Item 647-01 – <u>St. Catharines CW Berri to Woodburn</u> – 1861, 5¢ Beaver tied by St. Catharines CW <u>Berri duplex</u> cancel on cover, AU 14 61, paying 5¢ letter rate to Woodburn (b/s – Wentworth County). Routed via Hamilton and Stoney Creek (b/s). \$125.00





Item 647-02 – <u>Simcoe intaglio "4"</u> – 1885, 3¢ SQ and 2¢ RLS tied by intaglio "4" fancy cancel Lacelle #72 on cover from Simcoe Ont, fancy recorded from FE to MY 1885, paying 5¢ letter rate to St. Thomas (b/s). Carried by GWR with RY-80 G.W.R. Air Line (1884-1887, RF F). Rarity factor F represents 1 to 3 recorded examples. A real wow cover! \$250.00



Item 647-03 – <u>Guelph Machine & Tool Co.</u> – 1872, 3¢ SQ pair (rose red 11.85) tied by fancy cancel on Guelph Machine & Tool Co. advertising cover paying 6¢ cross border letter rate to Connecticut. \$125.00 <u>SOLD</u>





Item 647-04 – <u>Hartford Ont registered to Caledonia by RPOs</u> – 1880, 3¢ SQ, 2¢ RLS tied by large grid cancel on cover from Hartford Ont paying 5¢ registered letter rate to Caledonia (b/s 3-part dater). Routed via Waterford (in blue) and Brantford. Carried by Buffalo & Lake Huron Railway with RY-8 and RY-9 B&LH and Registered B&LH (b/s). Hartford Ont with manuscript date is very scarce and this one here is possibly the earliest recorded date MY 8 80. \$150.00




Item 647-05 – Newmarket Ont squared circle – 1895, 3¢ SQ tied by Newmarket Ont squared circle on cover paying 3¢ letter rate to Baldwin (b/s). SP 16 95. \$50.00




Item 647-06 – <u>Delhi Ont Stoddard House advertising</u> – 1896, 3¢ SQ tied by Delhi Ont broken circle on Stoddard House advertising cover paying 3¢ letter rate to St. Williams (b/s), via Hamilton (b/s). Reduced at right not affecting stamp. \$75.00



Item 647-07 – 1¢ First Rosette stationery card used from New York – c1891-2, 1¢ First Rosette stationery card with 2¢ Washington added tied by New York duplex K cancel to Germany. Pencil endorsement "S.S. La Champagne". Written in German language. \$50.00



Item 647-08 – Williams Manufacturing Co. – Typewriter – 1902, 2¢ Numeral tied by Montreal Bickerdike machine cancel on Williams Mfg Co. advertising cover, typewriter illustrated, paying 2¢ drop letter rate. \$125.00 SOLD



Item 647-09 – <u>Rubber company with precancel</u> – c1905, 1¢ Edward with inverted Toronto Ontario precancel on Robinson and Lindsay Rubber Company advertising cover paying 1¢ printed matter rate to Napierville. \$50.00 **SOLD**



Item 647-10 – <u>Louiseville Que special delivery</u> – 1921, 3¢ Admiral, 10¢ Special Delivery E1 tied by Louiseville PQ duplex cancel on cover, dated FE 21 21, paying 13¢ special delivery letter rate to St. Hyacinthe. Via Montreal with duplex H 4:30PM (*a very unusual use of the duplex H with hours*) and cds accompanies. Special delivery rate increased to 20¢ on August 1 1921. \$125.00





Item 647-11 – <u>Anderson-Macbeth Company hat manufacturers</u> – c1921-2, 1¢ Admiral stationery card mailed 3rd class from Toronto to Meaford reverse with Anderson Macbeth hat and band advertising. \$50.00 **SOLD**



Item 647-12 – **2¢ Admiral coil perf 8 #124 on cheque** – 1920, 2¢ Admiral coil perf 8 horizontal tied by Bank of Nova Scotia handstamp on Bank of Ottawa cheque. A very scarce and unusual use. \$125.00





Two added stationery cutouts to make the rate, mailed from Kaslo BC paying 3¢ letter rate to Victoria. \$50.00 SOLD




Item 647-16 – A shortpaid Jacques Cartier cover – 1934, 3¢ Jacques Cartier cancelled by North Portal & Moose Jaw RPO cds on dairy c/c cover from Weyburn Sask underpaying 5¢ double weight letter rate to Moose Jaw. 2¢ shortpaid and 4¢ collect. Paid with 4¢ Fourth Issue Postage Due stamp tied by Moose Jaw cds. Very scarce. \$40.00 SOLD





Item 647-19 – <u>Indianapolis Speedway KP128b</u> – 1935, 1¢ Medallion 3100 precancel stationery card with Fergus & Elora Motors advertising and Indianapolis Speedway view, paying 1¢ printed matter rate to Elora (printed *"or occupant"*). Webb KP128b (p.172). \$200.00 SOLD





Item 647-20 – <u>Blossom Hard Wheat Flour advertising</u> – 1944, 4¢ War tied by Lunenburg NS machine cancel on K.E. Crouse c/c cover, reverse with Blossom of Canada advertising with Canada illustrated, paying 4¢ letter rate to Hartland NB. \$65.00 <u>SOLD</u>



Item 647-21 – <u>T. Eaton cover damaged in railroad fire</u> – 1951, 4¢ meter on T. Eaton Co. window cover from Toronto, damaged in railroad fire, to an unknown destination. Research suggests it could be from the fire that occurred on December 23, 1951, in a baggage car attached to the Toronto, London & Windsor CNR train No.9, going west from Toronto. Dates are matching. \$100.00 SOLD
