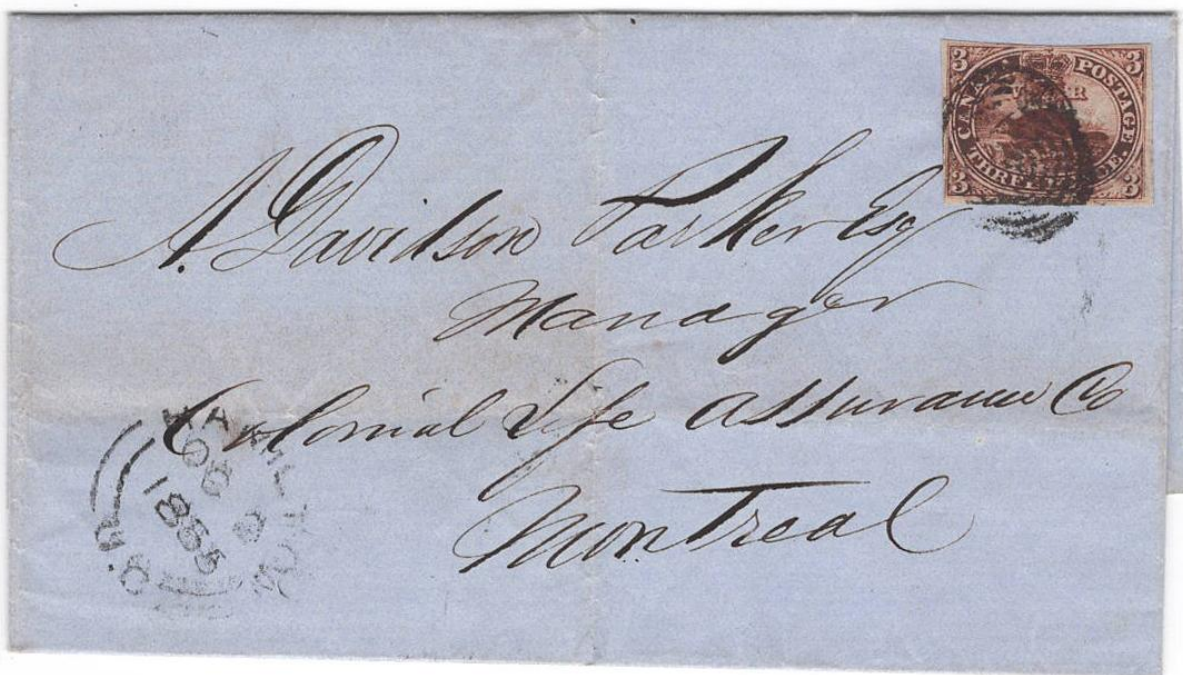

Item 645-01 – **England to Vittoria - District of Talbot** – 1846, stampless cover from England to Vittoria UC rated 1/2 Stg. Carried by Cunard Cambria from Liverpool FE 4 46 to Boston. Endorsed via Halifax. Vittoria manuscript postmark as receiver dated FE 27 46 (b/s). The ship arrived in Halifax on the 17th and Boston on 18th. Most likely a winter trip from Boston. \$100.00



Item 645-02 – **Hamilton 3d Beaver use** – 1855, 3d Beaver tied by concentric ring cancel on folded cover from Hamilton paying 3d letter rate to Montreal. \$200.00 **SOLD**



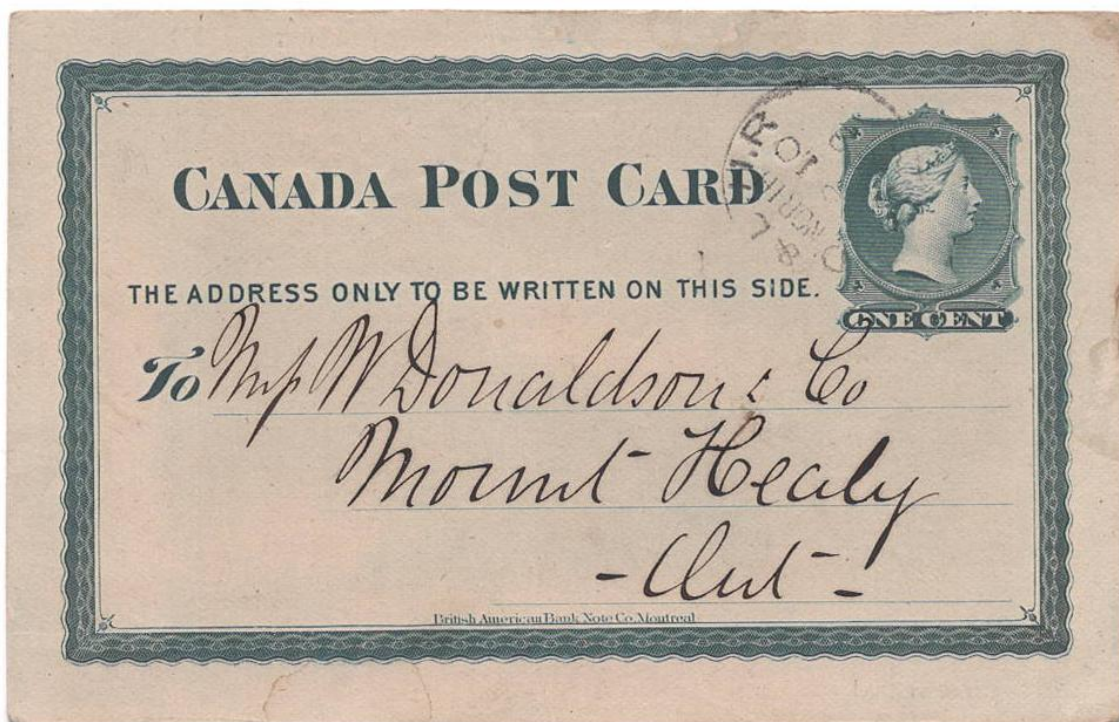
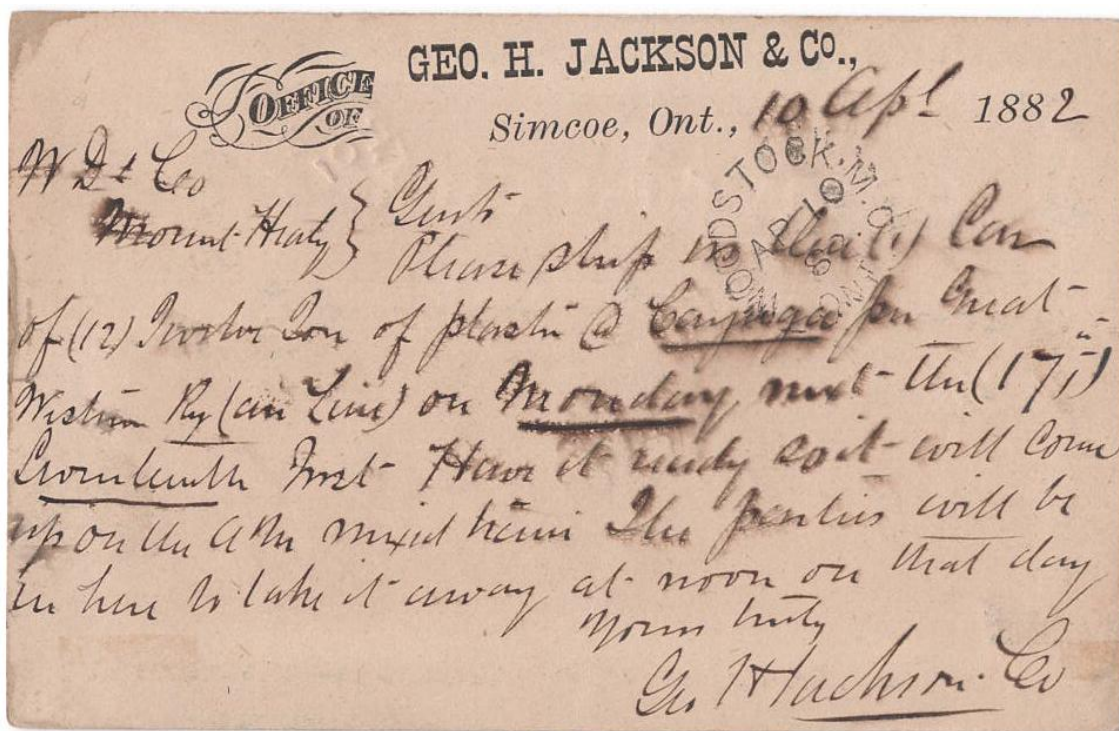
Item 645-03 – **Four ring 30 Peterboro** – 1860, 5c Beaver (*an early printing*) tied by Four ring 30 cancel on cover from Peterboro CW paying 5c letter rate to Toronto (b/s). \$150.00 **SOLD**



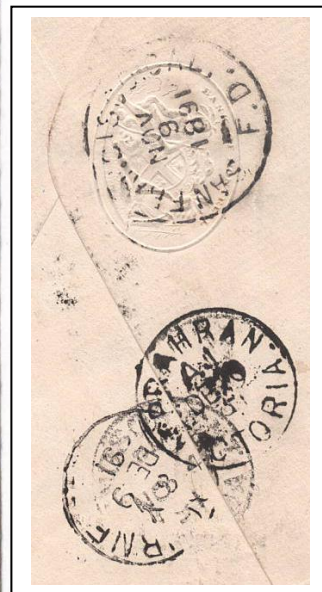
Item 645-04 – Two ring 14 Guelph Ont – 1869, 3¢ Large Queen tied by Two ring 14 cancel on cover from Guelph paying 3¢ letter rate to Hamilton. \$100.00 **SOLD**



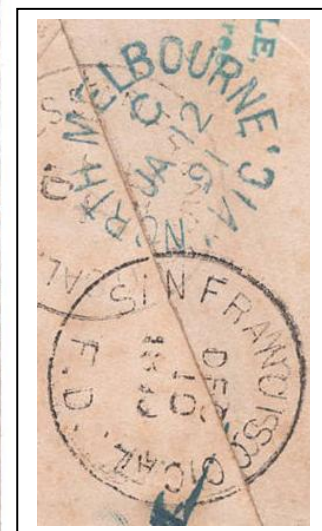
Item 645-05 – British Association private postcard (for the advancement of science) – 1897, 1¢ SQ tied by Toronto Bickerdike machine cancel on British Association private postcard paying 1¢ postcard rate to New Hampshire. Such cards to the U.S. were not authorized until JA 1 98. \$150.00 **SOLD**



Item 645-06 – **Port Dover & Lake Huron Railway** – 1882, 1¢ stationery card from Simcoe Ont, G.H. Jackson & Co. c/c, mailed on board Port Dover & Lake Huron Railway to Mouth Healy. Woodstock MO transit (b/s). P.D. & L.H.R. (North) AP 10 82. RF F, Gray RY-136 (1879-1887). Very scarce. \$100.00 **SOLD**



Item 645-07 – **10c double wgt UPU to Australia** – 1891, 2c, 3c, 5c SQ tied by Montreal duplex cancel on Bank of Montreal cover, dated NO 3 91, paying 10c double weight UPU letter rate to Australia (b/s). As customary routed via San Francisco (b/s). Australian colonies joined the UPU on OC 1 91. \$300.00



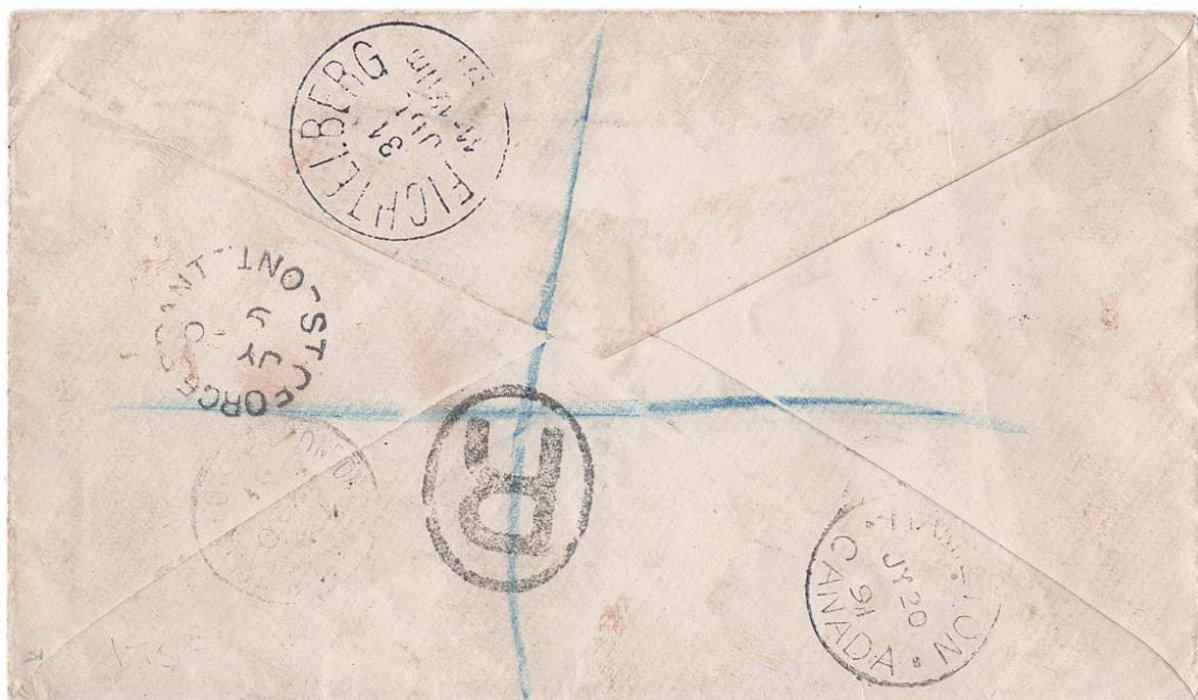
Item 645-08 – **12c pre-UPU letter rate to Australia** – 1891, 1c, 5c (2) tied by Montreal duplex cancel on 1c PSE paying 12c pre-UPU or non-UPU letter rate to Australia (b/s). Via San Francisco as usual (b/s). \$1,200.00



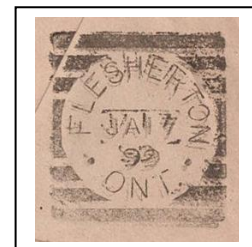
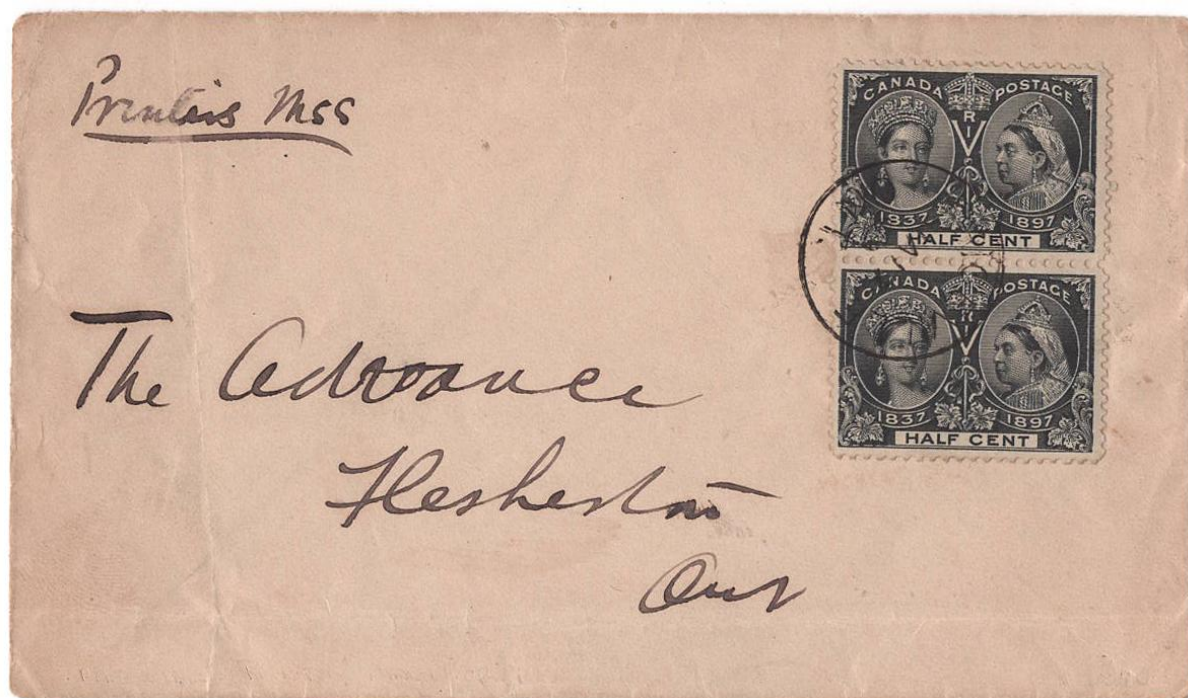
Item 645-09 – **16¢ registered letter rate to England** – 1874, 1¢, 3¢, 6¢ (2) tied by registered straightline on cover from Toronto paying 16¢ registered letter rate to England (8¢ + 8¢). Carried by Cunard Russia, entered in Liverpool as U.S. Packet and sent surface to London. Ugly but rare. \$1,500.00



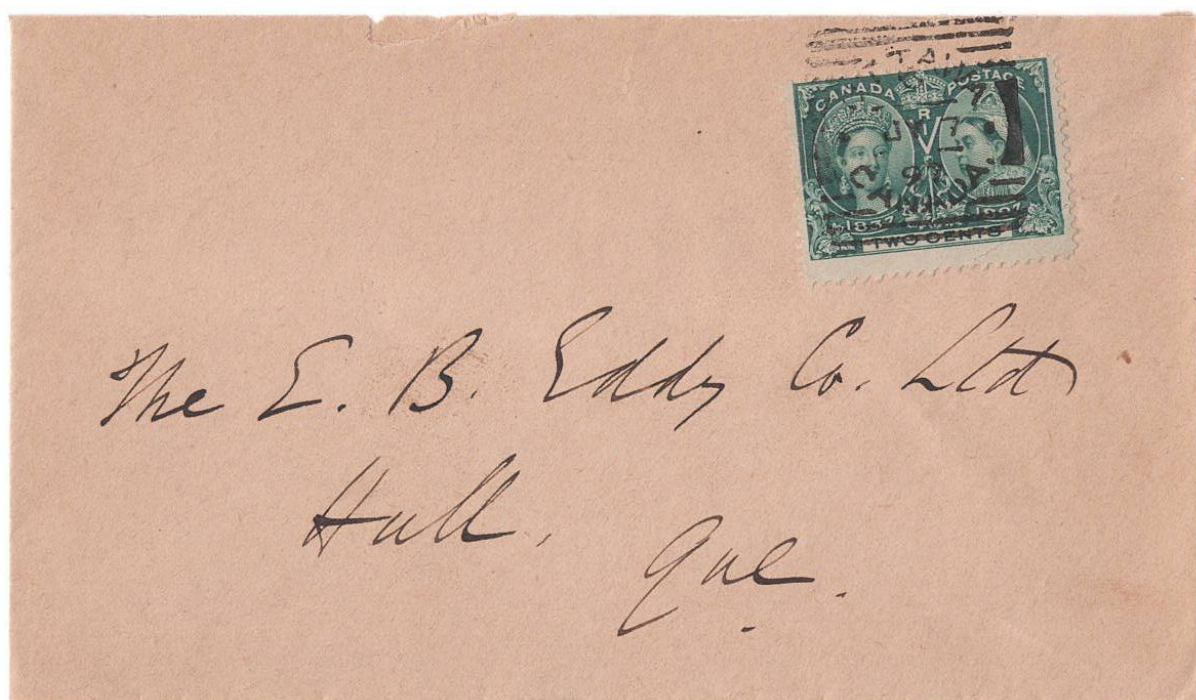
Item 645-10 – **2¢ RLS rose carmine (F1b)** – 1888, 3¢ SQ, 2¢ RLS (F1b, rose carmine, perf 12) tied by oval registered cancel on cover from Hamilton paying 5¢ registered letter rate to Clinton (b/s). RPO (b/s). The 8¢ registered domestic letter rate was effective May 8, 1889. Slightly reduced at right. \$150.00



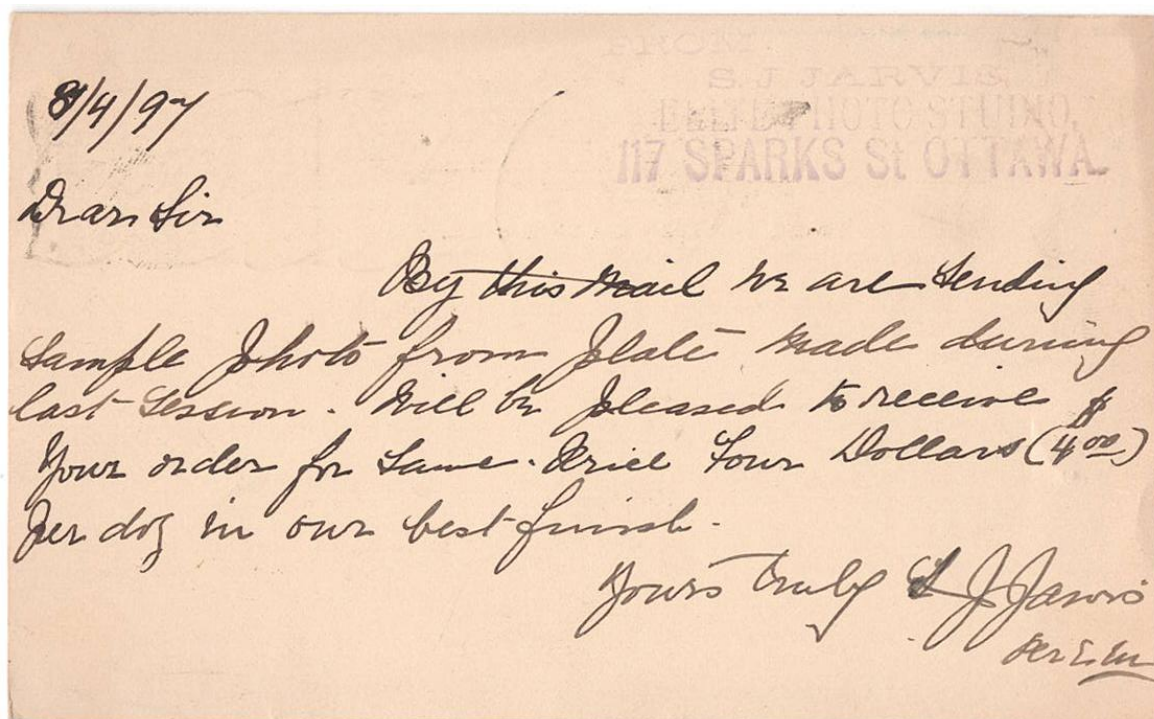
Item 645-11 – **10¢ UPU registered to Bavaria, Germany** – 1891, 5¢ SQ, 5¢ RLS tied by concentric ring cancel on cover from St. George Brant Ont paying 10¢ UPU registered letter rate to Germany (b/s). Via Hamilton and London England (b/s). \$400.00



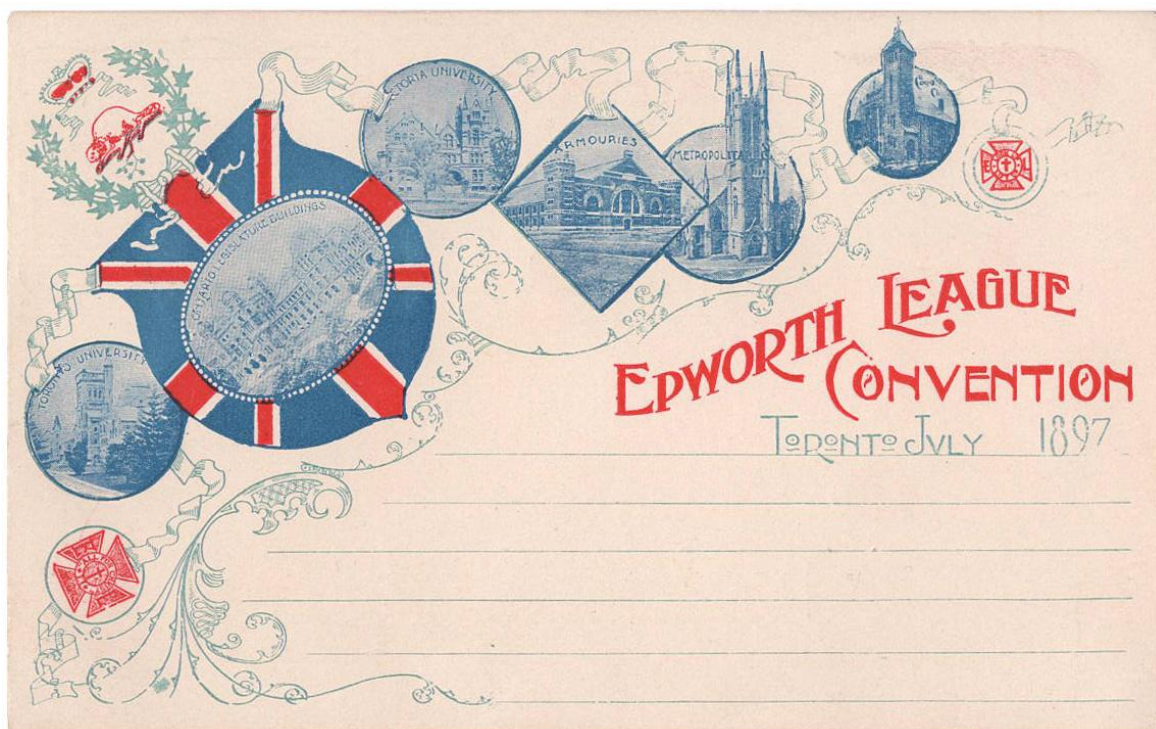
Item 645-12 – **Half cent Jubilee use** - 1899, ½¢ Jubilee vertical pair tied by Orangeville Ont cds on cover paying 1¢ printed matter rate to Flesherton (b/s). A tough one!! \$500.00



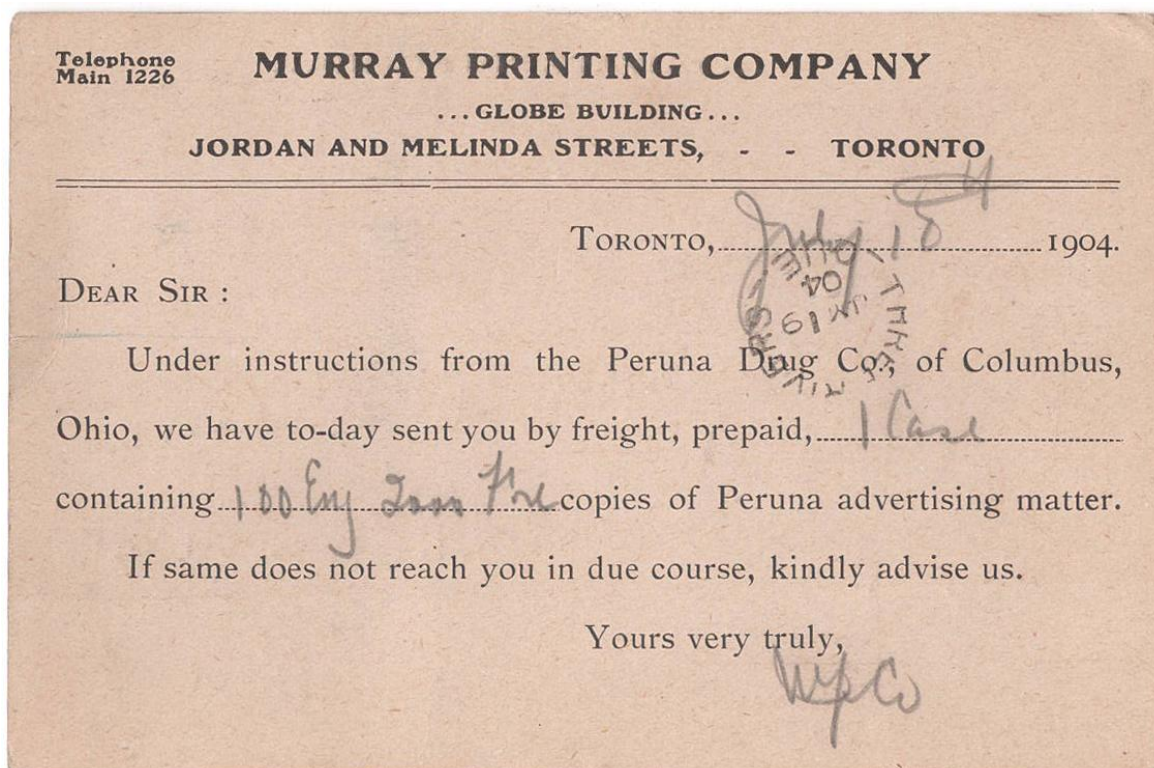
Item 645-13 – **Ottawa Hull 2¢ adjacent Post Office rate** – 1897, 2¢ Jubilee tied by Ottawa squared circle on cover paying 2¢ adjacent Post Office rate to Hull (b/s). Same day arrival. A very elusive Jubilee cover. Tiny opening tear at top. \$350.00



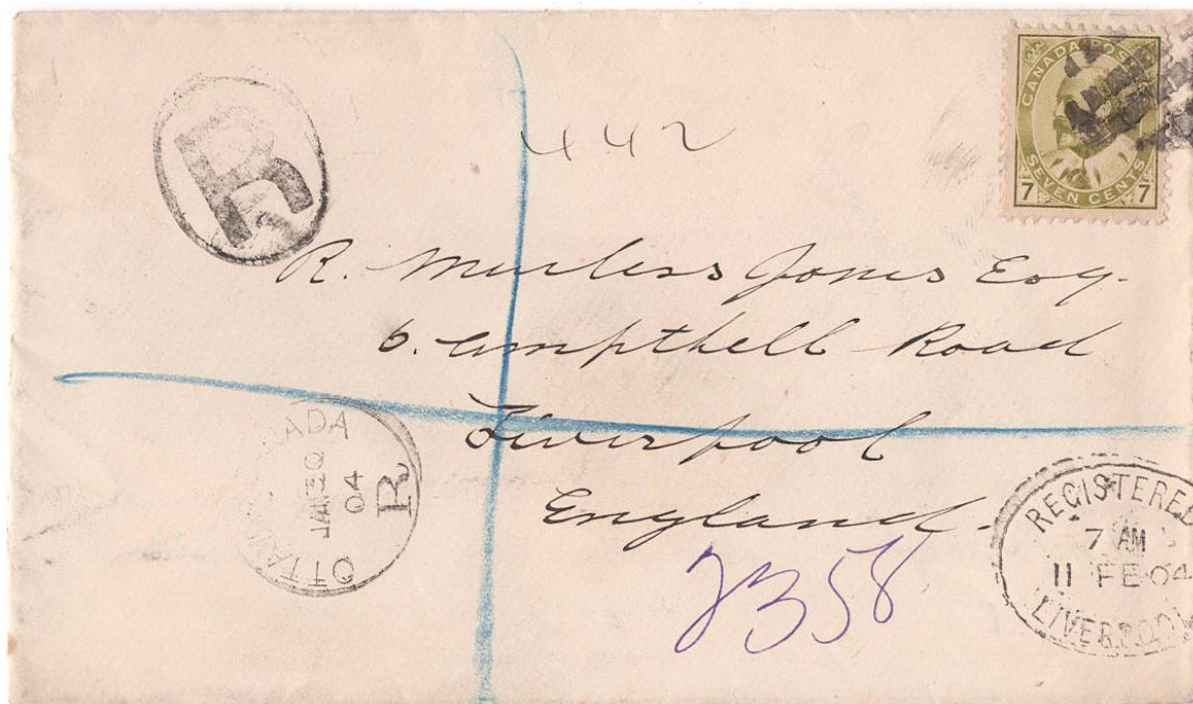
Item 645-14 – **Flag 4-6 commercial use** – 1897, 1¢ Jubilee stationery card mailed from Ottawa with flag 4-6 paying 1¢ postcard rate to Perth Centre NB. The card is from S.J. Jarvis Photo Studio. \$75.00 **SOLD**



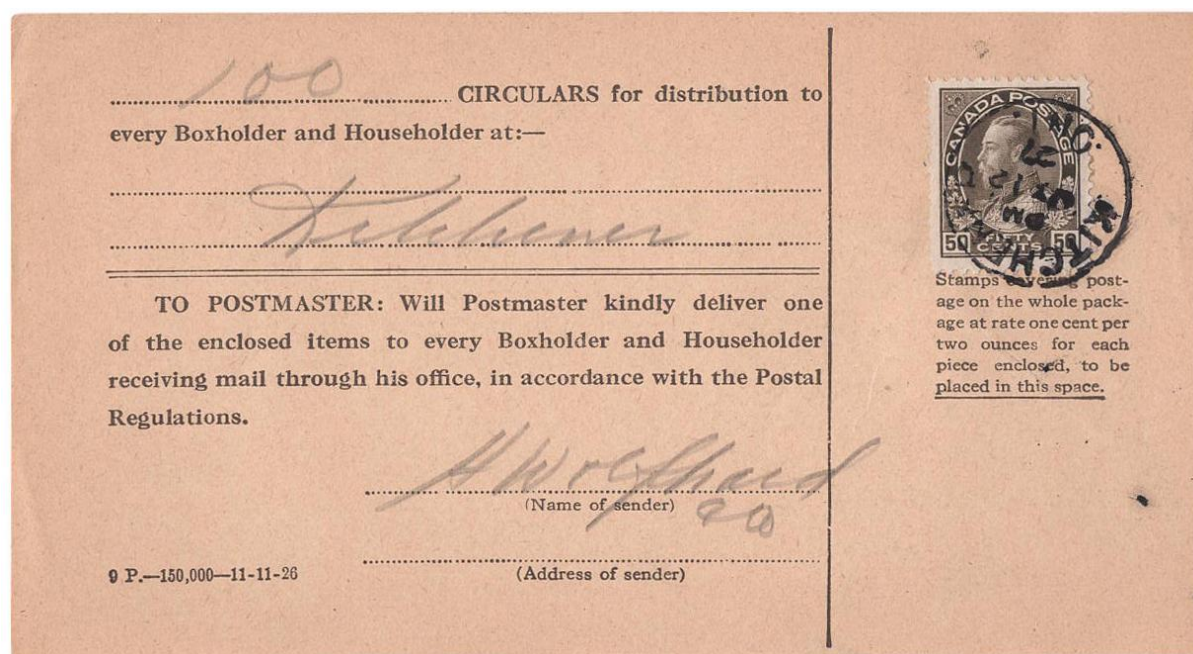
Item 645-15 – **Epworth League Convention** – 1897, 1¢ Jubilee precancel (T-51-D, Style T, double at bottom) on Epworth League Convention private postcard. Not written, unaddressed and not posted. The cards that I have seen were always from convention attendees. \$125.00



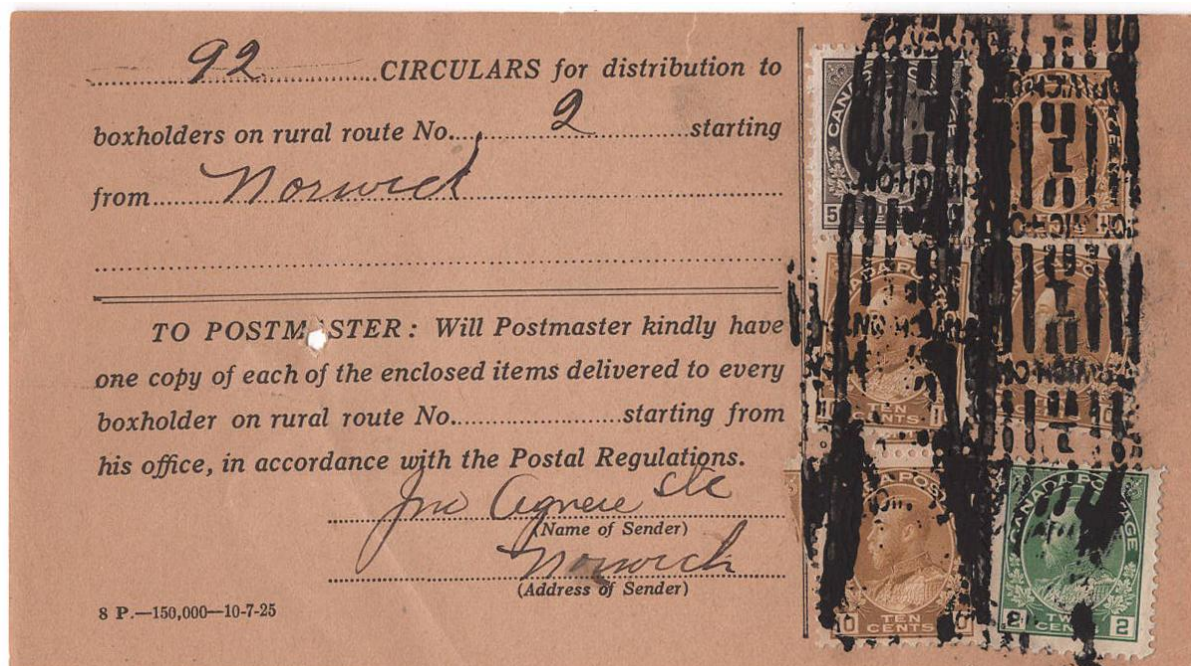
Item 645-16 – **Murray Printing Co.** – 1904, 1c Edward tied by Toronto machine cancel on Murray Printing Co. private postcard paying 1c postcard rate to Three Rivers (b/s). Message relates to advertising. \$50.00



Item 645-17 – **Ottawa 7¢ Empire registered to Liverpool** – 1904, 7¢ Edward tied by grid cancel on cover from Ottawa paying 7¢ Empire registered letter rate to Liverpool (receiver on front). \$75.00 **SOLD**



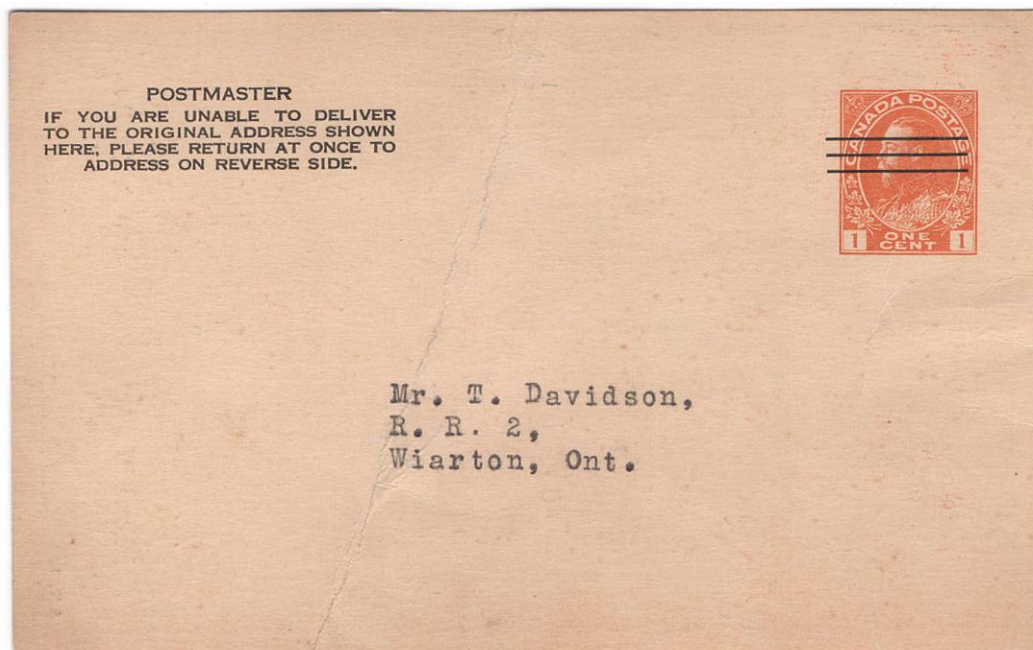
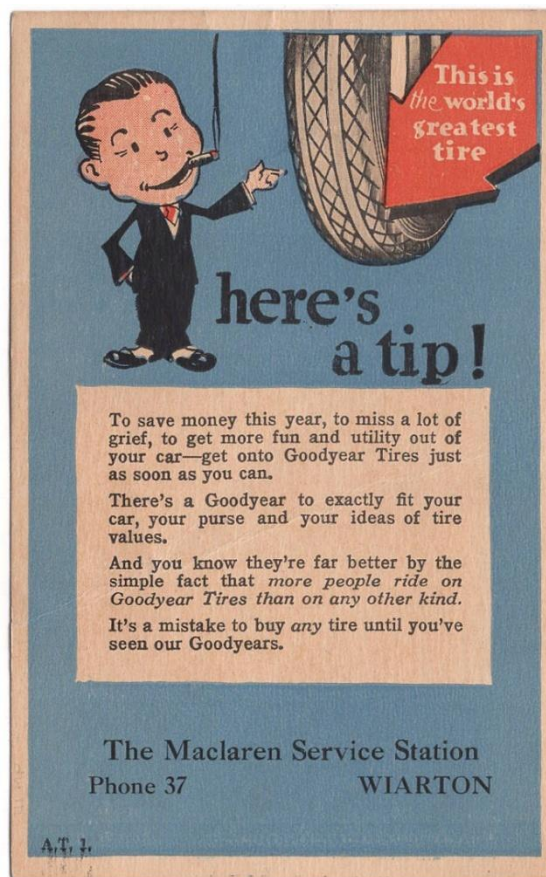
Item 645-18 – **50¢ Admiral single on circular receipt** – 1927, 50¢ Admiral single use tied by Kitchener Ont cds on circular receipt for distribution, ½¢ per circular. A nice clean example. \$60.00



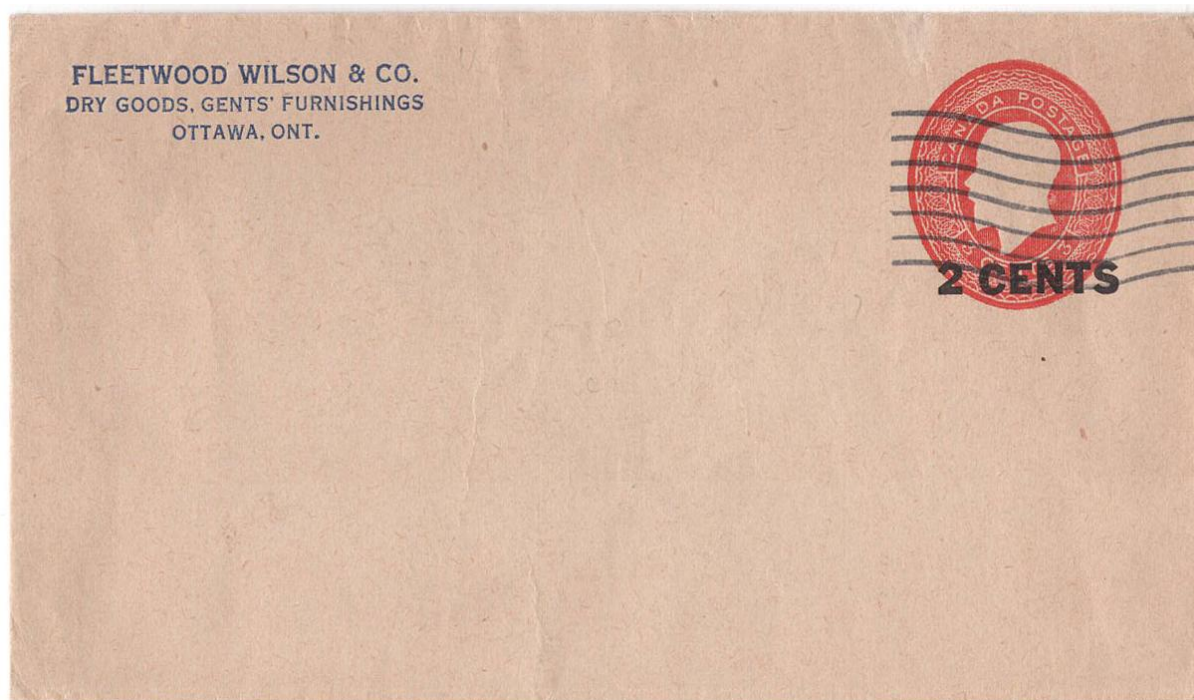
Item 645-19 – **Norwich Ont roller No.1** – c1925, 2¢, 10¢ (4), 50¢ Admiral tied by a heavy Norwich Ont roller No.1 on circular receipt for distribution, 1¢ per circular. \$50.00



Item 645-20 – **Water Motor Washer advertising** – 1914, 2¢ Admiral tied by Ottawa machine cancel on J.H. Connor & Son advertising cover, Water Motor Washer illustrated, paying 2¢ letter rate to Prescott (b/s). \$100.00



Item 645-21 – Warton Ontario card with private precancel added – c1921, 1¢ Admiral stationery card (die III) from Warton Ont, with private precancel added, paying 1¢ 3rd class matter rate to Warton rural route 2. Reverse with MacLaren Service Station advertising. Light crease. \$100.00



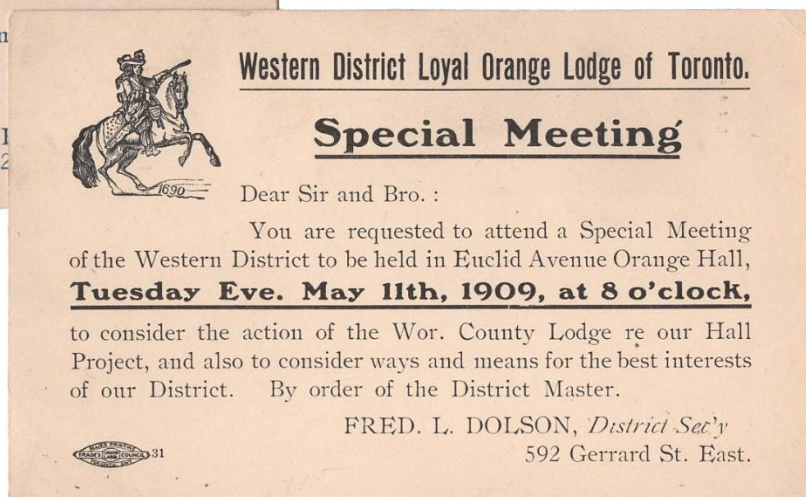
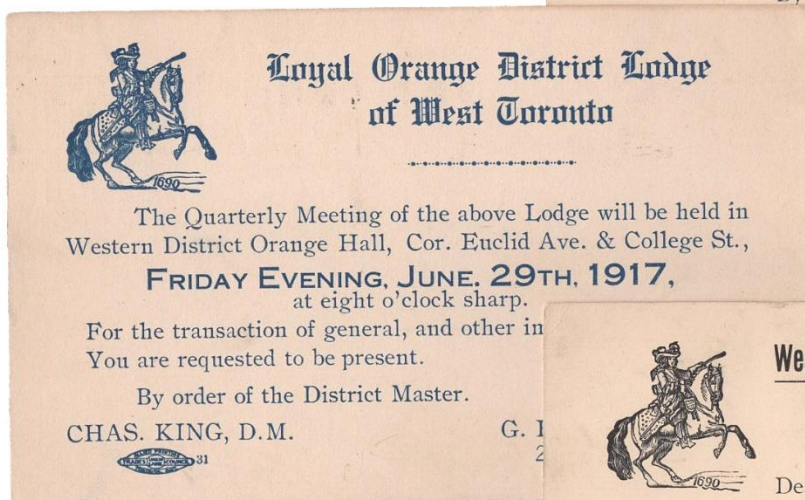
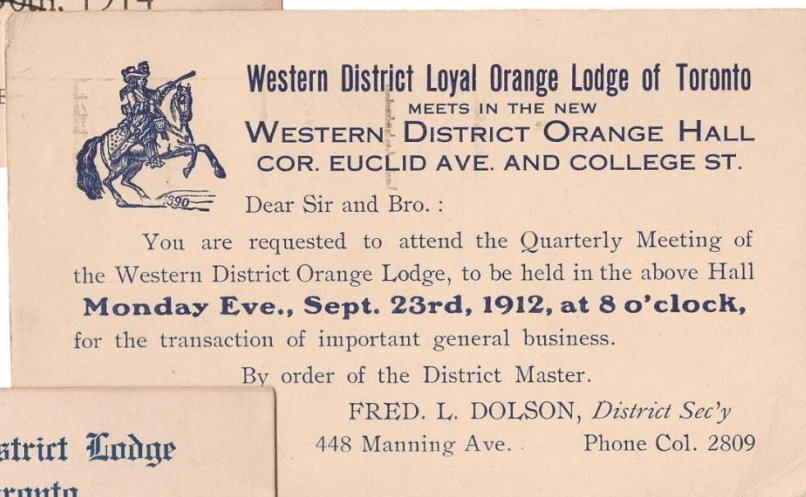
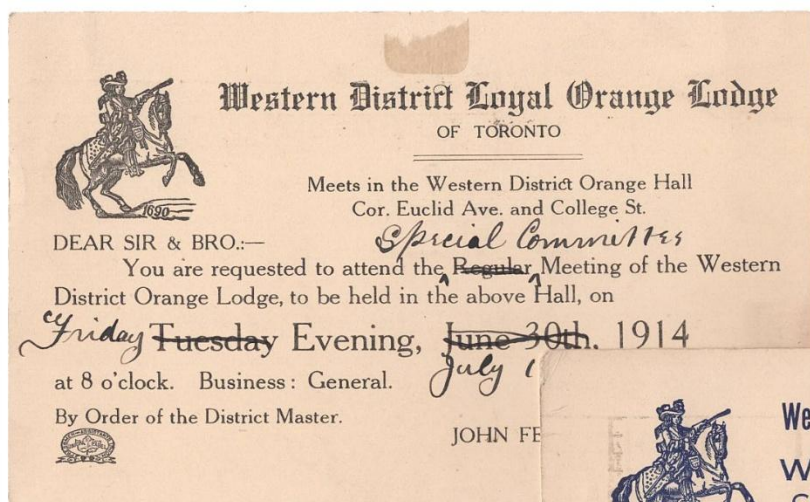

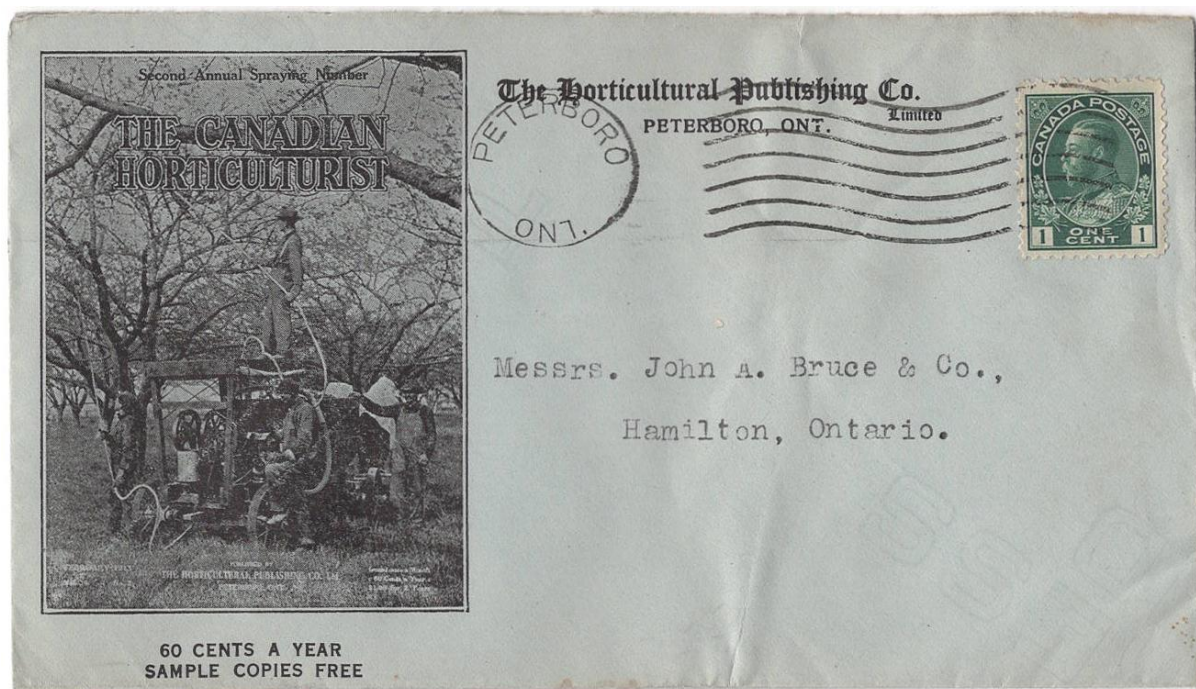
Item 645-23 – **St. Hyacinthe Que E1 cover (same day delivered)** – 1920, 1¢ (3), 10¢ Special Delivery E1 tied by St. Hyacinthe Que duplex cancel (time mark AM), cds free strike on front duplex on stamps, paying 13¢ special delivery letter rate to Montreal. Receiver 2:30 PM the same day. A late usage of the 1st printing. Ex Barlow. \$125.00



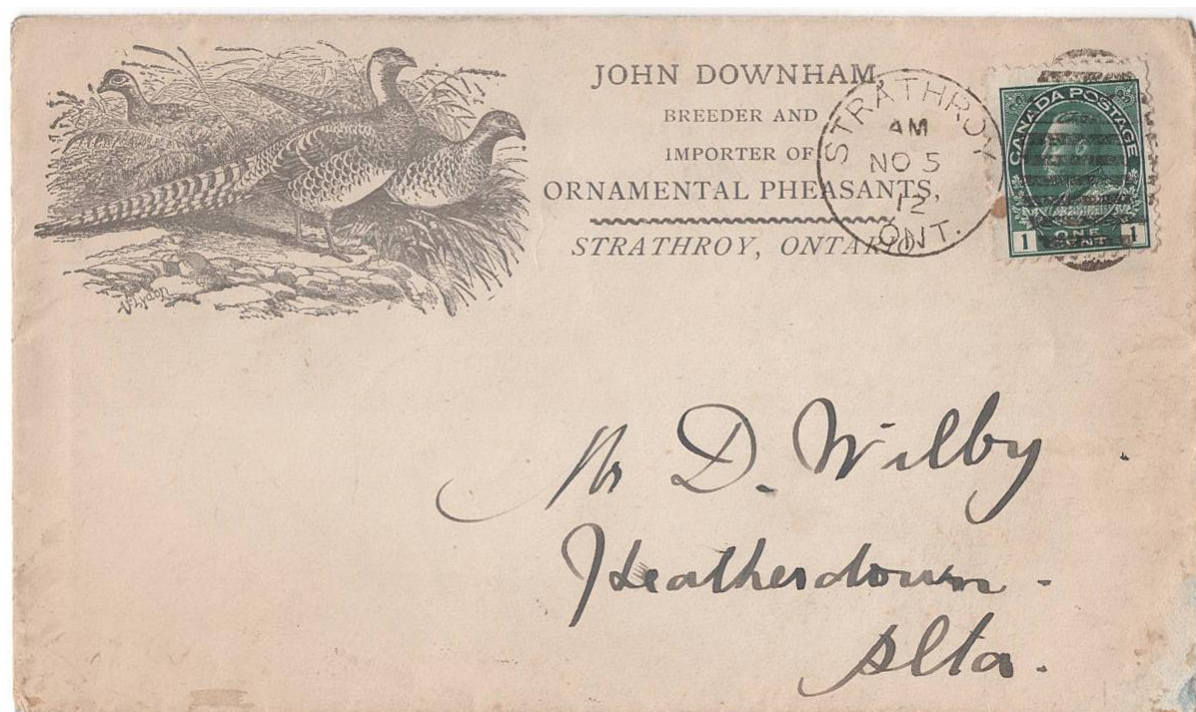
Item 645-24 – **Toronto AR form** – 1915, 1c, 2c (2) Admiral tied by West Toronto cds on Post Office Service *Avis de Reception* form paying 5c AR fee to Toronto. Text mentions Winnipeg and notice a partial Winnipeg Orb cancel. The office of origin section has a Postal Station D West Toronto cds dated FE 4 15 and with Toronto machine and oval registered cancels both dated FE 11 15. \$85.00 **SOLD**



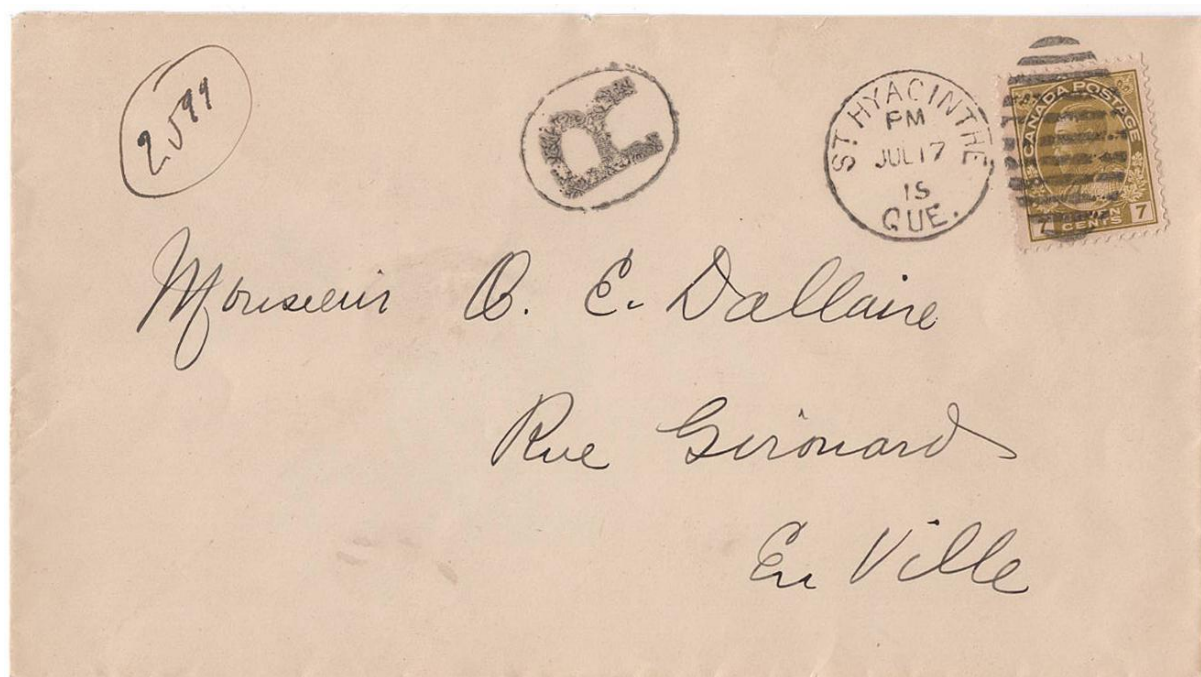

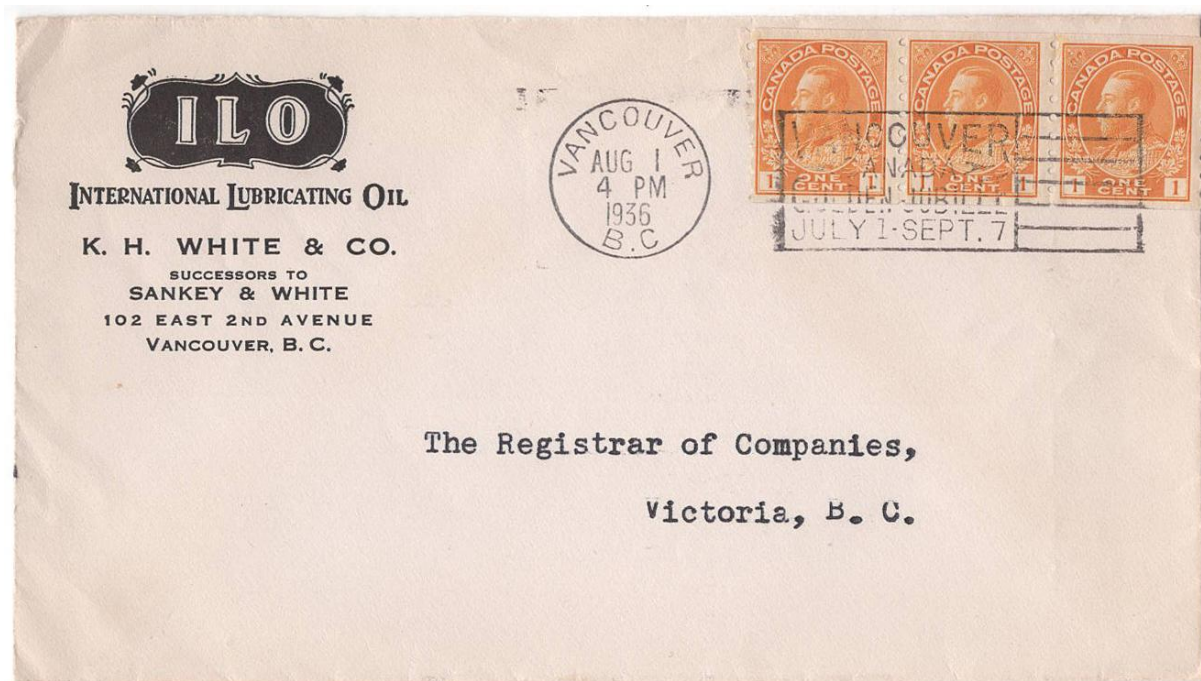

Item 645-28 – St. Hyacinthe 7¢ drop registered – 1915, 7¢ Admiral tied by St. Hyacinthe Que duplex cancel on cover paying 7¢ registered drop letter rate. An intense shade., \$75.00



Item 645-29 – 1¢ Admiral coil strip of 3 – 1936, 1¢ Admiral coil strip of 3 tied by Vancouver machine cancel on ILO Lubricating Oil advertising cover paying 3¢ letter rate to Victoria. \$25.00

Endorsed: "Jan 15/29, I certify this was the first of the 1929 20 cent stamp used at the Hamilton P.O." / E.R. Weblett". Addressed to himself. The 20c Scroll was issue JA 8 29. An interesting first time and first day "in Hamilton". \$200.00



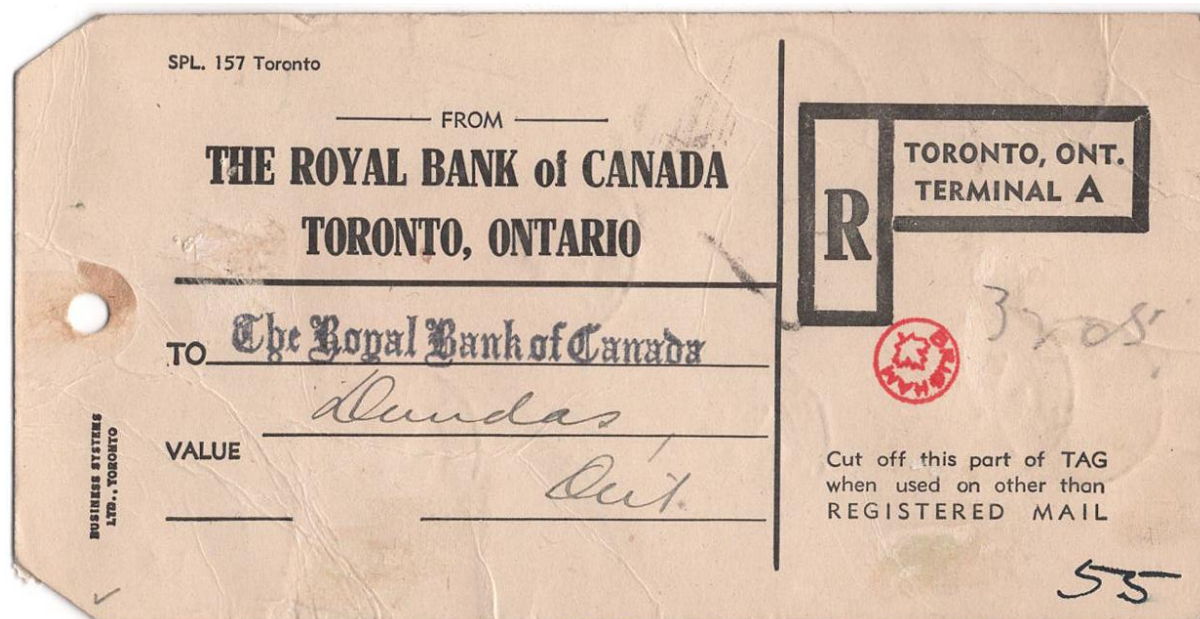
Item 645-32 – **5c Scroll block of 4 paying special delivery** – 1930, 1c vertical pair, 5c Scroll block of 4 tied by Hamilton cds on O'Brien News Co. c/c cover paying 22c special delivery letter rate to Indianapolis. Pt. Huron & Chi RPO (b/s). A spectacular cover! \$125.00



Item 645-33 – **Specimen ENX32-8** – c1933, 1¢ Medallion stationery with scalloped oval "Specimen Only" with initial. Webb ENX32-8, p.62. \$100.00



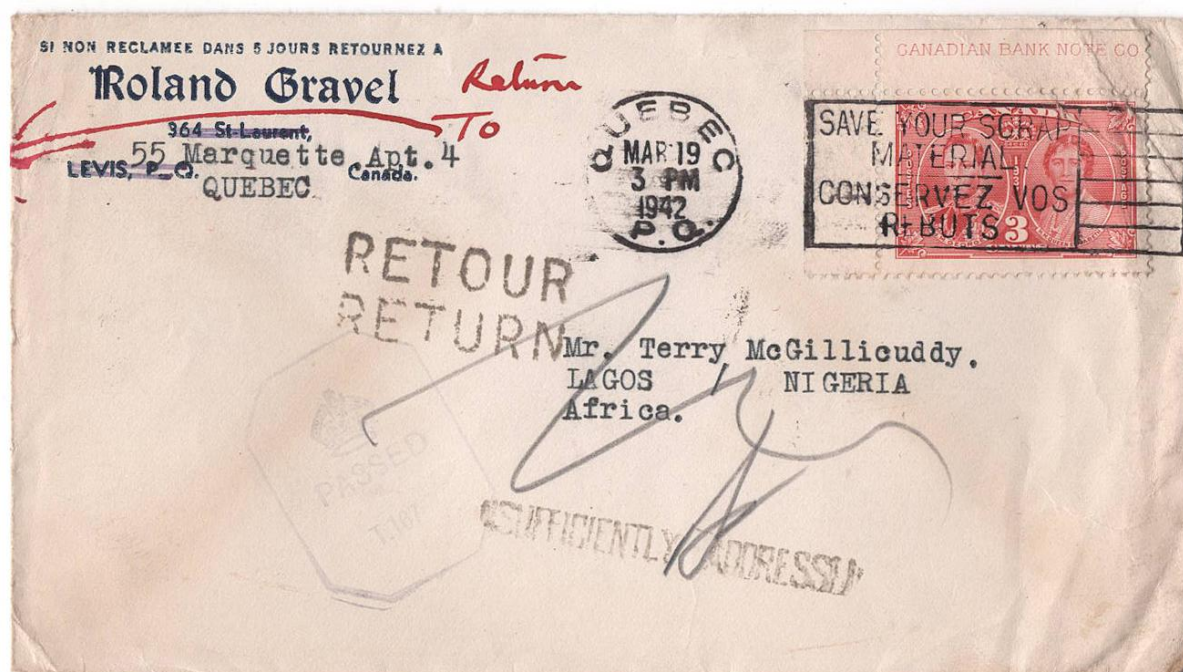

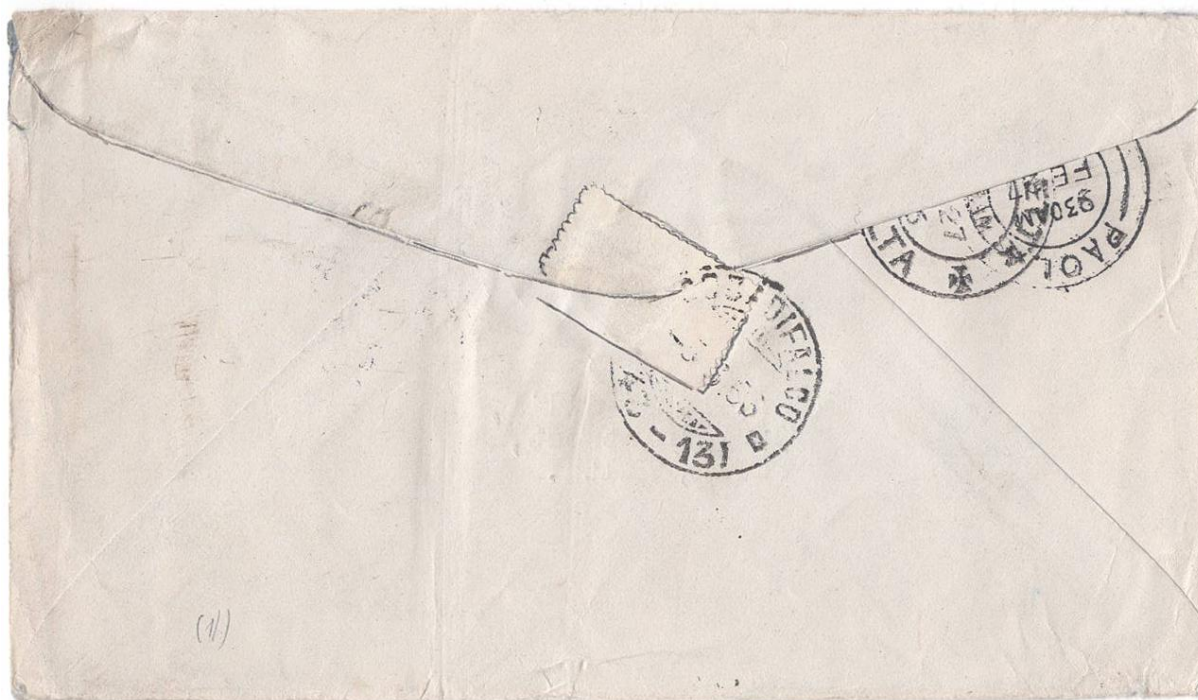

Item 645-36 – **Camp N “Sherbrooke Quebec”** – 1941, airmail double censored cover from Australia to Camp N Base Army Post Office, Ottawa (b/s). Camp N was in Sherbrooke, also known as Camp 42 or Camp Newington. The camp was situated on the grounds of the Quebec Central Railway's Newington Yard and initially served as a camp for refugees. Canada Int Op Crown No.21 censor marking. \$125.00 **SOLD**



Item 645-37 – **3c Empire to Nigeria – returned** – 1942, 3c Coronation tied by Quebec machine cancel on Gravel c/c cover paying 3c Empire letter rate to Lagos, Nigeria (b/s). Passed by censor crown. Insufficiently addressed and returned to sender. \$150.00



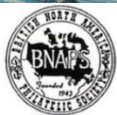
Item 645-38 – 2c Wilding cover to Malta redirected to Italy – 1956, 2c Wilding tied by Toronto machine cancel on cover paying 2c printed matter rate to Malta (b/s). Address label underneath. Redirected to Palermo Italy (b/s) with Malta 2d, 3d stamps tied by Paola circular datestamp. A very unusual Wilding cover! \$75.00
