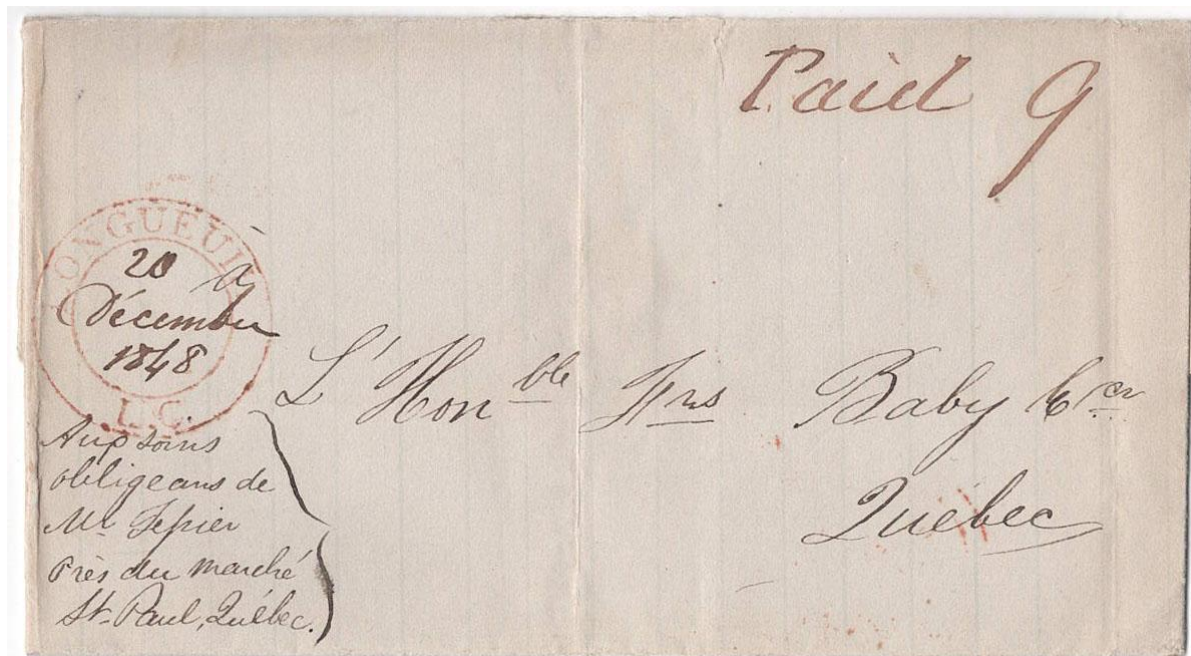




Item 672-01 – **Quebec Bishop Mark, to Three Rivers** – 1786, folded letter from Quebec with Quebec Bishop mark insert, rated 7d collect to Trois-Rivières. The letter is from Alexandre Dumas, as lawyer, relating to a legal matter and suit. Dumas was a businessman, militia officer, notary, lawyer, and politician; born in France, died at Quebec in 1802. One of his commercial interests under the French régime was the Gulf of St Lawrence fisheries, a field he continued to pursue after 1759. During the American invasion of 1775–76, he served as captain in the Canadian militia and took part in repelling Benedict Arnold's assault on Rue du Sault-au-Matelot. A very pretty letter, much scarcer than the rated 9d letters to Montreal. \$750.00



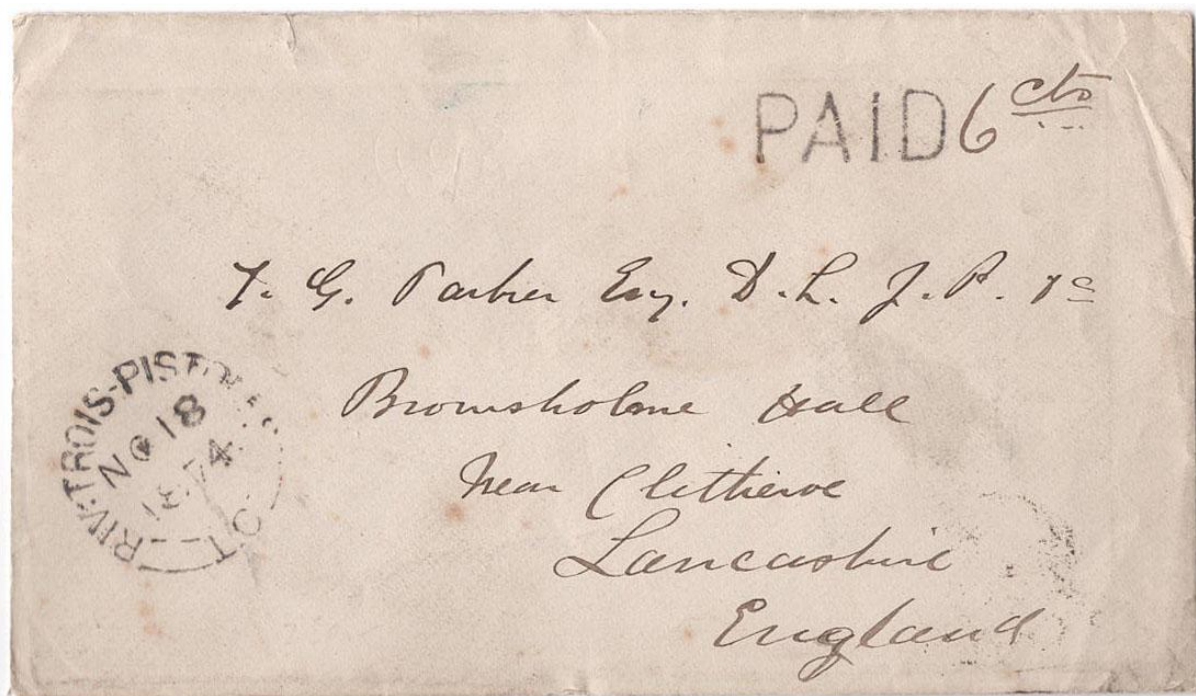
Item 672-02 – **The rare Yarmouth UC double circle (Elgin)** – 1836, folded cover from Yarmouth UC, double-circle in black with italic lettering, paid 9d to Toronto. Rare postmark and the latest recorded date among the few known examples. The post office operated from 1830 to 1837 and closed during the Rebellion when Postmaster Robert Kennedy fled. Later, the Temperanceville Post Office opened on the same site on April 6, 1849. Ex Smith, Leigh. Exceedingly rare. \$500.00



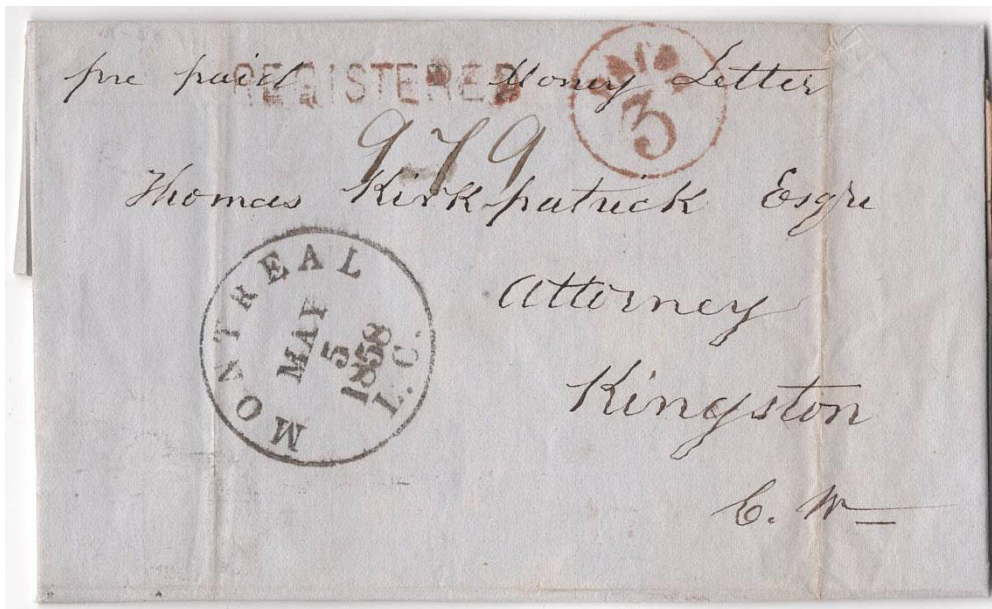
Item 672-03 – **Longueuil LC double circle** – 1848, stampless folded cover from Longueuil LC, red double-circle with manuscript date, paid 9d to Quebec. Endorsement giving delivery instructions near the Quebec market, St Paul Street. Longueuil double-circle is rare, only three recorded examples. Ex Field, Rixon, Leigh. \$400.00



Item 672-04 – City of Ottawa Ruggles indicia D – 1858, free-franked stampless cover from Ottawa with Ruggles “City of Ottawa” indicia D postmark to Toronto (b/s). Toronto Ruggles indicia C as receiver. Pretty cover. \$100.00



Item 672-05 – **Riviere Trois-Pistoles LC to England** – 1874, stampless cover from Riv Trois-Pistoles LC paid 6c paying the Allan Line letter rate to England (b/s). Carried by the Circassian. A rare Quebec postmark. \$200.00



Item 672-06 – **Montreal LC Ruggles on registered** – 1858, folded letter, registered, from Montreal paid 3d with registry fee paid in cash to Kingston. Only the second example I have seen of the Montreal LC Ruggles handstamp used as a despatch postmark. This handstamp is otherwise known on “not called for and advertised” letters (five reported examples). Heavy staining inside, not visible externally. A very tough Montreal postmark. \$250.00



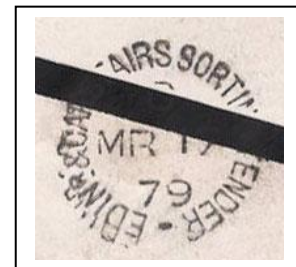
Item 672-07 – **Cobourg SQ special delivery to New York** – 1897, 3¢ SQ and US 10¢ Special Delivery tied by Cobourg Ont cds on cover, paying 13¢ special-delivery letter rate to New York (b/s). US 10¢ SD stamp faulty from back-flap opening tear. Under reciprocity regulations, the sender was required to apply the special-delivery stamp, which had to remain uncanceled until arrival; in this case it was not, though its presence is nevertheless correct and tied by the Cobourg cds. Trio of New York postmarks on back. A rare SQ special-delivery cover to New York. \$550.00 **SOLD**



Item 672-08 – **Prince Albert Sask to Shanghai, China** – 1890, 3¢ SQ (4) tied by grid cancel on cover from Prince Albert, Sask, dated NO 4 90, overpaying 10¢ letter rate to China (b/s). Routed via Vancouver (b/s). Carried by the RMS Parthia of the Cunard Line. This is one of four recorded SQ covers to China. Interior and opening tear restored; two stamps with tears, possibly pre-affixing faults. A rarity despite condition. \$600.00 **SOLD**



Item 672-09 – **20¢ Widow use on parcel piece to England** – 1893–1895, 2¢ SQ (2) and 20¢ Widow tied by Ottawa roller cancel on parcel piece to England. Reverse shows fibrous brown kraft-type paper. Parcel post rates to England during this period varied between 20¢ and 28¢ per 1 lb. \$250.00



Item 672-10 – **1879 Toronto duplex on mourning cover** – 1879, 5¢ SQ tied by Toronto duplex cancel on mourning cover paying 5¢ U.P.U. letter rate to Scotland (b/s). Liverpool U.S. Packet receiver on front. In the 1870s Toronto had an emerging and short-lived range of duplex devices, all challenging; the datestamp on this strike measures 24.5 mm and dated FE 28 79. \$100.00



Item 672-11 – **10c UPU registered to Argentina** – 1894, ½c SQ (18) tied by oval Montreal Que parcel cancel on 1c stationery envelope; Montreal barred circle hammer 1 dated JY 10 94, paying 10c UPU registered letter rate to Argentina (b/s) via New York (b/s). Some overall tropical foxing, still an attractive hammer 1 and UPU registered rate cover. \$500.00 **SOLD**



Item 672-12 – **10¢ UPU registered to France** – 1881, 1¢, 2¢ (2) SQ and 5¢ RLS tied by oval registered cancel on Clerk of the Court of Montreal cover; reverse with Crest of the "Greffes de la Couronne", paying 10¢ UPU registered letter rate to Rouen, France (b/s). Routed via London. A rarely seen 1¢, 2¢, 5¢ RLS combination. \$550.00



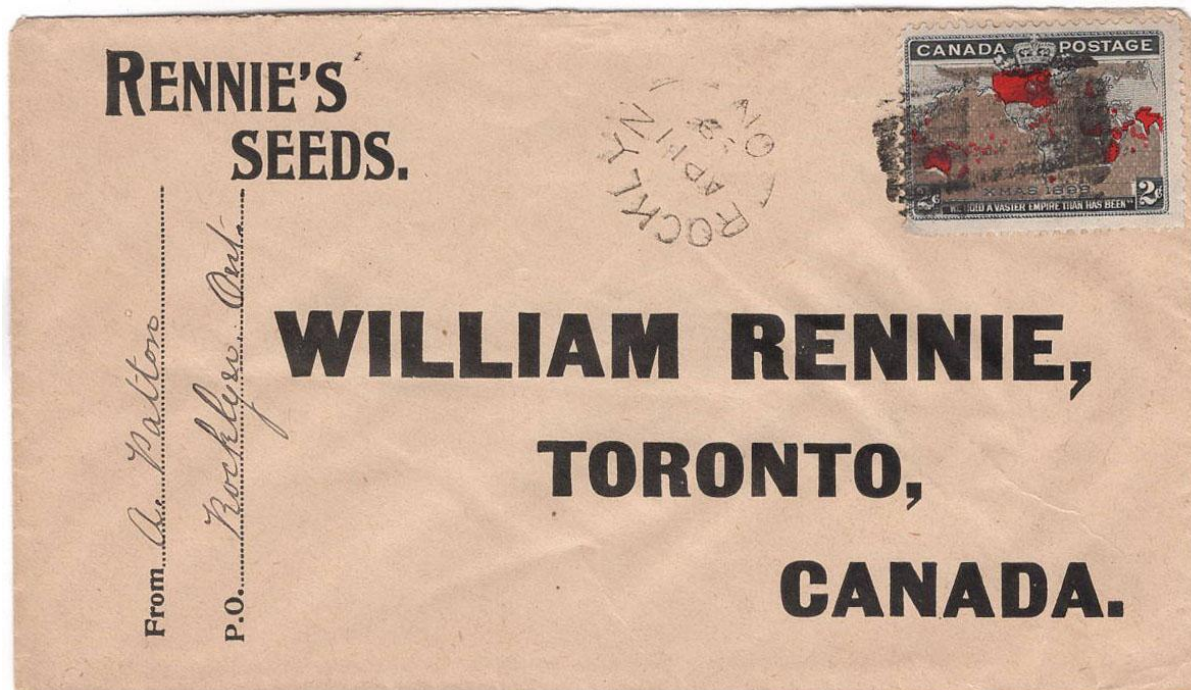
Item 672-13 – **BK1, 2¢ Numeral booklet** – c.1900, complete booklet with red binding tape under staple, containing all information-rate pages, interleaves, and two 2¢ carmine die II Numeral panes of six, issued JU 11 00. Mint, fresh, OG, NH, FVF, with the usual minor disturbance seen on early booklets but without adhesion. RG certificate #2154A (2009). Unitrade \$4,500.00. A beauty. \$2,500.00



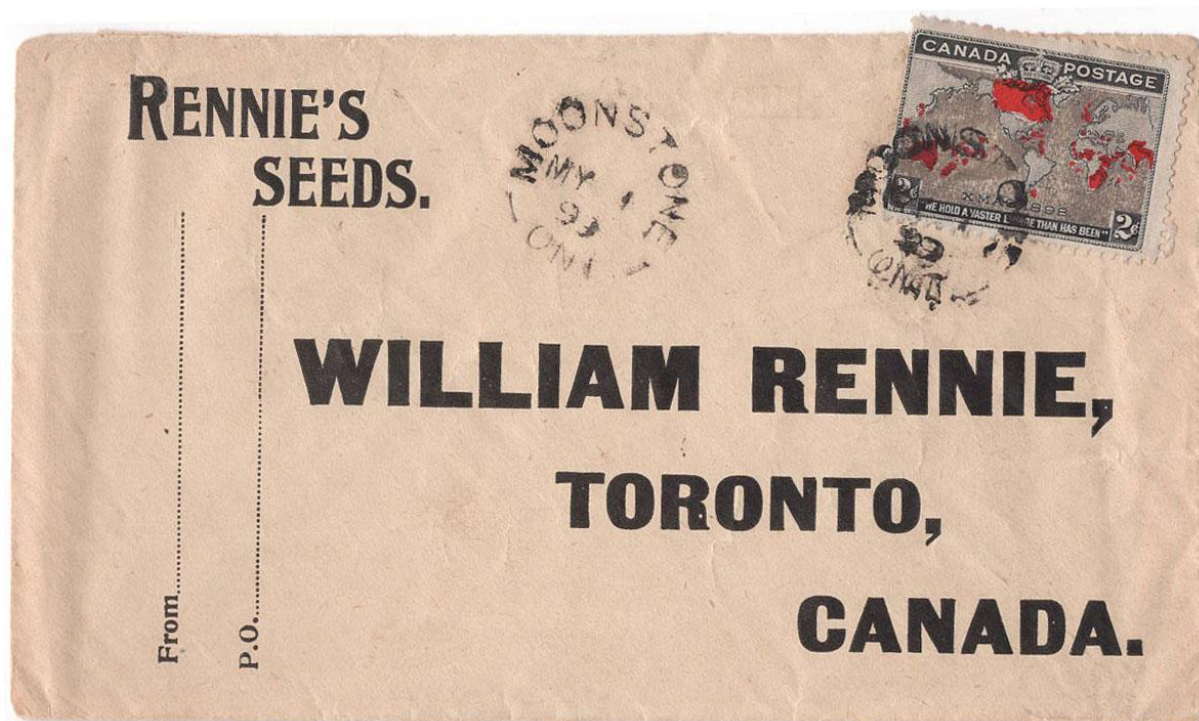
Item 672-14 – **Sault Ste. Marie Ont squared circle** – 1899, 1¢ Numeral (2) tied by grid cancel on cover from Sault Ste Marie Ont, squared circle AM MY 1 99, paying 2¢ letter rate to Toronto (b/s). Ex Cohen, Hennok. \$50.00 **SOLD**



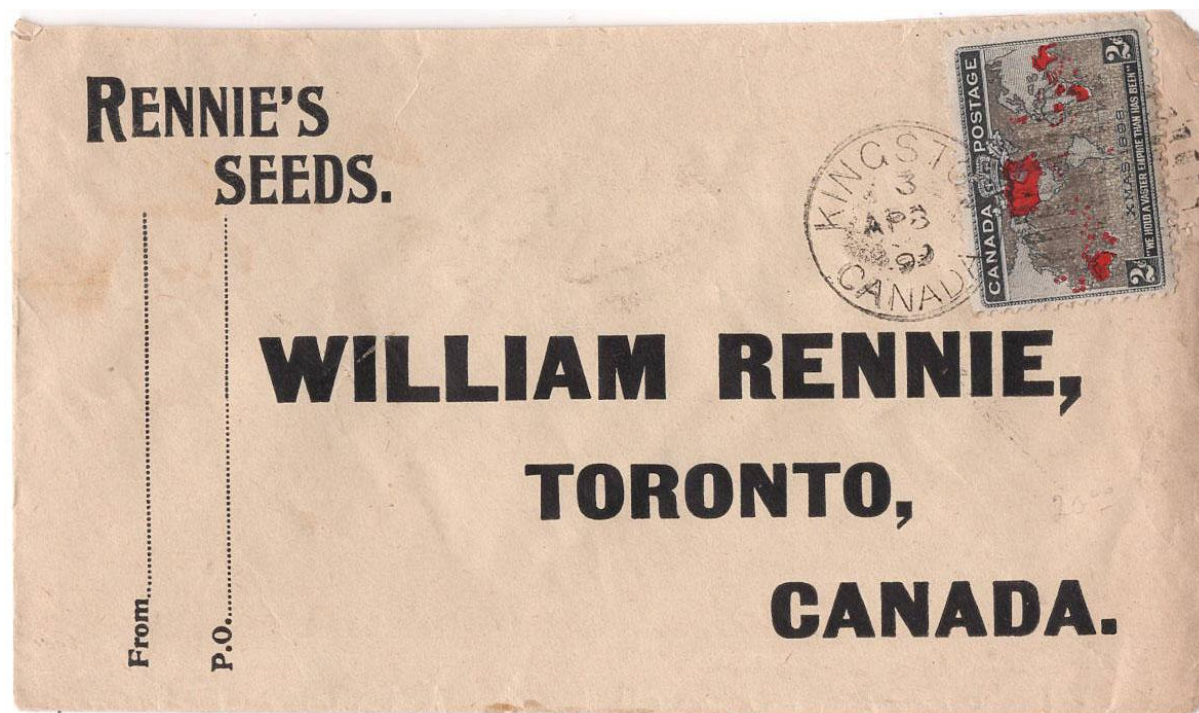
Item 672-15 – **Stratford Windsor Hotel advertising** – 1899, 2¢ Numeral tied by Stratford Ont duplex cancel on The Windsor advertising cover paying 2¢ letter rate to London (b/s). London carrier mark on front. Hotel illustrated cover from Stratford are scarce! \$75.00 **SOLD**



Item 672-16 – **Rocklyn Ont (Grey County)** – 1899, 2¢ Map (muddy-water orange-brown shade) tied by homemade cancelling device on Rennie reply cover from Rocklyn Ont, paying 2¢ letter rate to Toronto (b/s). \$50.00



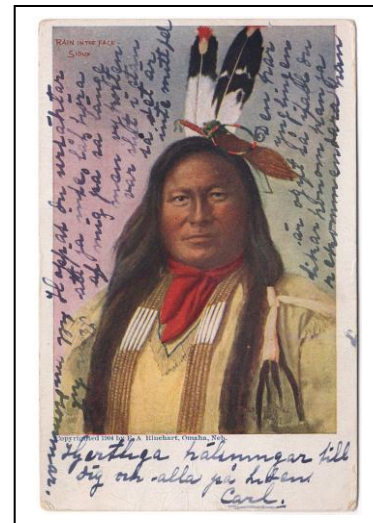
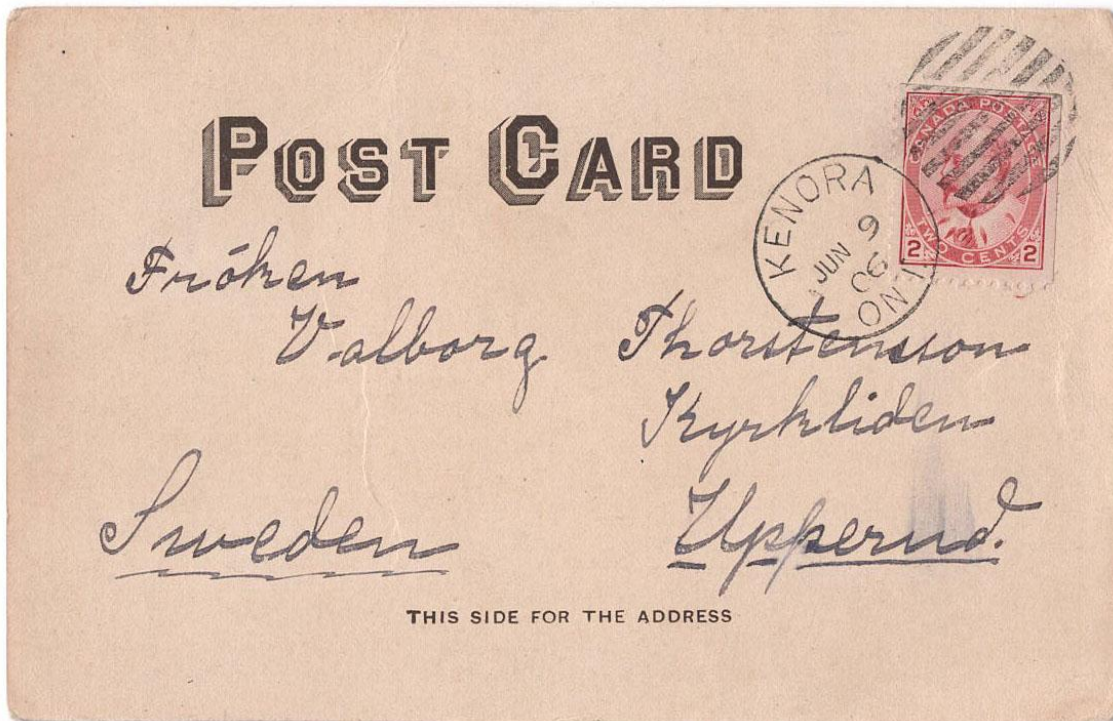
Item 672-17 – Moonstone Ont (Simcoe County) – 1899, 2¢ Map (muddy-water charcoal shade) tied by Moonstone Ont broken circle on Rennie reply cover paying 2¢ letter rate to Toronto (partial b/s). Faint Warminster (b/s). \$50.00



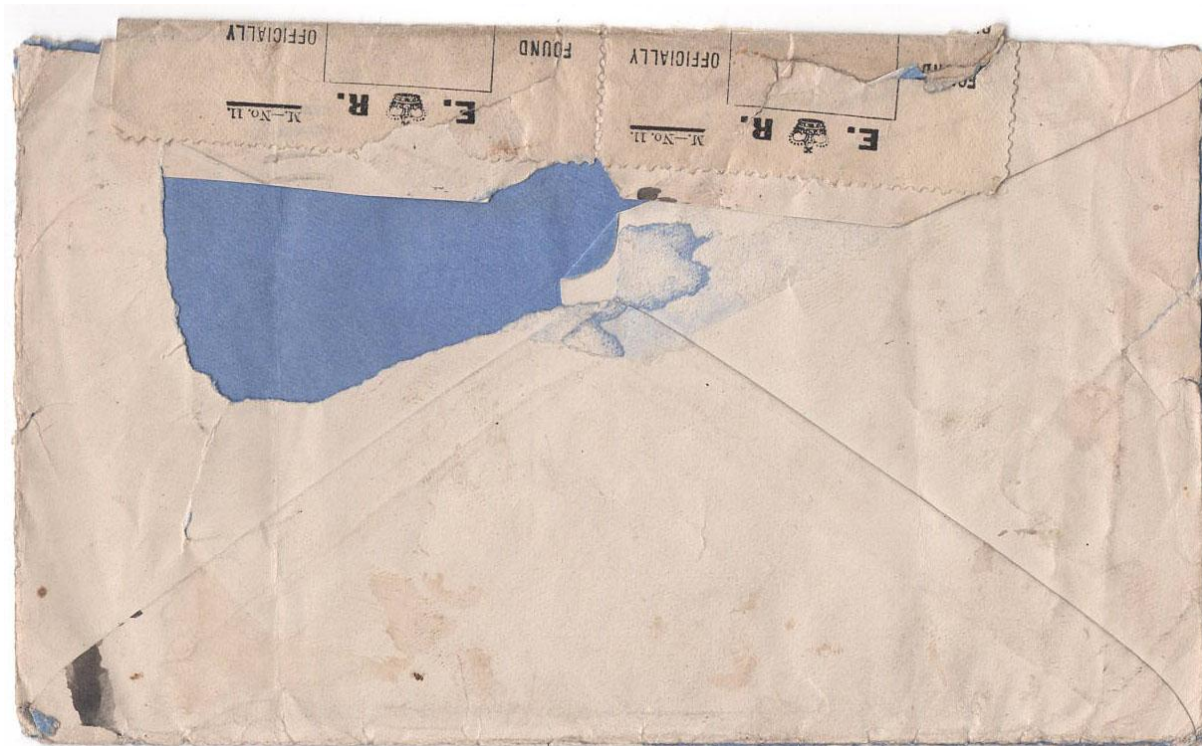
Item 672-18 – 2¢ Map (plate re-touch at base) – 1899, 2¢ Map (plate re-touch at base, muddy-water charcoal shade) tied by Kingston duplex cancel on Rennie reply cover, paying 2¢ letter rate to Toronto (b/s). \$50.00



Item 672-19 – **Registered No.2 Saskatoon Sask** – 1910, 2¢ (booklet stamp), 5¢ Edward tied by Registered No.2 Saskatoon Sask cds on cover paying 7¢ registered letter rate to Massachusetts (b/s) via Winnipeg (b/s) and St. Paul Minn (b/s). A rare Saskatoon postmark. Ex Horace Harrison. \$75.00



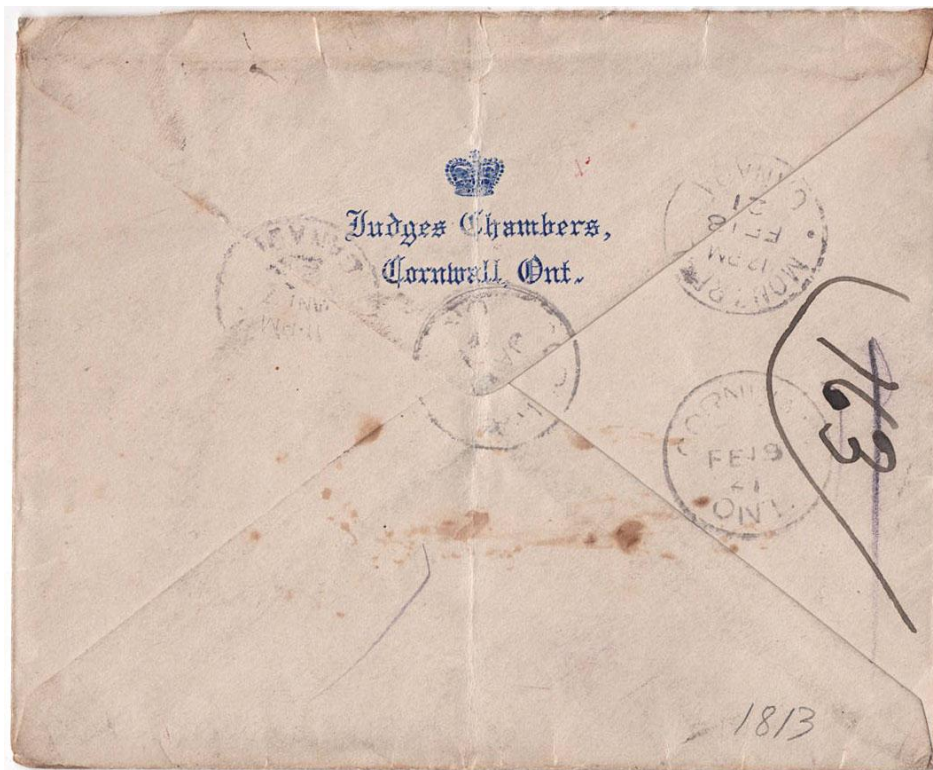
Item 672-20 – **Kenora postcard to Sweden** – 1906, 2¢ Edward booklet stamp tied by Kenora Ont duplex cancel on Sioux Chief postcard, published in Omaha, Nebraska in 1904, paying 2¢ UPU postcard rate to Sweden. \$50.00 **SOLD**



Item 672-21 – **Winnipeg cover to England officially sealed** – 1907, 1¢ Edward (2) tied by Winnipeg Man machine cancel on cover underpaying 4¢ double-weight Empire letter rate to England. T10 converted to 2d. Possibly damaged in transit or opened for other reasons; officially sealed with E.R. label tied by Worthing cds. \$50.00



Item 672-22 – **Richelieu and Ontario cover to Australia** – 1907, 2¢ Edward booklet stamp tied by Montreal duplex cancel on Richelieu and Ontario Navigation Company advertising cover, paying 2¢ Empire letter rate to Victoria, Australia (b/s). Routed via San Francisco and Melbourne (b/s). Manuscript “our steamer,” presumably written by an Australian family touring Eastern Canada. Not a rare steamship-company cover, but a very scarce use to Australia. \$200.00



Item 672-23 – **13¢ Empire registered to Ireland returned to sender** – 1921, 3¢, 10¢ Admiral tied by Cornwall Ont cds on Judges Chambers Crown c/c cover paying the 13¢ Empire registered letter rate to Dublin, Ireland (b/s). Returned to sender via Montreal (b/s) and Cornwall (b/s). Thirty-two days in transit. \$150.00 **SOLD**
