

Item 578-01 – Nova Scotia - 15¢ rate to California via Panama – 1866, NS 5¢, 10¢ (Sc 10,12) tied by oval grid cancel on cover from Windsor NS paying 15¢ letter rate to San Francisco, California. No Windsor postmark shown, routed via Halifax (b/s) and directed by Steamer from New York then through the Panama route. A rare rate for delivery beyond 3000 miles. Expertization New York Philatelic Foundation #0295453 (genuinely used on cover). Exhibit quality. \$1,250.00




Item 578-02 – Nova Scotia 3d dark blue – 1855, NS 3d dark blue just clear to large margins tied by mute grid cancel on cover from Halifax, dated MY 24 55, paying 3d letter rate to Bridgetown (b/s). Docketing notes indicate that the cover is from Fairbanks & Allison's (the exports and imports Halifax firm). Edge staining and aging. \$250.00





Item 578-03 – <u>Brock UC Money Letter</u> – 1849, folded money letter from Brock UC paid 11½d to Goderich (b/s) via Scarboro, Hamilton and Toronto (b/s). A scarce Ontario County office 1836-1869. Exhibit piece! \$250.00 **SOLD** 



Item 578-04 – Grenville LC (Argenteuil) – 1846, folded cover from Grenville LC rated 4½d collect to Montreal. A great strike. Ex Lussey. \$45.00



Item 578-05 – <u>Ste. Anne de la Perade LC (Champlain)</u> – 1853, folded cover from Ste. Anne de la Perade LC rated 3d collect to Quebec (b/s). \$35.00 <u>SOLD</u>



Item 578-06 – <u>Cap Santé LC (Portneuf)</u> – 1861, stampless cover from Cap Santé LC, a late use of the hammer 1, rated 7¢ collect to Quebec (b/s). \$60.00



Item 578-07 – <u>Legislative Assembly (William Scott) – Deux-Montages/St. Eustache</u> – 1851, stampless from the Legislative Assembly (seat in Toronto) rated 1/4 Currency / 1/2 Sterling to England (receiver on front). Signed by MPP William Scott. Scott was a businessman. He was born in Scotland growing up in Montreal. He became a merchant at Saint-Eustache and a member of the militia, but was dismissed in 1827 for participating in meetings supporting the Parti Patriote. He was elected for York. Viewed as a traitor. He fled but was arrested at Montreal in 1837. In 1844, he was elected to the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Canada for Deux-Montagnes. \$300.00





Item 578-08 – <u>Brougham CW in blue (Ontario)</u> – 1865, 10¢ Consort with large left margin tied by matching concentric ring cancel in blue, same ink, paying 10¢ cross border to U.S. Ontario County office. Back flap off and repairs. \$300.00

Item 578-09 – <u>Altona UC latest recorded (Ontario)</u> – 1877, 3¢ SQ, 2¢ RLS both tied by fancy cancel and concentric ring cancel on cover from Altona UC paying 5¢ registered letter rate to Armadale. Stouffville and Unionville transit (b/s), Registered T&N (b/s). Light reduction but still a pretty 1877 RLS cover and a very scarce postmark. \$250.00



Item 578-10 – <u>York Ont latest recorded date (Haldimand)</u> – 1897, 3¢ SQ tied by York Ont broken circle on cover paying 3¢ letter rate to Hamilton (b/s). This is the latest recorded date for this hammer, by 3 years. \$40.00




Item 578-11 – <u>Dunnville Ont (Haldimand)</u> – 1880, 3¢ SQ tied by fancy cancel on cover from Dunnville Ont, John Whitmore Insurance c/c, paying 3¢ letter rate to Stromness (b/s). \$60.00




Item 578-12 – <u>Luther Ont 1860-1885 (Dufferin)</u> – 1876, 3¢ SQ tied by target cancel on cover from Luther Ont, all struck in blue, paying 3¢ letter rate to Toronto. A very scarce Dufferin office. 1860-1885. \$75.00 SOLD




Item 578-13 – <u>Luther Ont 1860-1885 (Dufferin)</u> – 1873, 3¢ SQ tied by fancy cancel on cover from Luther Ont, all struck in blue, paying 3¢ letter rate to Toronto. One of the nicest from this very scarce Dufferin office. 1860-1885. \$125.00





Item 578-14 – <u>Campania Ont 1894-1912 (Dufferin)</u> – 1897, 8¢ SQ tied by Campania Ont broken circle on Massey-Harris cover paying 8¢ registered letter rate to Toronto. Tor & Owen Sound (b/s). Bowling Green (b/s). Very scarce. \$100.00 SOLD



Item 578-15 – <u>Stromness Ont the ERD by 11 years (Haldimand)</u> – 1878, 3¢ SQ tied by Stromness Ont broken circle on cover, shorter letters, paying 3¢ letter rate to Caledonia (b/s) via Seneca (b/s). An interesting discovery making the earliest recorded down by 11 years. Office closed in 1914. \$50.00



Item 578-16 – Horning's Mills Ont the ERD by 8 years (Dufferin) – 1882, 3¢ SQ sulfurized tied by target cancel on cover from Horning's Mills Ont paying 3¢ letter rate to Collingwood (b/s). This is the new earliest recorded date, by 8 years. \$75.00



Item 578-17 – <u>Tyneside Ont the only recorded example (Haldimand)</u> – 1875, 1¢, 2¢ SQ tied by target cancel on cover from Tyneside Ont, manuscript date NO 25 75, paying 3¢ letter rate to Toronto (b/s). Hamilton and Glamford (b/s). The only known example. \$200.00



Item 578-18 – <u>Ravenswood Ont (Lambton)</u> – 1896, 8¢ SQ tied by Ravenswood Ont broken circle on Rennie cover paying 8¢ registered letter rate to Toronto (b/s). Forest transit and carried by Tor & Sar MC (b/s). \$60.00 SOLD



Item 578-19 – Florence Ont Canada, LRD (Lambton) – 1891, 3¢ SQ tied by grid cancel on cover from Florence Ont (3-part dater with Canada, the new latest recorded date, JU 22 91) paying 3¢ letter rate to London (b/s). J.C. Lawrence Manufacaturers of and Dealer in Hardware, Stoves, Tinware. \$75.00 SOLD



Item 578-20 – Quebec manufacturers of boots and shoes – 1895, 3¢ SQ tied by Quebec duplex cancel on Migner & Goulet Boots & Shoes advertising cover paying 3¢ letter rate to Moncton (b/s). \$100.00



Item 578-21 – Mansfield Ont (Dufferin) – 1897, 3¢ SQ tied by Mansfield Ont broken circle on cover paying 3¢ letter arte to Toronto (b/s). Exhibit strike. \$75.00



Item 578-22 – <u>Marsville Ont registered (Dufferin)</u> – 1896, 3¢, 5¢ SQ tied by by smudge cancel on cover from Marsville Ont paying 8¢ registered letter rate to Toronto (b/s). Elora (b/s) and Street & Elora M.C. North (b/s). \$100.00 <u>SOLD</u>



Item 578-23 – <u>Fawn Ont 1874-1904 (Ontario)</u> – 1895, 1¢ SQ (3) tied by Fawn Ont broken circle on cover paying 3¢ letter rate to Toronto (b/s). This is the latest recorded date of this only Fawn Ontario hammer. \$50.00 <u>SOLD</u>



Item 578-24 – Rockton CW 11¢ registered to U.S. – 1873, 2¢, 3¢, 6¢ SQ (Ottawa, perf 12) tied by Rockton CW broken circle on cover paying 11¢ double weight registered letter rate to U.S. via Dundas. Carried by GWR with boxed Registered G.W.R. Choice! \$500.00





Item 578-25 – Farnham Que Collier's Hotel – 1886, 3¢ SQ, 2¢ RLS tied by grid cancel on Farnham Collier's Hotel c/c cover, mailed in Stanbridge Station CE (Berri hammer), paying 5¢ registered letter rate to Dickinson's Landing Ont (b/s) via Cornwall (b/s). \$85.00






Item 578-27 – <u>Bingham Road Ont (Haldimand)</u> – 1897, 3¢ SQ tied by fancy dotted cancel on cover from Bingham Road ont paying 3¢ letter rate to Hamilton (b/s). This postmark is recorded from OC 5 95 to AP 2 98. Office closed in 1915. \$40.00



Item 578-28 – <u>Colinville Ont the LRD (Lambton)</u> – 1896, 3¢ SQ tied by grid cancel on from Colinville Ont paying 3¢ letter rate to Toronto (b/s) via Sarnia (b/s). This is the latest recorded date for this hammer. Closed in 1914. \$50.00 **SOLD** 




