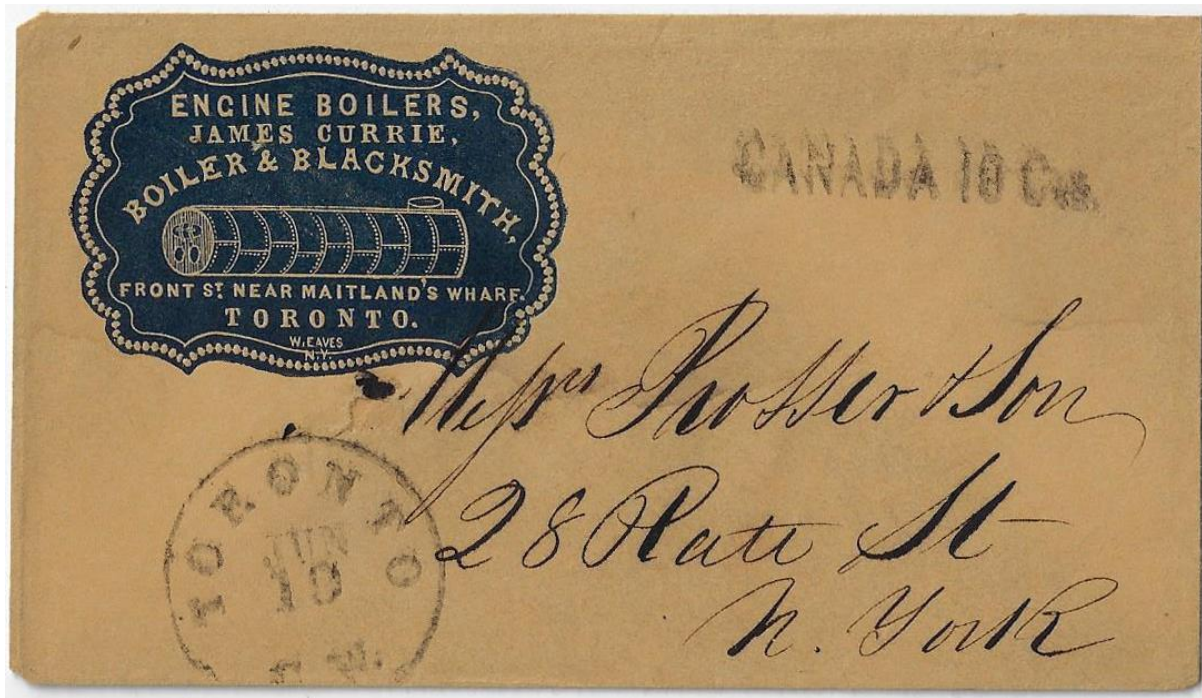

Item 576-01 – **Toronto Boiler and Blacksmith** – c1855, stampless cover from Toronto with James Currie Boiler & Blacksmith came and embossed dark blue advertising, rated Canada 10 Cts paying the cross border rate to New York. Currie was located on Front Street. \$400.00



Item 576-02 – **Copetown UC, the only recorded example (Wentworth)** – 1861, stampless cover from Copetown UC paid 5¢ to Rosebank via Harrisburg (b/s). This is the only reported example. \$200.00



Item 576-03 – **Tweedside Ont the only recorded example (Wentworth)** – 1871, folded letter datelined Saltfleet mailed from Tweedside Ont paid 3 to Beamsville Ont. The only recorded example. 1 known. \$250.00



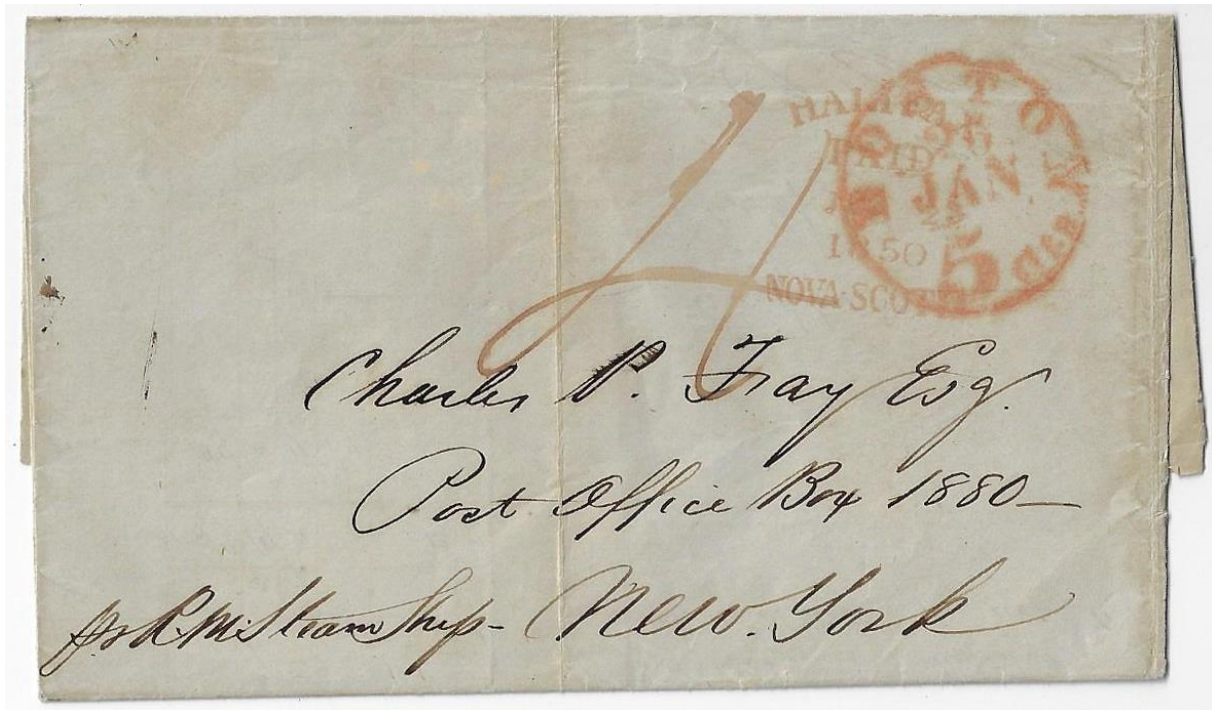
Item 576-04 – **Halifax to Le Have Nova Scotia** – 1842, business folded letter, datelined DE 27 41, mailed from Halifax rated 7d collect to Le Have. A pretty strike! \$50.00 **SOLD**



Item 576-05 – **Digby Nova Scotia to Charles Budd** – 1849, folded letter from Digby N.S., signed H. Stewart, paid 1/6 to Halifax. The letter is addressed to Charles Budd, a merchant and political figure in Nova Scotia. He represented Digby township in the Nova Scotia House of Assembly from 1830 to 1836 and 1840 to 1851. He served in a loyalist regiment during the American Revolution. After retiring from politics, Budd served as registrar of probate for Digby County. A nice Halifax Tombstone as receiver. Digby (b/s). \$75.00



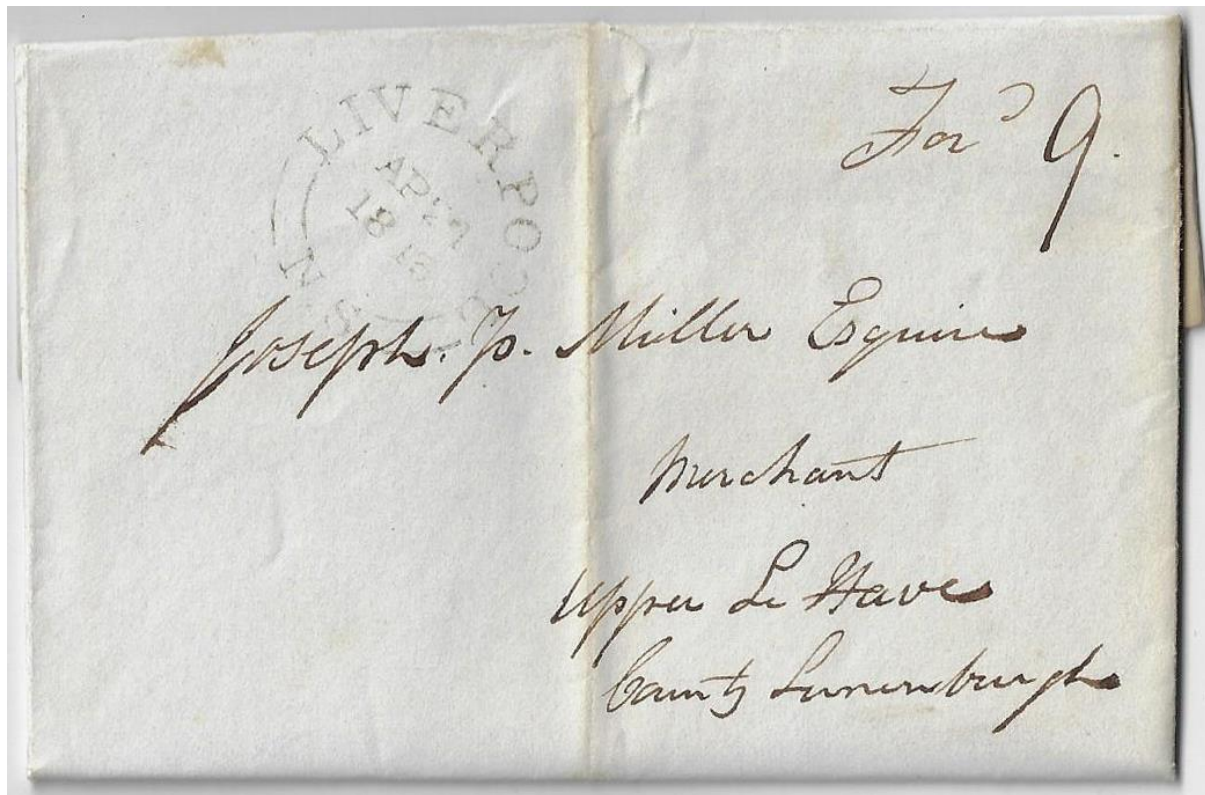

Item 576-10 – **1¢ Decimal – Hamilton CW** – 1866, 1¢ Decimal tied by Hamilton CW broken circle on cover, struck in blue, paying 1¢ drop letter rate. Slightly reduced at right but a nice strike! \$75.00



Item 576-11 – **The only recorded Bartonville UC** - 1866, 1¢ Decimal tied by Hamilton Berri duplex cancel on bank of BNA folded printed letter paying 1¢ circular rate to Bartonville (b/s). This is the only recorded Bartonville UC postmark (Wentworth County). Staining at top. \$200.00 **SOLD**



Item 576-12 – **St. Francois de Beauce registered to Charlevoix** – 1865, 5¢ Beaver tied by concentric ring cancel on cover from St. Francois de Beauce paying 5¢ letter rate to Murray Bay with registry fee paid in cash. Quebec transit (b/s). \$175.00



Item 576-13 – **Seaforth CW in blue (Huron)** – 1865, 5¢ Beaver tied by large grid cancel on cover from Seaforth CW paying 5¢ letter rate to Goderich (b/s). \$75.00

Carried by Steamship La Bretagne via New York. Once in France, redirected to Florence Italy (b/s). Ex Bowen. \$700.00



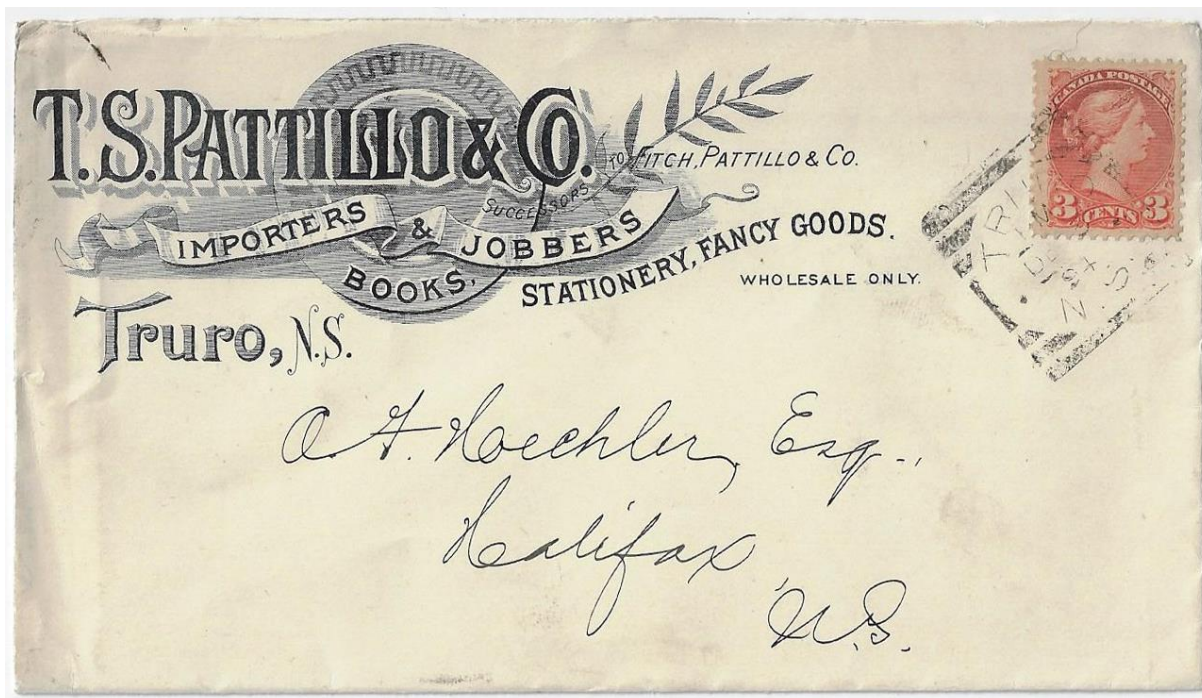
