

Item 558-01 – Newfoundland – compulsory registered and charged to Canada – 1941, 5¢ Caribou tied by Gander Newfd broken circle on compulsory registered cover, registry label Newfoundland Airport. To Goderich Ontario (b/s). Halifax & Campbellton RPO, Mont & Toronto RPO and Tor & Stratford RPO (b/s). Charged T20¢. Opened by censor, resealed with Newfoundland tape and censor #30 in blue crayon. This cover was probably censored at North Sydney Cape Breton. \$150.00 SOLD






Item 558-02 – <u>Compulsory registered in North Sydney NS</u> – 1941, 5¢ Caribou tied by Hare Bay B.B.N. Newf'd broken circle on cover to New York (b/s). Probably censored in North Sydney where Newfoundland had established an assistant censor and half dozen of examiners. The cover was found to contain money or stamps and was compulsory registered free of charge (b/s). Censors #30 and #32 in blue crayon have been considered likely North Sydney censors previously. Halifax & Camp RPO and St. John Montreal RPO (b/s). A real wow Caribou cover! \$300.00






Item 558-03 – <u>St. Pierre et Miquelon special delivery airmail</u> – 1942, NFLD 5¢ Grenfell (4) tied by Argentia NFLD rubber handstamp on cover from Saint-Pierre et Miquelon paying 20¢ special delivery airmail letter rate to Halifax. Examined by censor #41 and with passed by censor "2" handstamp issued to the assistant censor in North Sydney. This cover could be also French and might also have received extra attention as it was posted only two weeks after the take over from the Vichy Regime. \$200.00 <u>SOLD</u>







Item 558-04 – **Held by the censorship and released** – c1941-2, Newfoundland 5¢ Grenfell on postcard, no postal markings, held no doubt because of the illustration of distinctive transmission towers, wire and antenna on roof of the Cabot tower, "this missive withheld by the Censorship, is released on relaxation of security regulations which it infringed", mostly likely mailed to Nova Scotia in June 1945. A few cards like are known. \$150.00 **SOLD** 







Item 558-05 – Jamaica to Manitoba censored by Newfoundlanders – 1941, GEOVI ½d, 1½d tied by Kingston Jamaica machine cancel on cover paying the Empire letter rate to Transcona Manitoba (b/s). Censored by Newfoundlanders in North Sydney Nova Scotia, censored #30 with proper tape (tied by a postmark). Most unusual and showing the North Sydney was an entry port at the time. \$75.00 SOLD




Item 558-06 – <u>PPCLI – struck of strength</u> – 1941, 3¢ Mufti tied by Winnipeg machine cancel on cover to Pte G. Ingram, A Coy, PPCLI, 3<sup>rd</sup> Canadian Inf Holding, CASF. S.O.S. to Canada, Addressee Returned to Canada. FPO and Postal Corps (b/s). \$50.00 <u>SOLD</u>



Item 558-07 – <u>A rare FECB marking</u> – 1940, 3¢ Mufti tied by Toronto machine cancel on cover paying 3¢ letter rate to U.S. FECB with "Routine Correspondence Only, Approved for Export on behalf of the Foreign Exchange Control Board. Rare and not listed in Burrows. \$75.00 **SOLD** 






Item 558-08 – Compulsory registered in North Sydney NS – Craig Harbour NWT regsitered – 1937, 4¢ Mufti block of 4 tied by matching Craig Harbour NWT cds on Barrett Co. cover overpaying 15¢ double weight registered letter rate to Brantford (b/s). Possible 1¢ convenience. Carried by the R.M.S. Nascopie to Halifax (b/s) and then to Ontario by 5 RPO's (b/s) through the Martimes and Quebec to Toronto. Very pretty! \$150.00 SOLD



Item 558-09 – 1¢ printed matter to Iceland – 1941, 1¢ Mufti tied by Winnipeg Enlist Now flag cancel on Rotary unsealed cover paying 1¢ UPU printed matter rate to Iceland. Passed by censor. Much scarcer than the 5¢ UPU letter rate. \$150.00 SOLD





Item 558-10 – <u>Too late to connect with airmail</u> – 1939, 3¢ Mufti tied by Montreal machine cancel on fur company c/c cover underpaying the airmail rate to Moose Jaw (typewritten "airmail" at left). Interestingly, they used the received too late to connect with airmail, then sent surface, instead of charging dues. Montreal roller (b/s). \$25.00 SOLD







Item 558-11 – **5¢ UPU to Liberia, West Africa** – 1940, 2¢, 3¢ Mufti tied by Toronto machine cancel on censored cover paying 5¢ UPU letter rate to Cape Palmas, Liberia, West Africa (b/s). A bit rough opening at top. \$350.00

Cape Palmas is a headland on the extreme southeast end of the coast of Liberia at the extreme southwest.

The Cape consists of a small, rocky peninsula connected to the mainland by a sand dune.





Item 558-12 – 5¢ UPU to Mozambique – 1940, 5¢ Mufti (gum toned perfs) tied by Montreal machine cancel on censored cover paying 5¢ UPU letter rate to Beira, Mozambique (b/s). The cover is from Elder Dempster Lines to Union Castle Mail Steamship Co. Beira is located on the Mozambique Channel, an arm of the Indian Ocean located between Madagascar and Mozambique. \$400.00







Item 558-13 – Naval airmail cover to Guantanamo Bay, Cuba – 1943, 1¢ Mufti coil strip of 4, 6¢ War tied by roller cancel on cover, originally free franked, received and censored from the Destroyer HMCS St. Laurent in Halifax, T100 centimes paying 10¢ airmail letter rate to the U.S.N. Base in Guantanamo Bay, Cuba (b/s). Via Habana (b/s). \$150.00 SOLD




Item 558-15 – <u>3¢ preferential rate to France</u> – 1939, 3¢ Mufti tied by Lindsay Ont machine cancel on cover paying 3¢ preferential letter rate to France. Endorsed "Passenger "Carinthia Cruise". A very scarce surface rate. \$25.00



Item 558-16 – **25¢ airmail to Southern Rhodesia** – 1937, 5¢ Mufti, 20¢ Pictorial tied by Montreal duplex S cancel on cover paying 25¢ airmail letter rate to Southern Rhodesia. Endorsed via Quebec per S.S. Empress of Britain via GB. \$150.00






Item 558-17 – 1¢ printed matter rate to Czechoslovakia – 1938, 1¢ Mufti tied by Quebec PQ machine cancel on home made postcard, typewritten message from a stamp collector, paying 1¢ UPU printed matter rate to Czechoslovakia. \$50.00





Item 558-18 – <u>Transcona Manitoba registered to Italy</u> – 1937, 5¢ Mufti, 10¢ Pictorial of 1935 (some gum toned perfs) tied by Transcona Man cds on cover paying 15¢ UPU registered letter rate to Italy (b/s). Winnipeg and Montreal transit (b/s). \$50.00 SOLD






Item 558-19 – <u>Hochelaga registered to Sicily, Italy</u> – 1939, 5¢ Mufti, 10¢ Pictorial of 1938 tied by Montreal Hochelaga Post Office cds on cover paying 15¢ UPU registered letter rate to Sicily, Italy (b/s). Montreal British Branch (b/s). \$60.00



Item 558-20 – <u>Genie illustrated – Plymouth Motors</u> – 1935, Genie illustrated on Johnston Motors 1¢ stationery card with ½¢ reply card attached paying 1¢ printed matter rate to local. \$25.00 <u>SOLD</u>






Item 558-21 – <u>Mail Service Suspended</u> – 1940, 3¢ Mufti (2) tied by Cobourg Ont machine cancel on censored cover, Examined by Cenosr 28 and tiny C.28 tape, overpaying 5¢ UPU letter rate to Belgium. Mail Service Suspended due to War and returned to sender via the Dead Letter Office in Ottawa. \$125.00 SOLD



Item 558-22 – 1¢ printed matter rate to Switzerland – 1945, 1¢ War tied by Quebec PQ machine cancel on 1001 Jeux (1001 Games) advertising cover, stamped "Printed", paying 1¢ printed matter rate to Switzerland. Advertising UPU printed matter rate covers are all very scarce. \$60.00



Item 558-23 – <u>CAPO No.10 to Natal, South Africa</u> – 1944, 4¢ War tied by CAPO No.10 cds on RCAF double censored cover paying 4¢ Empire letter rate to Natal, South Africa. A most unusual destination for a CAPO cover. \$100.00



Item 558-24 – <u>War Disease Control Station</u> - 1945, 3¢ Coronation tied by Quebec machine on WDCS censored French Canadian patriotic cover to local. The War Disease Control Station was located at Grosse Ile on the St. Lawrence. A lovely Freddy Masson philatelic cover. \$50.00 <u>SOLD</u>




Item 558-25 – Clarkson Ont to Japan – U.S. censorship – 1947, 1¢, 4¢ War tied by Clarkson Ont cds on censored cover paying 5¢ UPU letter rate to Japan. U.S. Military censorship (civil mail censor tape), return address Sheridan Nurseries / Sheridan Ontario. \$75.00 SOLD




Item 558-26 – <u>Montreal postcard to Palestine</u> – 1946, 1¢, 3¢ War tied by Montreal machine cancel on postcard overpaying 3¢ UPU postcard rate to Haifa, Palestine. \$40.00



Item 558-27 – 15¢ airmail to Penang, Malaysia – 1947, 1¢, 4¢ War tied by Montreal machine cancel on 10¢ air letter sheet, Season's Greetings printed in red, paying 15¢ airmail letter rate to Butterworth, Penang, Malaysia. \$75.00 SOLD



Item 558-28 – 4¢ Empire to Cook Islands, Oceania – 1943, 1¢ War block (plate No.5) tied by Saskatoon Sask duplex cancel on Bessborough Hotel advertising cover paying 4¢ Empire letter rate to Rarotonga Island, Cook Islands. \$200.00



Item 558-29 – Redirected within the government in Ottawa – 1947, 1¢ War (4) tied by Winnipeg machine cancel on cover paying 4¢ letter rate to Ottawa (b/s). To Dept of Mines & Resources, redirected internally to External Affairs, then to the Dept of Secretary of State and to the Privy Council. An interesting public servant cover! \$25.00 SOLD





Item 558-30 – <u>Vancouver Blackouts – 68 ounces registered money packet</u> – 1945, 2¢, 10¢ (3), 20¢, \$1 (3) War tied by Vancouver Blackout cds on Bank of Nova Scotia mailing tag, with Blackout registry marking, paying \$3.52 registered money packet rate for 68 ounces to Woodfibre BC. 17¢ the first oz with registration and 5¢ each added oz. \$150.00 <u>SOLD</u>






Item 558-31 – 4¢ preferred rate to Argentina – 1945, 4¢ War tied by Montreal machine cancel on Ravitch Jewish Library c/c cover paying 4¢ preferred letter rate to Argentina (b/s). Naval censor DB/8. \$40.00



Item 558-32 – **15¢ airmail to North Borneo** – 1947, 1¢, 2¢, 3¢ (4) tied by Port Arthur Ont machine cancel on air letter sheet paying 15¢ airmail letter rate to North Borneo. Interesting enclosure from Woodgate Stamp Nook, about stamp exchange, to Alexander Graham Bell commemorative covers and other things. A rare destination. \$150.00



Item 558-33 – 10¢ airmail to Algeria (Bataillon de Chasseurs Malgaches) – 1944, 1¢, 3¢ (3) War tied by Montreal Place D'Armes duplex cancel on cover paying 10¢ airmail letter rate to Algeria. Redirected from Alger to Constantine. The cover is addressed to a Sergeant-Chef serving with the B.C.M Bataillon de Chasseurs Malgaches (kind of Legion Malagasy battalion). \$125.00



Item 558-34 – <u>Chemical swipes to detect hidden writing</u> – 1945, 4¢ War tied by Toronto machine cancel on censored cover (*Canadian censor*) underpaying 5¢ UPU letter rate to Switzerland. Charged T10 centimes converted to 15 Swiss centimes. No enemy censor markings however the letter has censor chemical swipes to detect hidden writing over message. \$150.00






Item 558-35 – <u>Christmas card to Halifax returned by letter carrier</u> – 1947, 1¢ War tied by Windsor NS machine cancel on cover with Christmas card accompanies paying 1¢ printed matter rate to Halifax. Returned by letter carrier with "Returned from Halifax for street and number address", charged 1¢ and paid with a second 1¢ War stamp tied by Windsor MOTO handstamp. An interesting cover with 1¢ War for postage and 1¢ War used as postage due stamp. \$50.00 **SOLD** 



Item 558-36 – 6 ounces photographer's mailer – 1948, 3¢ War tied by London roller cancel on London Photo Service photographer's mailer paying 3¢ printed matter rate to Windsor 1¢ / 2 ounces. A scarce rate. \$35.00



Item 558-37 – <u>Additional 1¢ Wartax commemorative cover</u> – 1943, 1¢ War coil strip of 3 on cover from Hamilton with "this letter was posted upon the inauguration of the additional 1¢ Wartax – Postmaster signed", paying 3¢ drop letter rate. \$20.00 <u>SOLD</u>





Item 558-38 – <u>British Commonwealth Air Training Plan</u> – 1943, 4¢, 5¢, 8¢, 13¢ War tied by MacDonald Man MPO 1004 cds on cover paying nine times weight registered Empire letter rate to Australia (b/s). 10¢ registration, 2¢ Wartax and 2¢ per oz. The cover was sent by an Australian airmen serving in Canada as part of the British Commonwealth Air Training Plan. RAAF abroad, bombing and gunnery school. A spectacular cover! \$200.00 SOLD



Item 558-39 – 40¢ airmail rate to Denmark – 1946, 20¢ War (2) tied by Montreal roller cancel on Montreal Daily Star c/c cover paying 40¢ airmail letter rate for ½ oz via London to Denmark. \$40.00



Item 558-40 – 1¢ War first day on J.C. Wilson card – 1942, 1¢ Confederation, 1¢ War tied by Hamilton cds dated JUL 1 42 paying 3¢ postcard rate to U.S. This is the War Issue first day. \$25.00





Item 558-41 – <u>Struck of strength</u> – 1944, 3¢ War tied by Montreal machine cancel on cover to Pte W. Sherry, 1 Canadian H.S.C. Reinforcement Unit, CAO. S.O.S. to Canada, returned via Montreal No.4 Depot and Ottawa. HQ CPS Poste Restante (b/s). \$50.00 <u>SOLD</u>








Item 558-42 – <u>Lcol McLean seeking votes</u> – 1945, 10¢ War tied by Toronto machine cancel on air letter sheet to Pte Sommerville, 2 DD AF, CAO. The letter is typewritten and is from Lcol McLean seeking vote to a soldier on duty (a Private). His letter advises of his nomination as the Progressive Conservative candidate for Parry Sound District in the up coming election 11 JU 45 and extolls the virtues of the P.C. party in soliciting Sommerville's vote. Pte Sommerville had been repatriated, struck of strength (SOS to CANADA) and the letter was returned. A real wow! \$125.00 SOLD



Item 558-43 – <u>St. Hyacinthe NPO 403 mailed unpaid</u> – 1945, cover mailed unpaid from St. Hyacinthe NPO 403 Quebec to Montreal with 8¢ postage due, the double deficiency. \$25.00



Item 558-44 – <u>6 Victory Bond labels "Come On"</u> – c1940, group of 6 "Buy the new Victory Bonds" labels, all with gum and NH. Come On Canada! \$75.00 <u>SOLD</u>





Item 558-45 – <u>RCAF – Flying Training School re-used cover</u> – 1943, RCAF No.8 Service Flying Training School free franked cover to Mosherville N.S. Re-used with RCAF mailing label and franked with 7¢, 10¢ War with Keyhole paying 17¢ airmail registered letter rate to a depot in Lachine. Redirected to Stanley Nova Scotia and returned to Lachine (b/s) \$75.00 **SOLD** 






Item 558-46 – 10¢ letter rate to Morocco – 1944, 10¢ War tied by matching Notre Dame du Portage PQ broken circle on cover paying 10¢ letter rate to Morocco (b/s), airmail service in Canada only, jusqu'à marking in red. Censored in Canada and England. The cover is addressed to a French Armed Forces sergeant. \$100.00 SOLD





Item 558-47 – **25¢ airmail to RAF Officer in Basra, Iraq** – 1939, 6¢, 20¢ Pictorial tied by Regina Sask machine cancel on cover paying 25¢ airmail letter rate to Iraq (b/s). 1¢ overpaid as a convenience franking. Small tear affecting stamp and priced accordingly. A rare destination. \$100.00



Item 558-48 – 10¢ airmail to Costa Rica – 1947, 10¢ Peace tied by Dundas Ont machine cancel on cover paying 10¢ airmail letter rate to Costa Rica (b/s). Via the U.S. with American label. A scarcer Central American destination. \$50.00



Item 558-49 – 40¢ airmail registered to Belgium – 1950, 7¢ Peace, 2¢, 3¢ (2), 4¢ (4), 5¢GEOVI both issues, 4¢ Centenary tied by Ottawa Sub No.6 cds on cover paying 40¢ airmail registered letter rate to Belgium. Montreal AMF (b/s). \$50.00 SOLD



Item 558-50 – **5¢ UPU to Luxembourg** – 1953, 5¢ GEOVI Postes Postage tied by Montreal Coronation flag cancel on cover paying 5¢ UPU letter rate to Luxembourg. \$75.00





Item 558-51 – **2¢ printed papers Empire to Fiji** – 1952, 1¢ GEOVI Postes Postage (2) tied by Wainwright Alberta machine cancel on cover paying 2¢ printed papers British Empire rate to Fiji (b/s). \$100.00 **SOLD** 



Item 558-52 – <u>CP letterview censored fold-out</u> – 1952, 2¢, 4¢ GEOVI Postes Postage tied by Toronto machine cancel on CP letterview fold-out with letter and illustrations paying 6¢ letter rate to Austria. Written on board S.S. Empress of France. Austrian censored No.96 on front. A very pretty item and scarce. \$50.00 <u>SOLD</u>





Item 558-53 – **2¢ UPU printed matter rate to Finland** – 1952, 2¢ GEOVI Postes Postage tied by Toronto machine cancel on unsealed cover paying 2¢ UPU printed matter rate to Finland (b/s). \$40.00
