



Item 575-01 – **Bentick CW (Grey 1847-1865)** – 1851, folded cover from Bentick CW paid 3d to Southampton (Owen Sound b/s). Hammer 1 spelling variation “Bentick” instead of “Bentinck”. A very scarce Grey County Office, in operation from 1847 to 1865. \$250.00



Item 575-02 – **Walpole UC (Haldimand 1836-1856)** – 1842, folded cover from Walpole UC, exhibit quality double circle struck in red, paid 7d to Niagara. The Walpole Post Office changed to Selkirk in 1856. Choice double circle. \$300.00




Item 575-03 – **York UC Straight-Line** – 1818, partial folded letter from York UC paid 1N2 to Montreal. This is the hammer type 1 (1803-1823). York County. \$125.00 **SOLD**




Item 575-04 – **Drummondville UC – Too Late (Welland)** – 1844, folded letter from Drummondville UC rated 11½d collect to Kingston (b/s). One of the two Drummondville hammer. Mailed after cutoff time with Too Late marking. The letter is signed by Samuel Street and relates to the issue of debenture for 300£ of stocks and assets. \$75.00 **SOLD**





Item 575-05 – **Port Hope UC (Durham)** – 1855, stampless cover from Port Hope UC paid 3d to Toronto (b/s). Trinity College. \$25.00




Item 575-06 – London UC paid via charge box account – 1854, stampless cover from London UC paid 3d to Toronto (b/s). A nice smaller “Paid” marking. Postage charged to box account. \$25.00 **SOLD**



Item 575-07 – Seaforth CW (Huron) – 1863, stampless cover from Seaforth CW (20mm Berri) paid 5 to Quebec (b/s). I have seen only a handful of this 20mm Berri. Very scarce. \$50.00



Item 575-08 – **Belmore CW (Huron)** – 1864, stampless cover from Belmore CW paid 5 to Quebec (b/s) via Walkerton (b/s) and Bentinck (b/s). \$50.00



Item 575-09 – **Montreal registered to St. Brigid LC** – 1857, lawyer registered folded letter from Thomas Nye in Montreal, paid 3d with registry fee paid in cash, to St. Brigid d'Iberville. Via St. Johns CE (A JUL 24 1857). \$125.00






Item 575-10 – Letter from Melbourne LC mailed in Montreal – 1859, letter datelined Melbourne 14 SE 59 mailed registered in Montreal, two diff paid markings with paid 5 to Lachine. Registry fee paid in cash. \$125.00 **SOLD**



Item 575-11 – **Guelph too late** – 1851, folded letter datelined Esquesing JU 2 59, mailed from Guelph rated 3d collect to Hamilton (b/s). Mailed too late for the day's mail. The letter is signed by Ruth Adams and relates to property appraisal. \$50.00 **SOLD**



Item 575-12 – **January 1 1870** – 1870, stampless cover from Fergus CW (Berri hammer CW) rated 5c collect to Toronto (b/s). It is an interesting cover bridging Large Queen the Small Queen era. \$75.00




Item 575-13 – **Erin UC (Wellington)** – 1859, stampless cover from Erin UC 7¢ collect to Toronto (b/s) via Georgetown (b/s). From 25 NO 56, a separate device was used as a dater. \$75.00




Item 575-14 – **Erin UC registered (Wellington)** – 1858, business registered letter, signed by Charles McMiller, from Erin UC paid 3d to Guelph (b/s) via Georgetown (b/s). Registry fee paid in cash. All markings struck in blue. A beauty! \$125.00




Item 575-15 – **Eden Mills UC (Wellington)** – 1858, stampless cover from Eden Mills UC paid 3 to Vienna via Wellington Square, Ingersoll, Vienna (b/s). This is the earliest recorded date of all Eden Mills hammers. A very scarce Wellington County Office. \$125.00



Item 575-16 – **Parker CW (Wellington)** – 1873, 3¢ SQ tied by grid cancel on cover from Parker CW (the earliest recorded date, 1st hammer) paying 3¢ letter rate to Toronto. Elora transit (b/s). A scarce Berri. \$75.00




Item 575-17 – **Parker CW modified hammer (Wellington)** – 1881, 1¢ stationery card from Parker CW (the latest recorded date, 1st hammer) to Guelph. Elora transit (b/s). Modified arcs due to deterioration. \$100.00



Item 575-18 – **Everton UC** – the only recorded example (WTN) – 1857, stampless cover from Everton UC, Wellington County, dated AP 6 57, paid 3 to Acton (b/s) via Erin and Georgetown (b/s). \$300.00




Item 575-19 – **Everton UC – the only recorded example (WTN)** – 1859, stampless cover from Everton UC, Wellington County, dated AU 29 59, 7¢ collect to Toronto (b/s) via Guelph (b/s). Note the manuscript like marking at lower left, perhaps to emphasize the date change to the hammer. A beauty! \$300.00




Item 575-20 – **Winfield UC, the discovery copy (Wellington)** – 1871, stampless cover from Winfield UC paid 3 to Toronto. This is the discovery copy, the earliest reported date of 2 recorded examples (records from March 1871 to March 1872). Reduced at left. \$200.00




Item 575-21 – **2¢ LQ strip of 3 - Eastern Twp Quebec to US** – 1872, 2¢ Large Queen strip of 3 with one jumbo, pen cancel, on cover from Herbert CE paying 6¢ cross border letter rate to New Hampshire. Routed via North Troy Vermont and Mansonville (b/s). A rare Brome County office, 1867-1879. \$750.00



Item 575-22 – **New Aberdeen CW (Waterloo 1847-1877)** – 1872, 1¢ stationery card mailed from New Aberdeen CW, too late, to Ayr Ont. A scarce Waterloo office, closed in 1877. \$100.00 **SOLD**






Item 575-23 – **Mimosa CW (Wellington)** – 1879, 1¢ stationery card mailed from Mimosa CW, manuscript date and the latest recorded date, to Galt Ont. This postmark is recorded from 1874 to 1879 only. A scarce Wellington office. \$75.00



Item 575-24 – **Waterloo Ont – Fire Insurance Co.** – 1896, 3¢ SQ tied by Waterloo Ont squared circle MY 4 96 on The Mercantile Fire Insurance Co. advertising cover paying 3¢ letter rate to Toronto (b/s). \$100.00



Item 575-25 – **Notre-Dame St. Montreal fancy** – 1895, 3¢ SQ with Notre-Dame Street Montreal cogwheel fancy cancel. Lacelle 1470. \$100.00 **SOLD**





Item 575-26 – **Toronto blackmailer – Court case cover** – 1894, 1¢ SQ tied by smudge cancel on cover from Toronto, used as a wrapper, paying 1¢ printed matter rate to local. Docketing notes, annotations and entries referred to a court case, Exhibit A, Exhibit E, *Blackmailer Campbell*. \$125.00




Item 575-27 – **Baie de la Trinité Que via steamboat to Rimouski (North Shore)** – 1888, 3¢ SQ tied by smudge purple cancel on cover from Baie de la Trinité (North Shore, between Baie Comeau and Sept Iles) paying 3¢ letter rate to Toronto. Carried by steamboat to Rimouski and overland to Toronto. Rare. \$150.00 **SOLD**



Item 575-28 – **Waterford Ont squared – registered** – 1895, 3¢, 5¢ SQ (affixed over the edge fault) tied by Waterford Ont squared circle, MR 9 95, paying 8¢ registered letter rate to U.S.(b/s). Routed via Hamilton and by St. Thomas & Fort Erie RyPO (b/s). \$150.00



Item 575-29 – **Segeun Falls Ont spelling error (Via Rosseau)** – 1875, 3¢ SQ sulfurized tied by target cancel on cover from Seguin Falls Ont (Parry Sound, spelling error 1873-1876 hammer) paying 3¢ letter rate to Toronto (b/s). The cover was routed via Rosseau and tended to believe that it went by steamboat to Port Carling. A scarce hammer and an interesting Parry Sound cover! \$125.00




Item 575-30 – Dundas Ont free franked to House of Commons – 1899, Dundas Ont free franked cover with letter, squared circle PM AP 8 99, to Thomas Bain MP in the House of Commons (b/s). Thomas Bain was MP for Wentworth South, a farmer and married to Helen Weir. The letter is from his loving Helen to a dear Mary. \$100.00







Item 575-34 – **Stratford Wines and Liquors** – 1908, 2¢ Edward tied by Stratford Ont duplex cancel on William O'Dwyer Wines, Liquors and Cigars advertising cover paying 2¢ letter rate to Hamilton (b/s). Very scarce. \$100.00 **SOLD**





Item 575-35 – **Galt Old Boys' Reunion cinderella** – 1907, 1¢ Edward tied by grid cancel on Galt postcard, with “Come to Galt – Old Boy’s Reunion – August 7,8,9, 1907” dated event stamps, paying 1¢ PC rate to U.S. This cinderella is listed in Lafreniere book as CC0024 p.1. \$125.00 **SOLD**



Item 575-36 – **Gordon Head BC (RF E, 1900-1920)** – 1906, 1¢ Franklin tied by Cavalier North Dakota cds on postcard to Gordon Head BC. Receiver SP 12 06. \$125.00








Keyhole precursor with matching Montreal dotted cds (b/s). Reverse with electrical engineer related message. \$150.00



Item 575-39 – **Muskoka Free Hospital** – 1909, 1¢ Edward, Muskoka Free Hospital 1909-1910 cinderella well tied by Cobourg Ont duplex cancel on card paying 1¢ PC rate to Ripley (receiver). A very pretty “tied” example. \$75.00 **SOLD**



Item 575-40 – **Sandwich to Ford Ontario (1913-1923)** – 1920, 3¢, 5¢ Admiral tied by Sandwich Ont cds on cover paying 8¢ registered letter rate to Ford Ontario. Not called for and returned to sender via Windsor (b/s). Ford cds JA 10 20 (b/s) and Ford broken circle FE 10 20 despatch on front. The Ford Post Office opened in 1913 and closed permanently in 1923. Cover still sealed with its content. \$100.00



Item 575-41 – **Two James Morrison Brass Co. perfin covers** – 1924-5, 3¢ and 2¢ Admiral with James Morrison Brass JMT perfin on two advertising covers from Toronto paying the letter rate to Queenston. Johnson Tomasson RF C. Pair \$150.00

Item 575-43 – **12c registered letter rate to England** – 1930, 3c Confederation block of 4 (straight edge sheet at top) tied by smudge cancel on cover from Charlottetown PEI paying 12c Empire registered letter rate to England (b/s). Carried by Ch'town & Sackville RPO, Halifax & Campbellton RPO and via Halifax (b/s). \$100.00



Item 575-44 – **Summerland BC** – 1927, 10¢, \$1 Admiral, 5¢, 20¢ Historical tied by Summerland BC roller cancel, and with a tiny MOOD cancel, on slip paying a service for \$1.35. Most likely a circular distribution on a rural route (18 R.R.). A very unusual mixed franking. \$100.00





No receiver as customary to this South African destination. Middle fold. A seldom encountered 6¢ Ottawa Conference franked cover. \$250.00 **SOLD**




Item 575-46 – House of Commons to Belgium – Refused for the fee – 1937, 3¢ Pictorial tied by House of Commons cds on "Chambre des Communes" cover underpaying 5¢ UPU letter rate to Belgium. 1F40c postage due stamp tied by Brussel cds. Reverse with refused for the fee label and returned to the House (b/s). \$125.00




Item 575-47 – House of Commons to Austria – Gone away – 1936, 5¢ Pictorial tied by House of Commons cds on “Chambre des Communes” cover paying 5¢ UPU letter rate to Austria (b/s). Parti “Gone” label, returned to sender (b/s). The letter is from Camille Bouchard and relates to stamps. Perhaps he was the brother of Joseph Georges Bouchard Member of Parliament for Kamouraska... using his brother privileges on mail... \$125.00



Item 575-48 – **8¢ Medallion use** – 1932, 5¢, 8¢ Medallion tied by Vancouver cds on cover paying 13¢ registered letter rate to Toronto. \$50.00 **SOLD**





Item 575-51 – **OHMS free postcard, airmail shortpaid** – 1940, 3¢ Mufti OHMS perfin tied by Ottawa machine and cds cancels on OHMS free franked *application for employment* card to Outlook Sask (b/s). Mailed airmail, which was not free, shortpaid 3¢, 6¢ postage due. Very unusual. \$50.00 **SOLD**



Item 575-52 – **15¢ airmail to Greece** – 1948, 5¢ War, 10¢ Peace tied by Toronto machine cancel on postcard paying 15¢ airmail rate to Greece. Receiver both sides. \$75.00


