50 – **An early Mail Service Suspended cover** – 1939, 2¢, 3¢ Mufti tied by Montreal machine cancel on cover paying 5¢ UPU letter rate to Nagasaki, Japan. The cover is dated October 27, 1939. Censored with postal censorship notice attached to cover “*this letter is returned as it is undesirable that postage stamps should be imported or exported at the present time*”. This is an early “Mail Service Suspended” cover. Returned. Canada declared War on Germany in September and declared war on Japan later but shortly after there was widespread fear that Japanese descents, in particular the BC fishers who made up the majority of the fishing fleet, might act against Canada's interests. The cover is from a Montreal engineering firm. \$300.00 **SOLD**



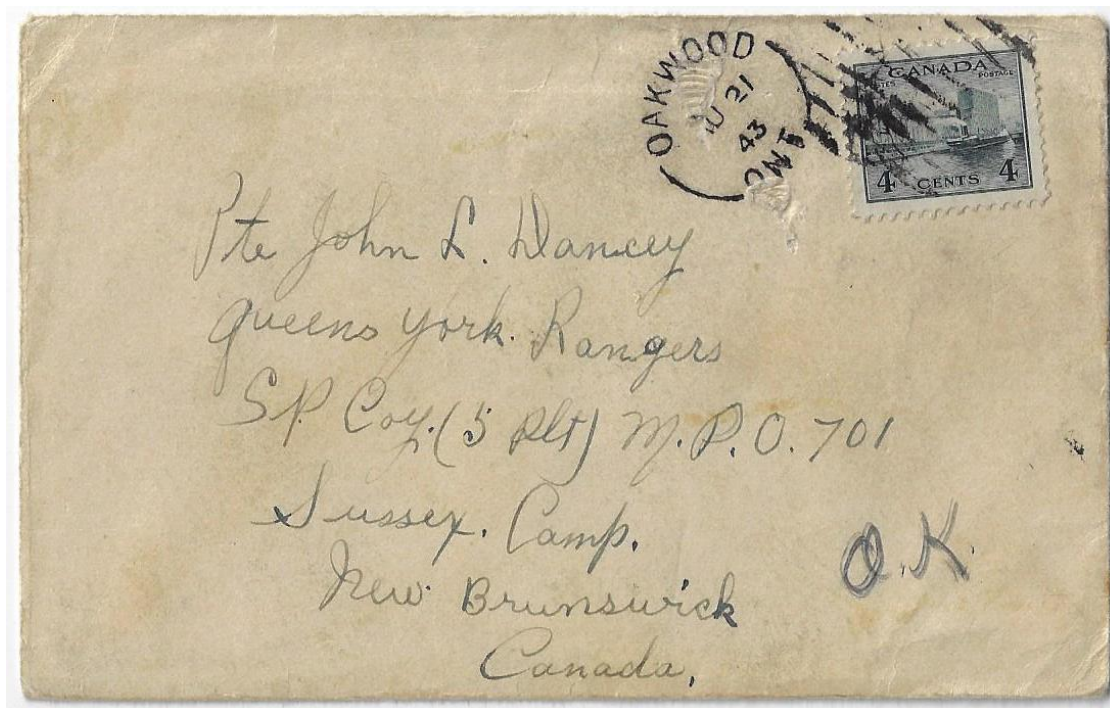
