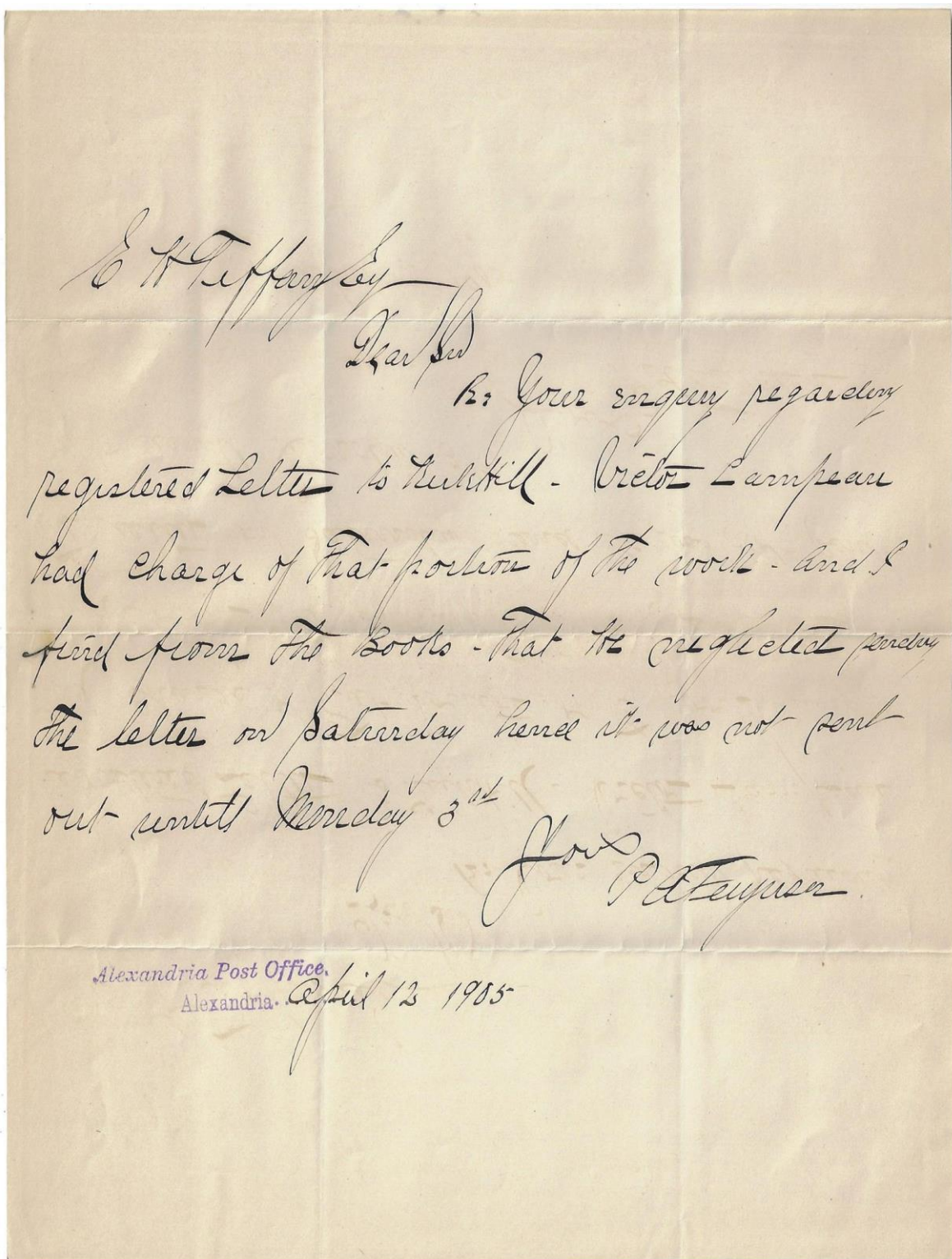

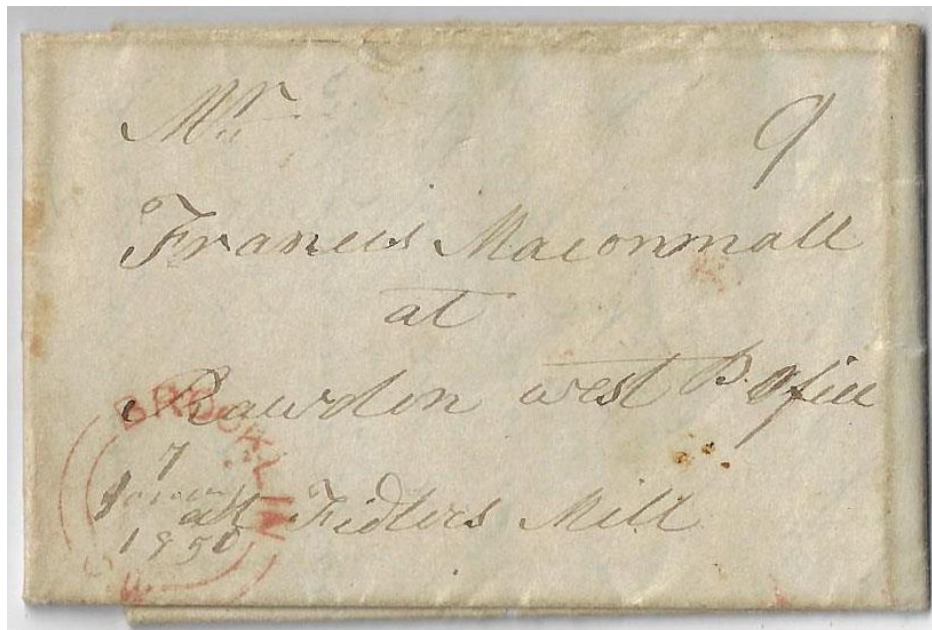

Item 583-01 – Alexandria Ont Post Office (GGY) – 1905, letter from the postmaster, Alexandria Ontario Post Office, dated April 12 1905 and signed by Peter A. Ferguson to E.H. Tiffany. \$150.00

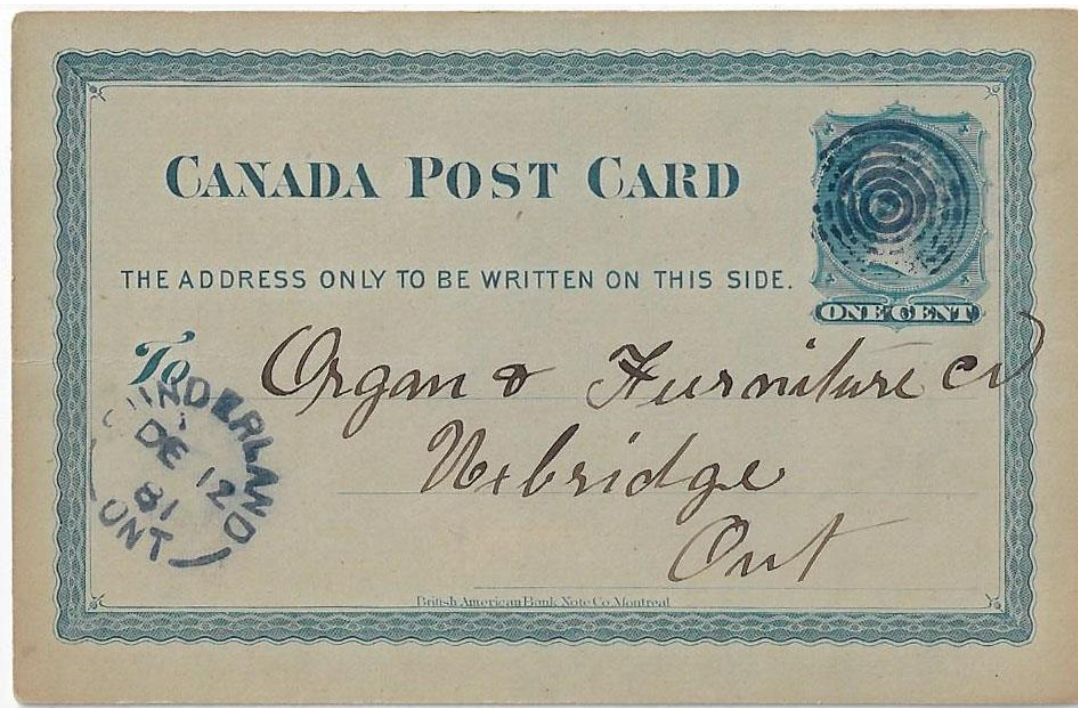

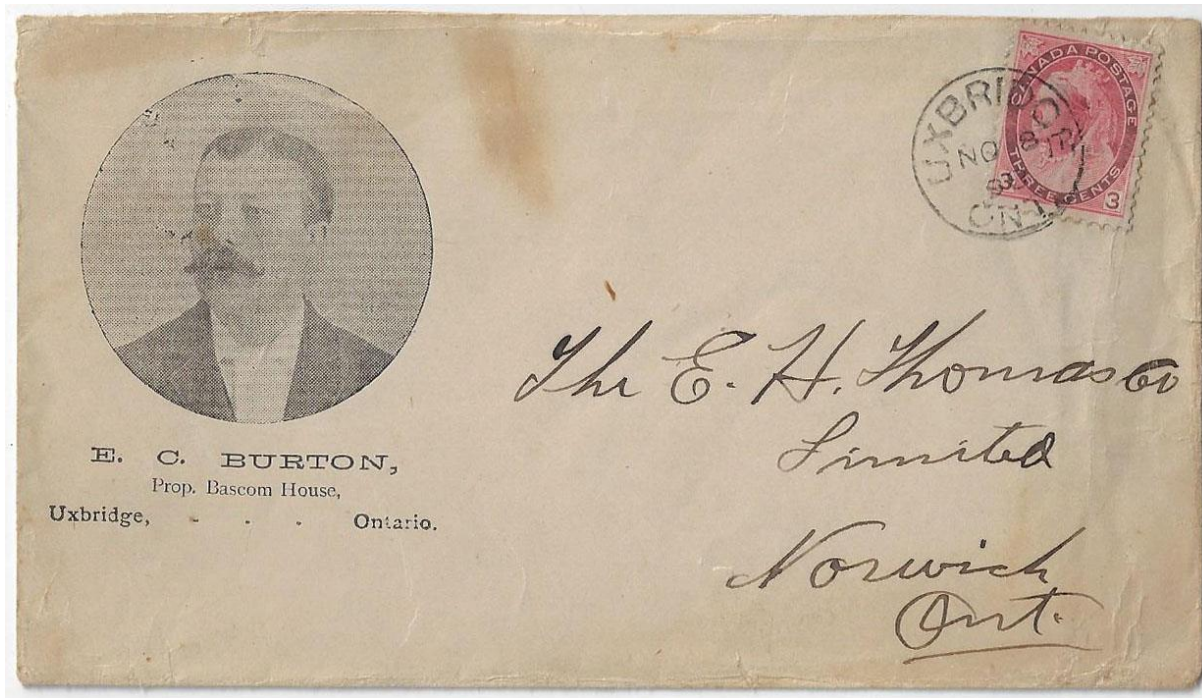

This is the earliest recorded date of all Sunderland markings (AP 2 71). The rare Nevis CW Berri hammer as receiver. \$200.00 **SOLD**



Item 583-04 – **Sunderland Ont in blue (Ontario)** – 1881, 1¢ stationery card from Sunderland Ont (*struck in blue*) paying 1¢ PC rate to Uxbridge. The card is addressed to the Uxbridge Organ Co. and relates to a furniture piece. \$50.00 **SOLD**



Item 583-05 – **"U" Uxbridge fancy cancel (Ontario)** – 1887, 3¢ SQ tied "U" fancy cancel on cover from Uxbridge Ont paying 3¢ letter rate to Deer Park in Toronto (b/s). Some paper lost at back flap. Rare. \$125.00 **SOLD**

Item 583-07 – **Uxbridge High School advertising (Ontario)** – 1891, 3¢ SQ cancelled by cork cancel on Uxbridge High School advertising cover paying 3¢ letter rate to Port Essington BC, Victoria transit (b/s). \$200.00 **SOLD**



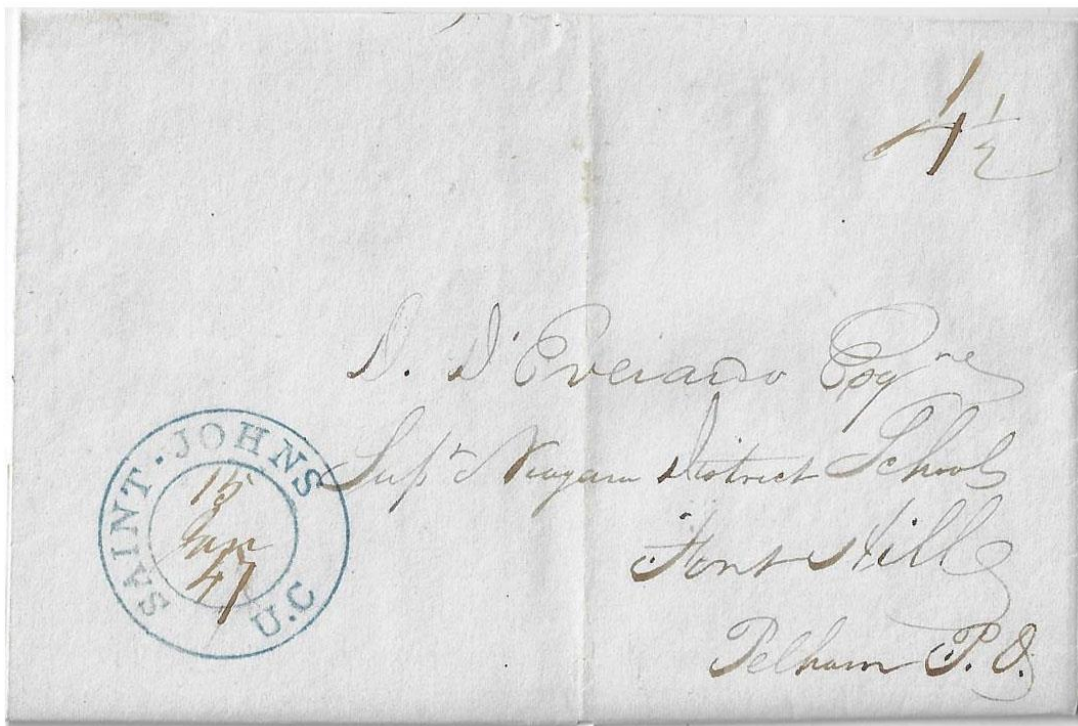

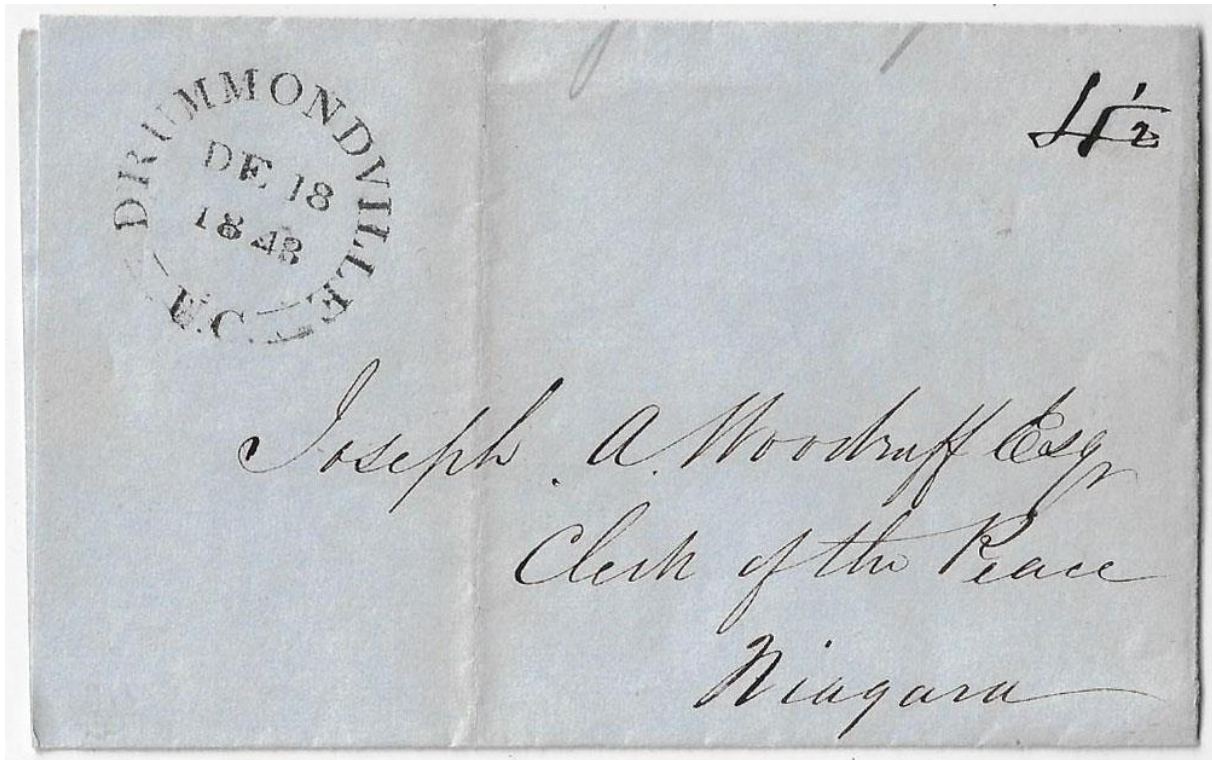
Item 583-09 – **Port Dalhousie UC (Lincoln)** – 1838, money letter from Port Dalhousie UC, undated double circle in black rated 1/9 to Toronto. The letter is datelined Customs House Port Dalhousie 12 July 1838, signed by the collector John Clark. \$200.00



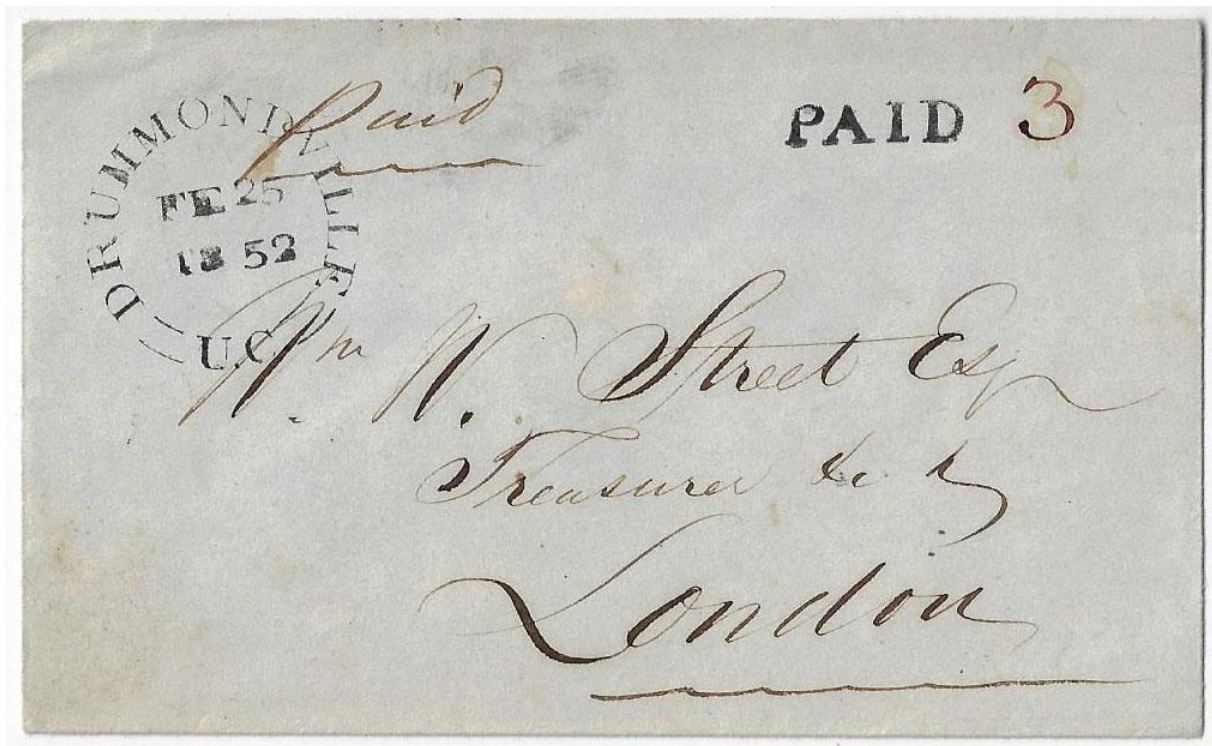
Item 583-10 – **St. John's UC manuscript (Welland)** – 1832, folded cover from St. John's UC rated 7d collect to York. St. John's UC is a very tough office, 1831-1851. This manuscript postmark is the latest recorded date of a few known example. (MR 1 1832 to MY 29 1832). \$300.00



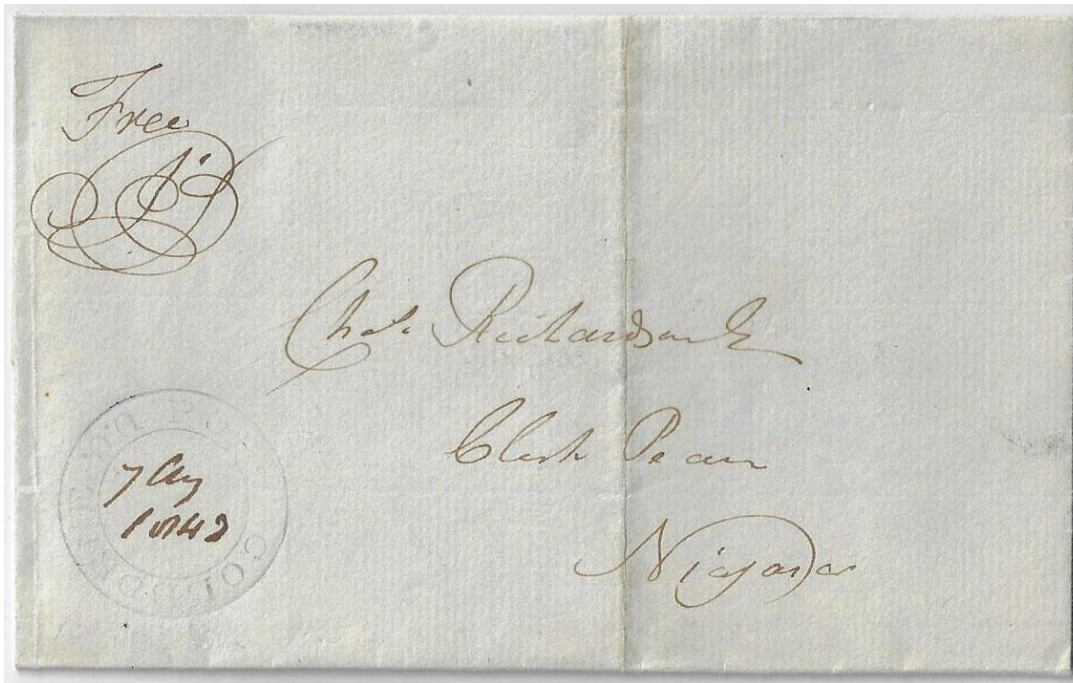
Item 583-11 – **Saint Johns UC double circle in blue (Welland)** – 1847, folded letter from St. John's UC rated 4½d collect to Fonthill. This is a rare Upper Canada postmark, in the highest level of quality. 1831-1851. The letter relates to Niagara Dist School trustee and the election of Russell Rich. \$500.00

The Post Office was established specially for the tour of the Mackenzie District by Governor General of Canada, John Buchan (Lord Tweedsmuir). The ship was built at Fort Smith in 1920 and abandoned in 1946. The tour began in Waterways Alberta on July 21 and then via the S.S. Distributor on July 23 at Fort Smith. To Fort Resolution across Great Slave Lake and down the Mackenzie River to Aklavik, returning to Fort Smith on August 16. The cover is signed by the pilot McMullen and the Postal Superintendent Hale. \$150.00



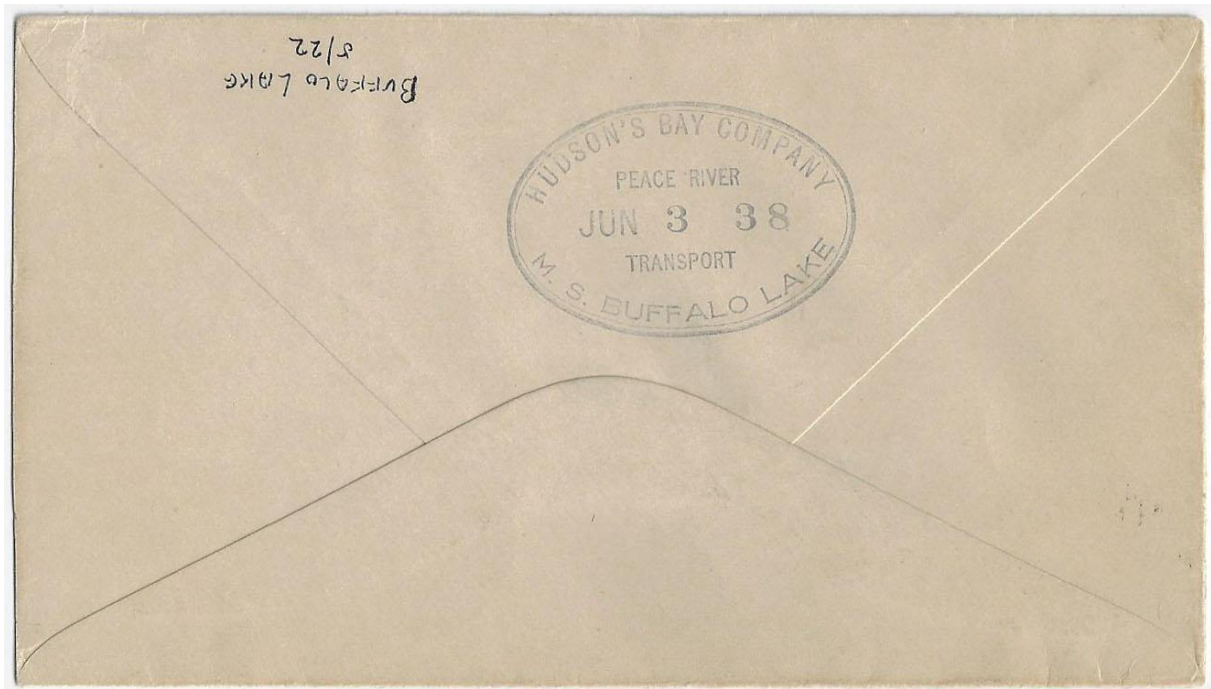

Return address OIC Radiosonde Station, Dept of Transport. *Meteorological observations.* \$60.00 **SOLD**



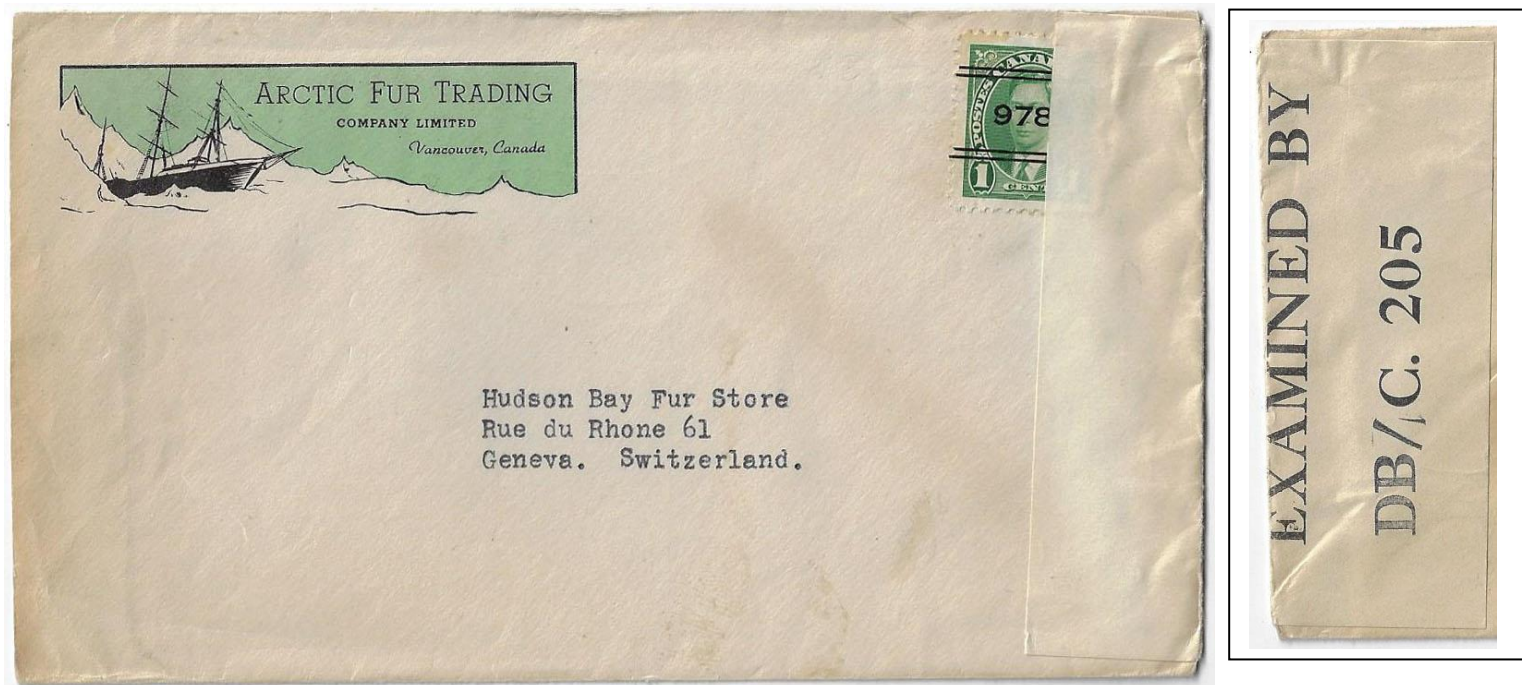
